**THE SKINNY...** The 2000 NCAA Division II Men's and Women's Basketball Championship West Regionals take place this week - the men's competition at Seattle Pacific and the women's at CAL POLY POMONA. Three CCAA squads: league champion CAL STATE, SAN BERNARDINO, UC DAVIS and CAL STATE L.A. will participate in Seattle, while women's conference champ Pomona is the lone CCAA representative in the national showcase for the first time since 1994. The spring seasons are in full gear, however, with the official beginning of the track & field season commencing last Wednesday. This week the UC schools, Davis and Riverside, host their regional rivals in a pair of multi-team meets featuring some of the best athletes the CCAA has to offer. Originally scheduled for SAN FRANCISCO STATE, the five-way meet at Davis was moved to Aggie country because of the current renovation of SFSU's Cox Stadium.

A key series in baseball this weekend looks to pit defending national champion CHICO STATE at UC RIVERSIDE. Riverside is ineligible for any postseason opportunities, but its games against all CCAA squads affect CCAA records, which determine the four participants for the league tournament to be held the second week of May. Chico is currently 9-0 and ranked No. 1 nationally.

In softball, No. 24 CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD, fresh off a non-league win over No. 17 UC DAVIS at a Texas tournament, takes on the Aggies in Davis on **Saturday, March 11**. The Roadrunners must tangle with a fierce Chico State squad first, however, as the two teams meet in Chico on **Friday, March 10 at 1:30 p.m.** 

CCAA NEWS AND NOTES . . . SAN FRANCISCO STATE student and former Gator pole vaulter John Marheineke won \$10,000 by sinking a halfcourt basket on Fan Appreciation Night during SFSU's final home basketball game of the season on February 26. Marheineke, a 22-year-old kiniesiology major hit nothing but net in a contest sponsored by CollegeClub.com. Following his feat, Marheineke was a guest on a local sports television show and his shot has been aired numerous times on the San Francisco NBC affiliate . . . GRAND CANYON President and current baseball coach Gil Stafford was officially inaugurated as the President of GCU on Thursday, February 24. The unique dual-position held by Dr. Stafford is being featured in this month's edition of ESPN The Magazine, scheduled to hit the newsstands on Wednesday, March 8 . . . GCU women's basketball senior Veronica Gonzales finished her career as the all-time leading scorer in GCU history with 789 points in just two years with the 'Lopes . . . Karen L. Miller, Director of Athletics at Cal Poly Pomona for 18 years, will finish her tenure this month. The Broncos have won two CCAA Championships and placed second nationally in women's soccer during her final academic year as Athletics Director . . . Chico State baseball pitcher John-Eric Hernandez, the Most Outstanding Player of the 1999 Division II Finals, won his 34th career game at Chico in a 19-6 win at Cal State, San Bernardino last week. The 34th victory at Chico State breaks the all-time record of 33 that has stood for 50 years.

## UC DAVIS' CHRIS STRETCH NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS catcher/designated hitter **Chris Stretch** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Player of the Week for the week of February 28-March 5.

Stretch, a senior from Yorba Linda, Calif., led the Aggies to three wins last week with 10 hits in 17 at-bats (.588), including three home runs, three doubles, six RBI and a stolen base. Stretch opened the week with two hits, one of which was a double, in an 9-2 non-conference

win over San Francisco State.

He was instrumental in a doubleheader sweep of Cal State L.A. last Friday with a pair of hits in the first game and three more in the second contest. Stretch also hit home runs in back-to-back games in a Saturday doubleheader against Cal State L.A. The Player of the Week honor is the first of Stretch's career.

GRAND CANYON designated hitter/catcher **Tyler Beuerlein** was named the Rawlings CCAA Player of the Week for the week of February 21-27.

Beuerlein, a 6-2 sophomore from Phoenix, Ariz., led the Antelopes to a four-game CCAA sweep of San Francisco State with seven hits, four of which were home runs, and six RBI. He had three home runs, including the game-tying round-tripper, in a 21-18 extra-inning win over SFSU to end the series. Beuerlein finished the series with a 1.720 slugging percentage and a .636 batting average (7 for 11) in earning his first CCAA Player of the Week honor.

## CS DOMINGUEZ HILLS' CHRIS REIDEL NAMED RAWLINGS PITCHER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS righthander **Chris Reidel** has been named the Rawlings CCAA Baseball Pitcher of the Week for the week of February 28-March 5.

Reidel, a 6-3 senior from Garden Grove, Calif., was stellar on the mound for the Toros this past weekend, pitching 12 innings and allowing just 10 hits, two runs and two walks while striking out 12. In three innings of the Toros' win over Azusa Pacific, Reidel yielded one hit,

zero walks and struck out three.

Three days later, Reidel fired a complete-game 4-2 CCAA victory over Cal State Stanislaus, limiting the opponent to two runs on nine hits and two walks while striking out 10. For the week, Reidel compiled a 1.50 earned run average. The Pitcher of the Week award is the first of Reidel's career and the second for a Toro this season.

SONOMA STATE righthander **Colin Hayes** was named the Rawlings CCAA Baseball Pitcher of the Week for the week of February 21-27.

Hayes, a senior from Atascadero, Calif., allowed one hit over six and two-thirds innings to earn the victory in the Cossacks' 2-0 win at Cal State L.A. in SSU's CCAA opener. He struck out four, walked two and didn't allow a CSLA batter past second base in improving his season record to 3-1. The CCAA Pitcher of the Week honor is the first for Hayes this season and the second of his career.

## CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD'S CHRISTI ABSHIRE NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD center fielder **Christi Abshire** has been named the CCAA Softball Player of the Week for the week of February 28-March 5.

Abshire, a senior from Lake Isabella, Calif., hit .588 (10 for 17) with four runs, and three stolen bases at the Schutt Leadoff Classic last week to power the Roadrunners to a fifth-place finish at one of the nation's most prestigious tournaments in all of college softball.

UC DAVIS shortstop **Sharlie Cunningham** was named the CCAA Softball Player of the Week for the week of February 21-27. Cunningham, a junior from Pittsburg, Calif., led the Aggies to a pair of road sweeps over UC Riverside and Cal State, San Bernardino with five hits in seven at-bats (.714), including two home runs. She finished the four-game stretch with five runs, five RBI and a slugging percentage of 1.571. The Player of the Week honor is the first of for Cunningham in 2000.

## CAL STATE STANISLAUS' JENNY BROWN NAMED PITCHER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE STANISLAUS pitcher **JennyBrown** has been named the CCAA Softball Pitcher of the Week for the week of February 28-March 5.

Brown, a junior from Turlock, Calif., earned her second Pitcher of the Week honor this season by leading the Warriors to three CCAA victories over Chico State, Sonoma State and San Francisco State last week. She fired complete-game shutouts against Chico (a 1-0, 11-inning win) and San Francisco State, and picked up another complete-game win over Sonoma. Brown was dominant against SFSU, allowing just one hit while striking out nine. She finished the week with three wins to run her season record to 7-0. She allowed one earned run on 12 hits and one base on balls, and struck out 17 in 24.0 innings pitched last week.

CHICO STATE hurler **Alli Fritz** was named the CCAA Softball Pitcher of the Week for the week of February 21-27. Fritz, a junior from Placentia, Calif., pitched two complete-game shutouts at UC Riverside and Cal State, San Bernardino, giving up a total of six hits and finishing the week with 13 strikeouts. She yielded just two hits and struck out five in a 5-0 win over UCR, then came back to limit CSUSB to four hits while striking out eight Coyotes in a 3-0 win. The Pitcher of the Week award is the first for Fritz in 2000.
