ONWARD MARCH ... A wide array of spring sports action this, the predominant majority of which pits CCAA members against non-conference competition. In softball, CAL STATE, SAN BERNARDINO and UC RIVERSIDE host top-ranked and defending national champion Humboldt State (CSUSB earlier today) and UCR on **Tuesday, March 14**. In baseball, CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS returns from a week-long trip to Hawaii to host Division I Bradley, marking the first of many intersectional battles. SONOMA STATE and SAN FRANCISCO STATE do battle in league play - first in Rohnert Park on Tuesday and Friday; then a high-noon doubledip in The City on **Saturday, March 18**. A very light week in women's tennis has only four non-league matches on the schedule. The all-encompassing sport of track & field transcends the travel itinerary this week as the CCAA members cover nearly every region of the Golden State for invitational action.

CCAA NEWS AND NOTES . . . CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD's MEN'S SWIMMING team won its 10th **NCAA CHAMPIONSHIP** last week with a convincing 57-point win over runner-up Drury. Senior **Derek Guffey** broke the NCAA Division II record in the 200 backstroke with an national-championship time of 1:45.53 to lead the way . . . The championship increases the number of NCAA Championships won by CCAA members at the time they were members to 133, which ranks first among Division II conferences. UC DAVIS finished fourth overall on the men's side and 12th in the women's competition, and Bakersfield's women finished 15th for its eighth top 20 finish in nine years . . . CAL POLY POMONA named **Ky Kugler** its Interim Athletic Director, effective April 1 through June 30. Kugler, currently an Assistant Athletic Director at Pomona, will replace the retiring **Karen Miller** . . . UC DAVIS' indoor track & field teams finished third (men) and eighth (women) at the NCAA Division II Championships in Boston last week. **Trevor Boler** won the NCAA D-II Indoor crown in the pole vault (16-8.75) and **Jennifer Swanson** duplicated the feat on the women's side (12-3.5). All nine Aggies competing in the national championships earned All-America honors.

CSLA'S JOHN DRAPER NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE L.A. outfielder John Draper has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Player of the Week for the week of March 6-12.

Draper, a 6-2 sophomore from Whittier, Calif., hit .706 (12 of 17) last week to power the Golden Eagles to a three games to one series victory over CCAA rival San Francisco State last week.

He had four hits in five at-bats, including a double, and scored two runs and added two RBI in CSLA's 10-5 series-opening victory. Draper had three hits, four runs, two RBI and a stolen base in a 20-4 win over SFSU and ended the series with a perfect three for three showing. For the week, Draper had seven runs and five RBI to complement his hot hitting.

UC DAVIS' LUKE STEIDLMAYER NAMED RAWLINGS PITCHER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS hurler **Luke Steidlmayer** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Pitcher of the Week for the week of March 6-12.

Steidlmayer, a freshman righthander from Colusa, Calif., fired a seven-inning complete-game victory over Cal State, San Bernardino last week, allowing zero earned runs, six hits and a walk while striking out three in a 6-1 Aggie win.

The Pitcher of the Week honor is the first of Steidlmayer's career.

Bao-nhan Vinh - 2B, CHICO STATE: Was a dominant force in the top-ranked Wildcats' three wins at UC Riverside last week, hitting .471 (8 for 17) with three doubles, four runs and three RBI. Vinh went 4 for 5 and drove in the game-winning run in a 3-2 series-opening win. He extended his hitting streak to seven games and now has five multiple-hit games this season.

Dave Melton - P, CHICO STATE: Relief pitcher notched two saves vs. UC Riverside, coming on in the ninth inning of the first game and retiring the side in order to secure a 3-2 win. Also came on to pitch the final out of the series-finale, an 11-9 Chico win. Gave up just one hit in 1.2 innings of work.

Joe Gevas - OF, CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS: Hit .556 (10 for 18) in six games at Hawaii Pacific, three of which were CSUDH victories. Added six runs, two walks and an RBI. Went 3 for 4 with a run in a 6-2 win. Finished the series with two runs, two walks and an RBI.

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS outfielder **Shyamala White** has been named the CCAA Softball Player of the Week for the week of March 6-12..

White, a sophomore from Carmel, Calif., hit .667 (8 for 12) with three triples, three runs, two RBI and a 1.17 slugging percentage as the Aggies went 2-2 last week. She went a perfect 5 for 5 with all three of her triples and two RBI in a doubleheader sweep of Cal State Dominguez Hills. WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD pitcher **Melanie Wood** has been named the CCAA Softball Pitcher of the Week for the week of March 6-12.

Wood, a junior righthander from Tujunga, Calif., fired two one-hitters in three appearances last week to help the Roadrunners go 5-1 last week, with three of the wins coming at Chico State and UC Davis. Wood started out the week with a one-hit shutout win over UC Riverside. She struck out three and yielded just one walk in addition to the hit over five innings. Wood helped herself by going perfect at the plate with three doubles in the 11-0 win.

She notched her ninth win of the season with another one-hit performance at Chico State. In the 2-1 victory, Wood gave up one earned run and struck out four while walking seven. She hit safely in her only at-bat.

Wood finished the week with another complete-game victory over defending league co-champion UC Davis, scattering five hits and allowing one run. For the week, Wood pitched 19.0 innings, allowed seven hits, two earned runs, struck out 14 and limited opponents to a .113 batting average. WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD senior **Barbara Valkova** has been named the California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Tennis Player of the Week for the week of March 6-12.

Valkova, a native of Prague, Czech Republic, returned from a knee injury to keep her CCAA career record unblemished, picking up a pair of singles wins and teaming for a doubles victory as well. WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS sprinter **Kwamin Taylor** has been named the California Collegiate Athletic Association Men's Track & Field Athlete of the Week for the week of March 6-12 after winning two events at two different meets last week.

Taylor, a sophomore from Oakland, Calif., was a double-winner in a CCAA five-way meet at Woody Wilson Track in Davis last week, winning both the 100 and 200-meter sprints. He led a UC Davis sweep of the top four places in the 100 with a time of 10.85, then finished first in the 200 with a time of 22.12 as the Aggies cruised to the team title by over 100 points. The Athlete of the Week honor is the first of Taylor's career and the second in as many weeks for a UCD athlete.
