## BREAKIN' FOR GLORY

**ANYTHING BUT A SPRING BREAK FOR STUDENT-ATHLETES . . .** Mental intensity for final exams transfers to the playing venues this week as CCAA student-athletes test their mettle in a variety of key competition. In baseball, CHICO STATE, ranked No. 1 nationally, takes on rival UC DAVIS in a four-game set beginning **Friday, March 24 at 2:30 p.m. in Davis.** The Wildcats host a doubleheader the following day (Saturday to be exact) at high-noon at Nettleton Stadium. The two squads meet up one more time, back in Davis, to close out the season series with one another . . . In softball, the Cal State Hayward Pioneer Classic is the place to be as all five NorCal members will take part beginning Friday. One of the most prestigious track meets west of the Mississippi River will feature some of the CCAA's finest athletes as the majority of conference members are entered in the *Stanford Invitational*, which gets underway **Saturday (March 25)** morning and proceeds through Sunday afternoon. Women's tennis has SONOMA STATE looking to stay undefeated in league play as it heads 40 miles south to take on regional rival SAN FRANCISCO STATE at the Gators' brand new facility on **Tuesday, March 21.**

**CCAA NEWS AND NOTES . . .** The CALIFORNIA COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION and CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS are two of the seven entities that will receive funding from the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA) as part of the **Strategic Alliance Matching Grant Enhancement Program**, aimed at increasing gender and ethnic diversity within NCAA Division II intercollegiate athletic programs. The CCAA will utilize the additional funding to add a full-time Coordinator of Compliance and Operations position, and CSUDH will use its grant toward an Assistant to the Athletics Director position. The CCAA is the only conference to receive the grant, and Cal State Dominguez Hills is one of just six institutions to receive the grant . . . CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD named **Greg Bruce** as its first women's basketball head coach. Bruce most recently coached at Northern Colorado for three seasons, including this past year's 20-9 campaign that earned him North Central Conference Coach of the Year honors. Bruce, who also coached at Portland State and the Portland Power of the now-defunct American Basketball League (ABL), has a collegiate career record of 257-117 (.687) and seven NCAA Division II Championship tournament appearances to his credit. The Roadrunners will begin competing in women's basketball this fall . . . SONOMA STATE named **Jon Stevenson** its women's volleyball head coach. Stevenson, who succeeds Kelly Van Winden, is a former head men's volleyball coach at incoming CCAA member UC SAN DIEGO. He most recently served as the assistant coach at Wyoming . . . CAL STATE STANISLAUS women's basketball coach **LeAnn Millar** was named the 2000 Kodak Division II West Region Coach of the Year after leading the Warriors to a 19-10 mark. Players selected to the Kodak D-II All-West Region Team are CCAA Player of the Year **Lauri McIntosh** (Cal Poly Pomona), **ShannonDonnelly** (Cal State Stanislaus), **Des Abeyta** (UC Davis) and **Marissa Bradley** (Chico State) . . . The National Association of Collegiate Directors of Athletics (NACDA) announced that UC DAVIS has taken over first place in the Division II Sears Directors' Cup standings. The Directors' Cup honors the most successful all-around athletic department based on a point-system of each institution's athletic offerings. The Aggies lead the nation with 454, 13 more than second-place Western State with three months of competition remaining.

## CHICO STATE'S RYAN TASH NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CHICO STATE first baseman **Ryan Tash** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Player of the Week for the week of March 13-19.

Tash, a 6-2 junior from Sacramento, Calif., led the Wildcats offensively to three wins in four games over NorCal rival Cal State Stanislaus last week. He hit .385 (5 of 13) with three runs, a two-run homer, four RBI and a stolen base. Tash powered the defending national champion to a 6-1 win at Stanislaus with his round-tripper and an RBI single.

Chico now stands at 11-2 in CCAA play, a game and a half behind league leader Grand Canyon.

## CHICO'S DAVID ARROYO NAMED RAWLINGS PITCHER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CHICO STATE righthander **David Arroyo** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Pitcher of the Week for the week of March 13-19.

Arroyo, a 6-1 junior from Ventura, Calif., fired a seven-inning, complete-game shutout in the second game of a twinbill with Cal State Stanislaus last week.

He had complete command of his entire arsenal, stymieing the Stanislaus lineup and retiring the first 10 Warriors he faced. Arroyo yielded just three singles, set Stanislaus down in order five times and never allowed a runner past first base. In 7.0 innings pitched, Arroyo walked zero and struck out 10. He faced just two batters more than the minimum in earning his first Pitcher of the Week honor.
