SOMETHING TO PROVE

THIS WEEK . . . The top squads in all of the spring sports enter the final weekend in April with much to gain and lose as the conference and national postseasons near. Baseball league leader CHICO STATE, ranked third nationally, hosts No. 8 GRAND CANYON in a four-game set at Nettleton Stadium, beginning **Friday, April 28 at 7 p.m.** Chico has already clinched a berth in the upcoming CCAA Baseball Championship Tournament and will host the event (May 11-13). Canyon, which laid claim to the CCAA Men's Golf Championship in convincing fashion earlier this week, leads three other CCAA institutions (CAL STATE STANISLAUS, UC DAVIS and CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD) into the NCAA Division II Championship West Regional at Riverlakes Golf Club in Bakersfield (**Mon., May 1 through Wed., May 3**). CCAA track & field squads gear up for the annual megameet known as the Cal/Nevada Championships in Berkeley this **Saturday and Sunday (April 29-30)**. Chico State hosts a twilight meet on Saturday as well. Two weeks remain before the CCAA Championships are to be held in Davis (May 12-13). In softball, CCAA leader Cal State Bakersfield will try and close in on its ninth straight league title as it takes on SONOMA STATE and SAN FRANCISCO STATE in the Bay Area. The 'Runners are currently two games ahead of Cal State Stanislaus and have four fewer losses than the Warriors. The CCAA women's tennis squads send their individual players to the Central Coast to compete in the annual Ojai Individual Championships (**Apr. 27-30**). NCAA Division II Championship selections will be made over the weekend with several CCAA squads likely to receive berths.

CCAA NEWS AND NOTES . . . UC DAVIS softball coach **Kathy DeYoung** won her 600th career game as coach of the Aggies. In 22 years at UCD, DeYoung has produced an outstanding 601-330-2 (.645) record and guided the Aggies to nine NCAA Division II regional berths and three NCAA Championship Finals tournament appearances . . . CHICO STATE has been selected to host the 2000 California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Championship Tournament at **Nettleton Stadium** in Chico **Thursday, May 11 through Saturday, May 13**. Single day ticket prices for the three-day event are \$6 for adults, \$3 for college students with a valid I.D. and \$2 for high school students and under.

UC DAVIS' CHRIS STRETCH RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS catcher/outfielder **Chris Stretch** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Player of the Week for the week of April 17-23.

A senior from Yorba Linda, Calif., Stretch was a major factor in preserving the Aggies' hopes for a second straight berth in the CCAA Championship Tournament. In a 3-to-1 series victory over future Division I member UC Riverside, Stretch hit .563 (9 for 16) with 6 runs scored, 4 RBI and a stolen base. In the series finale, Stretch led UCD to a 14-8 win with a perfect 5-for-5 performance that included a double and a home run, and three additional runs scored. The triumph improved the Ags' league record to 18-13, currently tying Davis with Cal Poly Pomona for the fourth and final spot in the league tournament with two weeks to play.

Co-PLAYERS OF THE WEEK FOR THE LAST TWO WEEKS OF CCAA ACTION

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS' **Jill Howard** and **Britni Webb** have been named the California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Tennis Co-Players of the Week for the week of April 17-23.

Howard and Webb, UCD's No. 1 and 2 singles players, led the ninth-ranked Aggies to an impressive 9-0 victory over No. 17 Sonoma State in a showdown of CCAA unbeaten last week. Howard defeated SSU's Michelle Jovez (6-1, 3-6, 6-2) and Webb beat the Cossacks' Katy Messmer (6-1, 6-0) after teaming in a doubles victory over Sonoma's No. 1 team. The Player of the Week honors are the first for either player this season.

Cal State Bakersfield women's tennis players **Regina Csibi** and **Barbara Valkova** have been selected CCAA Women's Tennis Co-Players of the Week for the week of April 10-16. The No. 1 and 2 players on the No. 19-ranked Roadrunners' squad, both finished off perfect careers in CCAA individual tennis competition during that week of play. Valkova completed CCAA competition with a perfect 41-0 record in league play, and Csibi finished her CCAA career with an unblemished 36-0 mark in league play as well. Csibi's 104 career singles victories (1995-96, 1998-2000) are the most in CCAA history.
