GETTING READY TO RUMBLE

THIS WEEK . . . The final week of regular season action for baseball and softball this week has championship implications. In baseball, CAL POLY POMONA is one victory away from clinching a berth in the CCAA Championship Tournament. Standing in its way, however, is defending national champion CHICO STATE, which hosts Pomona in a four-game set beginning at 7 p.m. Friday, May 5. In softball, CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD has already clinched a tie for its ninth consecutive CCAA Championship and looks to win the title outright with a win over CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS (Fri., May 5, 1:30 p.m.) or second-place CAL STATE STANISLAUS (Sat., May 6, 12 p.m.). If Bakersfield loses all four games this week, it will share the conference championship with Stanislaus. NCAA Championship play gets underway this week with the Division II Men's Golf West Regional at the Riverlakes Golf Club in Bakersfield (May 1-3). Cal State Bakersfield, CCAA Champion GRAND CANYON, Cal State Stanislaus and UC DAVIS all compete in their quest for the national championship. In women's tennis, UC Davis hosts Cal State Bakersfield on Sat., May 6 at 10 a.m. in one of three NCAA D-II Championship West Regionals. SONOMA STATE takes on Hawaii Pacific on the islands in another West Regional, and Grand Canyon also heads to the islands to battle Hawaii-Hilo in yet another West Regional this weekend.

NOTEWORTHY STUFF... Cal State Bakersfield women's tennis player **Regina Csibi** was named the 2000 CCAA Player of the Year by the conference coaches. Csibi becomes the first athlete ever to be selected CCAA Player/Athlete of the Year four (4) times, having done so in 1995, 1998, 1999, 2000 ... CAL STATE STANISLAUS' softball team won its 40th game of the season last weekend with a 6-1 win over Cal State Dominguez Hills, marking the first time any Stanislaus athletic program has won 40 games in a season ... UC Davis assistant men's basketball coach **Bill Treseler** accepted the head coaching position at Dominican College.

CCAA BASEBALL CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT COMING UP... CHICO STATE has been selected to host the 2000 California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Championship Tournament at **Nettleton Stadium** in Chico **Thursday, May 11 through Saturday, May 13**. CHICO STATE, SONOMA STATE and GRAND CANYON have all clinched berths into the tournament. Single day ticket prices for the three-day event are \$6 for adults, \$3 for college students with a valid I.D. and \$2 for high school students and under.

CAL POLY POMONA'S PERKINS NAMED RAWLINGS PITCHER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL POLY POMONA lefty **Andrew Perkins** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Pitcher of the Week for the week of April 24-30.

A sophomore from Diamond Bar, Calif., Perkins set the tone for a Bronco sweep over San Francisco State that moved Poly to within one game of clinching a berth in the upcoming CCAA Championship tournament. In the series opener, Perkins fired a second complete-game shutout of the season, scattering seven hits and one walk and striking out eight in 9.0 innings. He faced four batters over the minimum in collecting his first Pitcher of the Year honor this season.

SONOMA STATE'S WETTELAND NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- SONOMA STATE outfielder **Tim Wetteland** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Baseball Player of the Week for the week of April 24-30.

Wetteland, a senior from San Mateo, Calif., hit a blistering .750 (12 of 16), including 3 doubles, a triple and 2 home runs, scored 9 additional runs (11 total) and drove in 9 more (11 total) to power the Cossacks to a four-game road sweep of Cal State, San Bernardino. The

wins clinched a second-straight CCAA tournament berth and positioned Sonoma into the second-place slot in the CCAA standings with four games remaining.

Wetteland went a perfect 3-for-3 with a double, 5 runs and 4 RBI in SSU's 17-9 win in the third game of the series. The Player of the Week honor is the first of Wetteland's career.

CHICO STATE'S MISTY HOWARTH NAMED CCAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CHICO STATE's **Misty Howarth** has been named the CCAA Softball Player of the Week for the week of April 24-30.

Howarth got Chico back on track by hitting .600 (6 for 10) with 4 runs and 4 RBI to lead the Wildcats to three wins last week. In an opening-game win over Cal State, San Bernardino, Howarth ripped a two-run double that capped a four-run fifth inning. The next day, Howarth again sparked a four-run rally, this time against UC Riverside, when she laced a two-run single that generated Wildcat momentum in the eventual victory. The Player of the Week honor is the first for Howarth this year.

UC DAVIS' BARRETT, BAKERSFIELD'S CISNEROS NAMED Co-PITCHERS OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- UC DAVIS pitcher **Courtney Barrett** and CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD hurler **Adriana Cisneros** have been named the CCAA Softball Co-Pitchers of the Week for the week of April 24-30 after both fired complete-game no-hitters.

Barrett, a sophomore from Yuba City, Calif., went the distance in a win over UC Riverside last Friday, giving up no runs or hits and just one walk while striking out six. The no-hitter is the second of Barrett's career and earned her the Pitcher of the Week honor for the first time in 2000.

Cisneros, a junior from Lynwood, Calif., earned two victories last week, with the latter being a complete-game no-no at San Francisco State on Saturday. Against SFSU, Cisneros did not allow a ball to leave the infield over the seven-inning stretch, enticing Gator hitters into 13 groundouts, six strikeouts and an infield fly. For the second consecutive year, Cal State Bakersfield clinched a tie for the CCAA title on the strength of a no-hitter, as stalwart Melanie Wood tossed a no-hitter at Sonoma State in 1999. The no-hitter was the first of Cisnero's career, and earned her the Pitcher of the Week honor for the first time this season. She helped her cause, going 2-for-4 with 2 RBI.

Retired CSUSB in order four times and didn't allow a runner past first base. Went 2-for-2 at the plate with 3 RBI. The next day, McCulloch fired a complete-game one-hitter, allowing 1 walk and striking out 3 in a 4-0 win over UC Riverside. After yielding a walk with one out in the third inning, McCulloch retired the next 14 batters in order.
