REGIONAL RIVALS MEET IN ROUND ONE FOR EARLY POSITION

KEY MATCHUP IN WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL HIGHLIGHTS THE WEEK . . . CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD, favored to winits 10th straight CCAA title, faces its stiffest test in the early season this week when it travels to undefeated CAL STATE L.A. for a Friday night showdown. The Golden Eagles have yet to lose a game and the Roadrunners scrimmaged Arizona of the Pac-10 to an even draw after four games. In men's soccer, CHICO STATE puts its No. 6 ranking on the line against SONOMA STATE on Saturday. The Wildcats have scored 23 goals in just five matches so far. The SSU women's soccer team, currently tied for second nationally, faces a stiff test against upstart San Francisco State, which has opened 1999 with a solid 4-1 record.

Bolanos, a 5-7 junior from Bell Gardens, Calif., powered the Toros to wins over No. 14 Cal Poly Pomona and No. 8 Grand Canyon last week. WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE L.A. outside hitter **Kasey Jungwirth** has been named the California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Volleyball Player of the Week for the week of September 6-12.

Jungwirth, a 6-0 junior from Camarillo, Calif., led the Golden Eagles to three road victories last week, including triumphs at UC Davis and Chico State to open CCAA play. She began the week with a 23-kill, 14-dig, 4-block assist performance in a three-game sweep at UC San Diego in which she hit .360.
