FIRST CCAA CHAMPIONS IN 1999-2000 TO BE CROWNED THIS WEEK

CHAMPIONSHIPS NEAR . . . The first CCAA Champions of the 1999-2000 academic year will be crowned Saturday at UC RIVERSIDE with the running of the 23rd Men's Cross Country Championship and the 19th Women's Cross Country Championship. The men's 8,000-meter race begins at 9 a.m. and the women's 6,000-meter competition gets underway at 10 a.m. The races begin and finish at Canyon Crest Drive on the UCR campus. The race for playoff berths in men's and women's soccer is heating up, with just one of four teams in each tournament having been determined thus far. In men's soccer, CAL POLY POMONA looks to wrestle the South Division lead away from Grand Canyon. North Division foes SONOMA STATE and CHICO STATE lock horns in the Napa Valley with both teams looking to secure the division's second playoff spot. The race is wide open in the women's South Division, with Pomona, CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS, CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD and CAL STATE, SAN BERNARDINO all contending for one of two available tourney berths. The CSUB women's volleyball team (12-1 in league play as of Oct. 18), in search of its 10th straight CCAA crown, can take command of the 1999 league race with a win over CAL STATE L.A., currently second in the league with an 11-2 CCAA record. The Golden Eagles have reeled off seven straight wins and the 'Runners are riding a six-game victory wave.

The second annual **CCAA Basketball Media Day** is scheduled for Monday, October 28 from 11:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. at The Los Angeles Athletic Club (Corner of Seventh and Olive Avenues). The 12 men's head coaches and 11 women's coaches will be on hand to preview the 1999-2000 season. All media are encouraged to attend. NAMED CCAA PLAYER OF THE WEEK**

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE STANISLAUS outside hitter **Michele Brown** has been named the California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Volleyball Player of the Week for the week of October 11-17.

Brown, a senior from Riverdale, led the Warriors to a pair of road victories in the Bay Area last week. In a four-game win at Sonoma State, Brown pounded 17 kills to go with 14 digs, two block solos, and a service ace. She then had 10 kills, 14 digs and two blocks in a three-game sweep of San Francisco State.

For the week, Brown averaged 3.86 kills (27), 4.00 digs (28) and 0.71 blocks (5) per game, and hit .298.
