BAKERSFIELD'S LIVINGSTON NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD forward **Jamal Livingston** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Men's Basketball Player of the Week for the week of December 6-12.

Livingston, a 6-7 senior from Bronx, NY, led the Roadrunners to much-needed CCAA victories over San Francisco State and Sonoma State last week as CSUB evened its league record at 2-2. Despite getting off to slow starts in both contests, Livingston made his presence felt when it mattered most. He scored 11 points and added seven rebounds, four blocked shots and two assists in a 56-46 win over SFSU, then was the catalyst in a decisive 67-52 win over then-No. 15 Sonoma State with 16 points, 17 rebounds, two blocked shots and a steal.

Livingston finished the week averaging 13.5 points, 12.0 rebounds and 3.0 blocked shots and shot 40.7 percent (11 of 27) from the floor. The Player of the Week honor is the second of Livingston's career.

WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- GRAND CANYON center **Veronica Gonzales** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Women's Basketball Player of the Week for the week of December 6-12.

Gonzales, a 6-1 senior from Phoenix, Ariz., earned the honor for the second straight week after powering the Lady 'Lopes to an 86-77 overtime win over Cal State, San Bernardino last week. She scored eight of her game-high 23 points in the extra period and added a season-high-tying 17 rebounds, three blocked shots, two assists and a steal to lead GCU.
