LIGHT PRE-CHRISTMAS SCHEDULES PRECEDE HOLIDAY TOURNEYS

TOURNAMENT TITLES ON CCAA WISH LISTS . . . After three grueling weeks of league play, CCAA men's and women's basketball squads take time to regroup with several non-conference games during the winter holiday season. A light schedule this week, with just a few intersectional tilts on the docket before Christmas Day. Several holiday tournaments take place soon thereafter, with CAL STATE BAKERSFIELD and GRAND CANYON hosting invitationals on the men's side, and CAL STATE STANISLAUS and Canyon putting on women's tournaments. The holidays provide little rest for Canyon, which hosts three tournaments (one men's, two women's) over a seven-day stretch. The SONOMA STATE women's team will participate in the Stanislaus tournament, and the CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS men will head to the Bay Area to compete in the Menlo Millenium Shootout. Prior to Christmas, the SAN FRANCISCO STATE men's team takes on crosstown rival San Francisco in the battle of The City on Wed., Dec. 22 at 8 p.m. The Division I Dons beat the Gators in women's basketball earlier this season (77-40 on Dec. 8). Other key non-league matchups on the men's side include UC RIVERSIDE hosting Pacific West Conference member Humboldt State (Tues., Dec. 21), and CAL STATE, SAN BERNARDINO hosting Seattle Pacific (Wed., Dec. 22) in a rematch of the 1999 West Region Championship. The Coyotes won the last battle between the two in overtime, 74-67, to win the regional and advance to the Elite Eight for the first time ever. CHICO STATE hosts Pac West members Humboldt State (Thu., Dec. 30) and Alaska Fairbanks (Mon., Jan. 3). In women's hoops, Pacific West Conference member Western Washington travels to CAL POLY POMONA (Wed., Dec. 29) and UC RIVERSIDE (Thu., Dec. 30) for a pair of telling non-league games.

GRAND CANYON'S KNIGHTON NAMED RAWLINGS PLAYER OF THE WEEK



WALNUT CREEK, Calif. -- GRAND CANYON guard **Toure Knighton** has been named the Rawlings California Collegiate Athletic Association Men's Basketball Player of the Week for the week of December 13-19.

Knighton, a 6-3 junior from Tucson, Ariz., was the driving force behind three Antelope wins this past week, including two key victories on the road.

He opened the week with a team-high 23 points on seven of 12 shooting, and added nine rebounds and two steals in a 66-60 home win over UC Riverside. Knighton then scored 16 points and added nine boards, three assists and a blocked shot as GCU handed Chico State its first home loss of the season, an 89-81 overtime defeat. Knighton tallied 10 points, 10 rebounds, four assists and two steals in the Antelopes' 58-51 win at defending CCAA Champion UC Davis to conclude the week.

He averaged 16.3 points and 9.3 rebounds, shot 48.5 percent from the floor (16 of 33) and converted 15 of 21 free-throw attempts (71.4 percent) over the three-game stretch as Grand Canyon evened its CCAA mark to 3-3. The Player of the Week honor is the first of Knighton's career.
