The second California Collegiate Athletic Association Men's Soccer Championship Tournament will take place this week at SONOMA STATE. The men's semifinals are scheduled for Thursday, November 4 and the final will be Saturday, November 6. No. 18 GRAND CANYON takes on CHICO STATE in a rematch of last year's semifinal, and No. 7 UC DAVIS plays CAL STATE DOMINGUEZ HILLS in the other semi.

1999 NCAA Men's Championship Information

Sixteen teams will be selected to participate in the 1999 NCAA Men's Championship. The championship bracket is comprised of two teams each from eight different regions. The California Collegiate Athletic Association and the Pacific West Conference are the two conferences that make up the Far West Region. The NCAA Division II Men's Soccer Championship committee will announce the pairings for the 1999 Championship on Monday, November 8. The first round of the single-elimination tournament to determine the national champion will be held the weekend of Nov. 12-14. Quarterfinals will be held the weekend of Nov. 19-21 and the semifinals and final will be held Nov. 26-28 at a site to be announced.
