1999 NCAA Women's Championship Information

Sixteen teams will be selected to participate in the 1999 NCAA Women's Championship. The championship bracket is comprised of two teams each from eight different regions. The California Collegiate Athletic Association and the Pacific West Conference are the two conferences that make up the Far West Region. The NCAA Women's Soccer Championship pairings will be announced Monday, November 8. The first round will be held the weekend of Nov. 13-14. Quarterfinals will be held the weekend of Nov. 20-21 and the semifinals and final will be held Dec. 3 and 5 at a site to be announced.
