## CALIFORNIA COLLEGIATE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION LETTER OF INTENT (CCAA LI)

1. The signing of the California Collegiate Athletic Association Letter of Intent (CCAA LI) binds you to CCAA institutions only. They are

- 2. The CCAA LI and the National Letter of Intent (NLI) will be honored by all CCAA member institutions.
- 3. CCAA institutions may elect to use the CCAA LI when a student-athlete is not eligible for the NLI or when a student-athlete is not receiving financial aid.
- 4. The CCAA LI does not admit a student-athlete into the institution. The student-athlete must meet the institution's requirement for admission.
- 5. If the student-athlete does not attend the CCAA institution named within this document for one full academic year, and enrolls in another institution participating in the CCAA LI program or CCAA institution participating in the NLI program, the student-athlete may not represent the latter institution in intercollegiate athletics competition until completing two full academic years of residence at the latter institution. Further, the student-athlete shall be charged with the loss of two seasons of intercollegiate athletics competition in all sports, except as otherwise provided in this CCAA LI or CCAA institutions participating in the NLI program. This is in addition to any eligibility expended at the institution at which initially enrolled.
- 6. Be aware of the initial signing dates and the final signing dates. Please make sure the CCAA LI is filled out completely.
