MID-CON IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

The Mid-Continent Conference has held an automatic bid to the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament since it started sponsoring the sport during the 1992-93 season. Former member Northern Illinois earned the league's first-ever bid in 1993, and the Huskies are one of eight teams to earn a trip to the "Big Dance" while a member of the Mid-Con. Another former member, Youngstown State, is the only Mid-Con representative to win a game in the NCAA Tournament. As the No. 12 seed in the East Region of the 1998 NCAA Tournament, the Penguins knocked off No. 5 seed Memphis, 91-80. Mid-Con representatives in the NCAA's have included:

Coaches, institutional sports information directors and selected members of the media are responsible for selecting the Mid-Con's all-conference first, second and honorable mention teams, All-Newcomer teams, and Player, Newcomer, Defensive Player, Sixth Man and Coach of the Year awards at the conclusion of the regular season.

The Mid-Con also selects Academic All-Conference teams, based upon a student-athlete's performance in the classroom. Student-athletes who have achieved at least sophomore academic status, lettered in the sport for which they are being nominated, and have achieved at least a cumulative 3.0 grade-point average are eligible for Academic All-Conference honors. They must be in at least their second year on campus.
