Oakland is lowest seed to win the Mid-Con Championship

With a stunning last-second three-pointer by **Pierre Dukes**, seventh-seeded Oakland downed No. 1 Oral Roberts in the Mid-Con Men's Basketball Championship game, 61-60. The Golden Grizzlies topped second-seeded UMKC, 67-63, in the opening round and sixth-ranked Chicago State, 56-53, semifinals to become the lowest seed in Mid-Con history to take home the men's basketball crown. **Rawle Marshall** earned Tournament MVP honors, while **Cortney Scott** garnered All-Tournament team accolades to lead the Oakland charge to the title. OU earned the league's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament for the first time in school history where the Golden Grizzlies went on to defeat Alabama A&M, 79-69, in the Opening Round game before falling to eventual national champion North Carolina, 96-68, in the first round.

Crowds roll in at the 2005 Basketball Championship

The fans turned out to support the Mid-Con Basketball Championship in its first year at the John Q. Hammons Arena at the UMAC in Tulsa, Okla. The first day's crowd of 4,561 represented the highest attendance for a men's quarterfinal session since 1994, when the championship was held at the Rosemont Horizon in Chicago, Ill. The overall attendance for the tournament was 17,547, including a sellout crowd of 6,005 for the Championship game, was the highest total for a men's tourney since 1994.

UMKC overcomes slow start

After opening the season with an 0-7 record, UMKC rallied to win its next 11 contests to pull into contention for the Mid-Con regular-season title. The Kangaroos finished the campaign with a 16-12 overall record and a 12-4 mark in conference play to come in second in the Mid-Con standings. The 12 wins in league action were the most in school history.

ORU takes home second regular-season title

With a 13-3 record in Mid-Con action, Oral Roberts took home its second conference regular-season title and first outright crown. The Golden Eagles dropped a heartbreaker in the Mid-Con Championship game, but earned a berth into the NIT where they lost to Maryland, 85-72. ORU's 25 overall victories are the most since the 1971-72 campaign.

Caleb makes the league Green with envy

Oral Roberts sophomore **Caleb Green** was selected as the Mid-Con Player of the Year in a vote of the league's head coaches, SIDs and selected media members. The sophomore was second in the conference in scoring (19.4) and rebounding (9.3). He was also among the conference leaders in field goal percentage and free throw percentage. Green also took home AP All-American and CollegiateInsider.com Mid-Major All-American accolades. Joining Green on the All-Conference first team were teammate **Ken Tutt**, Oakland's **Rawle Marshall**, Valparaiso's **Dan Oppland**, UMKC's **Carlton Aaron** and **Mike English**.

Valpo's Oppland is an Academic All-American

Valparaiso junior **Dan Oppland** earned a spot on the *ESPN the Magazine*/CoSIDA Academic All-America third team. It is the second national academic award for Oppland in his career. He owns a 3.49 grade point average as a physical education/sports management major. On the court, Oppland finished third in the conference in scoring.

Trio of Golden Eagles reach 1,000

Three Oral Roberts players reached the 1,000-point plateau for their career during the 2004-05 season. Senior **Luke Spencer-Gardner** and sophomores **Ken Tutt** and **Caleb Green** all surpassed the milestone. Green is just the 11th player in school history to register 1,000 career points and pull down 500 rebounds. Spencer-Gardner ended his career fifth on the Mid-Con's all-time assist list with 528 helpers.

Mid-Con teams enjoy home cooking

For the fourth year in a row, Mid-Con teams used home court to their advantage, posting a .778 winning percentage against non-conference foes. It is the fourth time in as many years that Mid-Con squads have won at least 68% of their non-conference home contests. Eight of the nine league schools posted winning records, led by regular-season champion Oral Roberts with an 11-1 mark.

Baez a welcomed addition to the Leathernecks

Senior **Eulis Baez** was a welcomed addition to the Western Illinois roster last season, taking home Mid-Con Newcomer of the Year and All-Conference second team accolades. Baez ranked in the Top 10 in the league in scoring, rebounding, steals and field goal percentage as he led the Leathernecks to their most wins since the 1997-98 campaign.

Maclies is the top Gent

Centenary senior **Chad Maclies** took on a larger role in the Gents game plan last season and he took advantage of it. In 2003-04, Maclies averaged 7.4 points and 6.3 rebounds per game, but improved on those averages in his senior season. The guard finished fifth in the conference in scoring at an 18.0 per game clip and increased his rebounding output to 8.1 boards per outing. His efforts led him to a berth on the All-Conference second team and LSWA All-Louisiana honors.

Mid-Con earns its share of Plays of the Day

Four Mid-Con men's basketball players earned their spot on ESPN's Plays of the Day this season. Chicago State's **Kevin Jones Jr.** was the first honoree with a game-winning half court shot against UMKC. Western Illinois' junior **Eliz Cepeda** continued the trend when he garnered attention on the Plays of the Week with his 80-footer at the halftime buzzer. Two days later, UMKC's **Mike English** took home Plays of the Day honors for his blocked shot on ORU's **Caleb Green**. Oakland's **Pierre Dukes** was the final Mid-Con athlete to claim a spot on ESPN with his Championship-clinching three-pointer in the waning moments against Oral Roberts.

Oral Roberts head coach **Scott Sutton** reached the 100-win mark for his career with a win over IUPUI in the Mid-Con Tournament semifinal ... ORU reached the 20-win plateau for the first time since the 1996-97 campaign ... Western Illinois' 11 overall wins and seven victories in conference play are the most for the Leathernecks since 1998-99 ... Chicago State's **Craig Franklin** reached the 1,000-point mark for his career last season ... ORU's **Caleb Green** broke the single-season Mid-Con record for free throws made (213) and free throws attempted (283) ... Chicago State earned "Team of the Week" honors from CollegiateInsider.com for the week-ending Feb. 6 ... IUPUI broke the single-game home attendance record when it announced a crowd of 2,277 at Consecro Fieldhouse against Valparaiso ... Western Illinois snapped a 28-game road losing streak during the 2004-05 campaign with an 85-68 victory over Centenary Jan. 27 ... ORU finished the season 11th in the CollegiateInsider.com Mid-Major poll ... Valparaiso (15-16) completed the season with a losing record for the first time 1992-93 ... The Mid-Con was 25th in the *Collegiate Basketball News* RPI ratings and Mid-Con teams had the sixth-ranked non-conference schedule ... Valparaiso appeared on ESPN2 for the third consecutive year with a 93-61 to then-#10 Duke.
