Mid-Con Tournament MVP

Meyerson, the Mid-Con Setter of the Year, directed Oral Roberts to its fifth straight Mid-Con Tournament title with wins over IUPUI and Valparaiso. Against IUPUI in a three-game win, Meyerson dished out 39 assists and helped the Golden Eagles to a .308 hitting percentage. Three players hit better than .300 in the match, thanks to Meyerson's distribution. In the championship match against Valparaiso, a four-game win, Meyerson upped her assist total to 53. She also added three service aces, eight digs and two blocks, while helping the team to a .288 hitting percentage. Oral Roberts will make its seventh NCAA Tournament appearance in as many years.

2001 Mid-Con Volleyball Notebook

AROUND THE MID-CON...

Chicago State (2-24, 2-10 Mid-Con): The Cougars failed to qualify for the 2001 Mid-Con Tournament... Chicago State's two league wins this season (over Western Illinois and Oakland) are its most in one year since joining the Mid-Con in 1994.

IUPUI (8-21, 6-6 Mid-Con): The Jaguars lost in three to top seed Oral Roberts in the Mid-Con Tournament semifinals... Angela Vinson was named to the all-tournament team... Sara Sparks was honored on the all-conference first team, while Jennifer Mertz was cited on the second team... Erica Kulma was named the league's first-ever Defensive Specialist of the Year.

UMKC (8-20, 7-5 Mid-Con): UMKC lost in the Mid-Con Tournament semis to second-seeded Valparaiso... Jaime Heenan was named to the all-tournament team... Sara Foster and Lindsey Zerr were both honored on the all-conference second team.

Oakland (6-22, 2-10 Mid-Con): The Golden Grizzlies failed to qualify for the 2001 Mid-Con Tournament

Oral Roberts (19-7, 11-1 Mid-Con): The Golden Eagles won their fifth straight Mid-Con Tournament title after knocking off IUPUI in the semifinals and Valparaiso in the championship match... Kristin Meyerson was named the Mid-Con Tournament MVP, while Patricia Menezes and Ivana Placko joined her on the all-tournament team... Meyerson, Maja Kuljis and Menezes were cited as first-team all-conference selections, with Kuljis earning Player and Freshman of the Year honors, and Meyerson winning Setter of the Year accolades... April Syko and Celeste Jones were named to the second team... the Golden Eagles made their seventh consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, losing to No. 2 Nebraska in three games in the first round.

Valparaiso (12-17, 10-2 Mid-Con): Valparaiso finished as the runner-up in the Mid-Con Tournament... Marion Hansen and Angie Nordquist were both named to the all-tournament team... Carrie Goodrich and Cyndi Norman were both cited to the all-conference first team... Becky Madden was named the Mid-Con Coach of the Year... Valpo's 12 wins were its most since 1997.

Western Illinois (4-19, 4-8 Mid-Con): The Westerwinds failed to qualify for the 2001 Mid-Con Tournament... Amber King was named to the all-conference second team.

ORAL ROBERTS CONTINUES MID-CON DOMINANCE

The Oral Roberts volleyball team has played in the Mid-Continent Conference for five seasons now, and they have not failed to win both the Mid-Con regular-season and tourney titles in each of those campaigns (1997's was actually a divisional title). After posting an 11-1 record during league play to clinch their fourth regular-season crown in a row, head coach Amy Farber Knowles' Golden Eagles captured their fifth consecutive Mid-Con Tournament championship by taking out IUPUI and Valparaiso in the semifinals and finals, respectively. By winning the league tournament, Oral Roberts assured itself of a seventh consecutive trip to the NCAA Volleyball Tournament. Oral Roberts is now 10-0 all-time in Mid-Con Tourney play, and 67-3 against league foes (including the regular season and tournament) since joining the Mid-Con in 1997.

ORAL ROBERTS' KULJIS NAMED MID-CON FRESHMAN, PLAYER OF THE YEAR

The Golden Eagles boasted the league's top rookie and its top player this season, and it just so happens that the same player fitted both bills. Oral Roberts freshman Maja Kuljis was an overwhelming choice for both the league's Freshman of the Year and Player of the Year honors. A first-team all-conference selection, she ranks in the league's top ten in hitting percentage, kills, digs, service aces and blocks, the only Mid-Con player to hold that distinction this season. Kuljis was joined on the all-conference first team by teammates Kristin Meyerson (the Mid-Con Setter of the Year and Tournament MVP) and Patricia Menezes.

NCAA TOURNEY TIDBITS... **ORAL ROBERTS MAKES SEVENTH STRAIGHT** NCAA TOURNAMENT APPEARANCE

Since joining the Mid-Continent Conference in 1997, Oral Roberts has been the premier team in the league. The Golden Eagles have earned five straight berths as a Mid-Con representative, and seven consecutive trips overall. Oral Roberts lost in three games to No. 2 Nebraska in the first round of the NCAA Tournament.

LONG NON-CONFERENCE WINLESS STREAK SNAPPED

Oral Roberts stopped a long losing streak for Mid-Con teams in non-conference play when it beat Arkansas-Little Rock on November 23. Mid-Con teams had lost 37 consecutive nonconference matches, dating back to the Golden Eagles' threegame win over Oklahoma on September 26.

MID-CON IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

Only two different institutions have represented the Mid-Con in the NCAA Tournament - former member Northern Illinois (1993) and Oral Roberts (1997, 98, 99, 2000, 01). Mid-Con teams are 2-6 all-time in the NCAA Tournament, with Northern Illinois posting a first-round win in 1993 over Illinois State, and Oral Roberts winning a first-round contest over Arizona in 1997

MID-CON AGAINST THE NCAA FIELD

Mid-Con teams had no success against this season's NCAA Tournament field. The league combined to go 0-15 against the NCAA field, with Oral Roberts dropping three of those matches (Colorado, Arkansas, Nebraska).

ORAL ROBERTS PREDICTED TO WIN MID-CON VOLLEYBALL CROWN IN PRESEASON POLL

The Oral Roberts volleyball team was tabbed to finish in a pretty familiar position in the preseason coaches poll this season. The Golden Eagles, who have won four Mid-Con Tourney titles in as many years, were selected to finish first in the poll, receiving six first-place votes. IUPUI, which tied Oral Roberts for last year's regular-season championship, finished second in the poll, while UMKC, which got one first-place vote in the poll, was third. Valparaiso, last year's fourth seed in the tournament, was predicted to finish in that same spot this season, followed by Western Illinois, Oakland and Chicago State.

TACHIKARA IS OFFICIAL BALL OF MID-CON AGAIN IN 2001

The Mid-Continent Conference's official ball won't change this season, as the Mid-Con and Tachikara team up again in 2001. Tachikara volleyballs will be used in all league games as well as the 2001 Mid-Con Tournament.

OAKLAND'S PIERCE SHOWING OFF SENIORITY IN STYLE

Oakland's Tess Pierce started out the 2001 season with a bang, much like any senior would outline her final year of competition. Pierce helped lead the Golden Grizzlies to four wins in seven outings; Oakland won just six matches each of the last two years. Much of the Golden Grizzlies' success comes from the play of Pierce, who led the league in hitting percentage and blocks after two weeks. Pierce, who became the first Oakland player to win Mid-Con Player of the Week honors on September 4, had 13 blocks in Oakland's three-game win over Niagara.

VALPARAISO'S HANSEN SETS NEW DIG RECORD

Valparaiso's Marion Hansen put her name in the Crusader record book on September 21, when she collected a school-record 36 digs in a five-game loss to IPFW. Through 10 matches, Hansen had accumulated at least 10 digs in seven contests, including two of 20 or more.

IUPUI'S SPARKS BECOMES SCHOOL'S CAREER LEADER IN KILLS

IUPUI's Sara Sparks reached an important career milestone in her team's four-game loss at UMKC on September 29. Sparks collected 10 kills against the Kangaroos, which moved her into first place on the Jaguars' career list in that category. Sparks is also IUPUI's career leader in attack attempts.

CHICAGO STATE SNAPS 14-MATCH LOSING STREAK THANKS TO BIG BLOCKING EFFORT

It took more than a month for it to happen, but Chicago State finally picked up its first win of the 2001 campaign on October 6 with a five-game victory over visiting Western Illinois. The Cougars, who rebounded from an 0-27 1999 season by going 5-18 last year, lost 14 straight to start this season. However, Chicago State used a tremendous blocking effort to beat the Westerwinds. The Cougars tallied a school-record 20 team blocks in the victory, as all but two Cougars had at least one block in the win.

ORAL ROBERTS EARNS REGIONAL RANKING

The NCAA released its first regional rankings on October 1, and the Mid-Con's top team was represented. Oral Roberts was ranked 10th in the NCAA Central Region, but dropped out in the next ranking on October 15.

FIRST TIME SWEET FOR CRUSADERS

For the first time in the program's history, Valparaiso beat perennial league favorite Oral Roberts on November 2. The two teams traded the first four games before the Crusaders proved victorious in the fifth game with a 16-14 win. The Crusaders' entire defensive effort helped in the win, as Valparaiso had six players post at least 13 digs in the win, and also collected 18 blocks, with three players tallying eight.
