## Mid-Con Player of the Week

UMKC's Sara Foster came up big in the final week of the regular season, which helped her Kangaroos clinch a Mid-Con Tournament berth. Foster started the week by posting 19 kills, seven blocks and hitting .531 in a five-game win over Drake. She then tied for match honors with 24 kills while hitting .389 in a five-game triumph over Oakland, a win that eventually led to UMKC's Mid-Con Tourney berth. Foster finished up the week by racking up 16 kills at Creighton in a four-game loss. For the week, Foster helped her team to a 2-1 record by averaging 4.21 kills and 0.93 blocks per game while hitting .377 (59-13-122).

## Mid-Con Volleyball News and Notes

**MID-CON VOLLEYBALL TOURNAMENT SET FOR THIS WEEKEND:** The 2002 Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament will take place this weekend in Tulsa, Okla., and regular-season champ Oral Roberts will serve as the top seed and host for the event. The Golden Eagles, winners of five straight Mid-Con regular-season crowns as well as five consecutive league tourney titles, will host No. 4 seed UMKC in the second semifinal on Friday, November 22, at 7:30 p.m. Second-seeded Valparaiso and No. 3 seed IUPUI, which tied for second in the final league standings, will square off in the first semifinal match at 5 p.m. The two winners will battle at 2 p.m. on November 23 for the Mid-Con Tourney crown and the league's NCAA Tournament berth. Valparaiso won three Mid-Con Tourney crowns (1994-96), making it one of two schools (Northern Illinois, 1992-93) besides Oral Roberts (1997-2001) to win the Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament.

**FOSTER CLOSES ON HOT STREAK:** UMKC's Sara Foster hit .377 in the final week of the regular season and averaged 4.21 kills and 0.93 blocks per game, helping her earn Mid-Con Player of the Week honors. Her 24 kills helped UMKC top Oakland in the final conference match of the season, leading UMKC to its sixth Mid-Con Tourney berth in seven years.

### MID-CON TEAM NOTES

**Chicago State (4-25, 1-11 Mid-Con):** Chicago State closed its season with a pair of four-game home losses to conference foes Valparaiso and IUPUI, extending the team's losing streak to 13 matches. The Cougars took a one-game lead against Valpo but could not hold onto the lead. Andrea Rose led all players with 18 kills, and also added seven blocks. Shannon Georges contributed a team-best eight blocks. Chicago State took another one-game lead in the season finale against IUPUI. Jennifer Harris posted a double-double with a team-best 20 kills and 12 digs, while Rose (11 kills, 14 digs), Vanessa Nicholson (35 assists, 12 digs) and Lisa Votteler (14 kills, 10 digs) all added double-doubles as well in the closely contested match. Chicago State's four wins in 2002 are its second-most since joining the Mid-Con in 1994 (the 2000 squad had five wins).

**IUPUI (12-18, 9-3 Mid-Con):** IUPUI finished up the regular season with a sweep at Western Illinois and a four-game triumph at Chicago State. Rebekah Pallikan recorded her team-best 12th double-double of the season with 11 kills and 15 digs in the win at Western Illinois, while Michelle Sobocinski and Tracy Bailey each added 10 kills in the win. The Jaguars dropped the first game at Chicago State but eventually prevailed in a closely contested match. Pallikan landed a match-high 23 kills and hit .333, while Bailey added 13 kills. Erin Jones collected a match-high 19 digs in the victory. Pallikan averaged 4.86 kills and 3.43 digs per game last week while hitting .309. IUPUI tied for second in the Mid-Con standings with Valparaiso, and will face the Crusaders as the No. 3 seed in the first semifinal of the Mid-Con Tournament. IUPUI has made four straight Mid-Con Tourney appearances. After starting the season with a 2-13 record, the Jaguars won 10 of 15 matches to close the regular season. IUPUI has broken team season records for solo blocks (67), block assists (306) and team blocks (220.0) in 2002.

**UMKC (14-17, 5-7 Mid-Con):** UMKC closed the regular season by winning of two of three matches, earning a Mid-Con Tournament berth in the process. The Kangaroos came from behind to beat Drake and Mid-Con foe Oakland in five games at home, then dropped a four-game contest at Creighton. Mid-Con Player of the Week Sara Foster was a catalyst in both wins. Against Drake, she had a team-best 19 kills and hit a scorching .531, and also had a match-high seven blocks. Jenni Watts (17), Angela Melka (11) and Liz Burton (10) all added double figures in kills. With a postseason bid on the line against visiting Oakland, UMKC came back from a two games to one deficit to win. Foster tied for match honors with 24 kills and hit .389, while Burton (11), Michele Dalzell (12) and Noe Perreira (14) all recorded double figures in kills. Dalzell picked up her first double-double of the season by adding 18 digs, and Katie Keating recorded 25 digs for her fifth 20-dig match of 2002. Foster (16), Melka (11) and Dalzell (10) all had double-figure kill totals in the loss at Creighton. Foster hit .377 in the three matches, while averaging 4.21 kills and 0.93 blocks per game. UMKC will appear in the Mid-Con Tournament for the sixth time in seven seasons, and will square off against top-seeded Oral Roberts in the second semifinal.

**Oakland (4-27, 4-8 Mid-Con):** Oakland missed out on a chance for its first Mid-Con Tourney berth by dropping league contests to UMKC (five games) and Oral Roberts (four) on the road. At UMKC, the Golden Grizzlies held a two games to one advantage but could not hold on for the road win. Beth Ann Rourk tied for match honors with 24 kills, and also added a season-best 30 digs, her fifth 20-dig performance of the season. Amanda Fowler and Courtney Varterasian added 13 and 11 kills, respectively. Rourk led Oakland again at Oral Roberts with 13 kills and 16 digs, while Fowler added 11 kills and Sara Miller nine blocks. Becca Saldana posted a pair of double-doubles in the final week of the regular season, and finished the season with 16 such performances, which ranks second in the league.

**Oral Roberts (20-8, 11-1 Mid-Con):** Oral Roberts posted a four-game win over visiting Oakland in its final conference match of the season. Ivana Placko led all players with 16 kills and a career-best five service aces, and added 11 digs for her first double-double of the season. Celeste Jones (15), Patricia Menezes (14) and Lindsey Engel (10) all recorded double figures in kills; Menezes added 13 digs for her seventh straight double-double, while Engel's 10 digs gave her her first double-double of 2002. Becky Dreher led the defensive effort with 32 digs, her league-best ninth 20-dig match of the year. Anna Moreno's four service aces moved her into second place on the Mid-Con's career service aces list (170); she needs just three more to become the conference's all-time leader in that category. Oral Roberts won its fifth straight Mid-Con regular-season championship, and will serve as the top seed in the Mid-Con Tournament for the fourth time in five seasons.

**Valparaiso (20-9, 9-3 Mid-Con):** Valparaiso ended the regular season on a solid note, extending its win streak to three matches with a four-game win at Chicago State and a three-game triumph at Western Illinois. The Crusaders tied their best four-game blocking effort ever at Chicago State, recording 21.0 team blocks, including a school match-record 17 solos. Liz Mikos did most of the blocking damage, smashing school records for solo blocks (10) and total blocks (14), and added 10 kills for her first double-double of the year. Marion Hansen and Michelle Robinson tied for team honors with 11 kills. The Crusaders had 14 service aces at Chicago State, and followed that up with 13 more at Western Illinois. Lindsey Moore had four of those aces against the Westerwinds and added a team-best 13 digs. Valparaiso tied for second place in the Mid-Con standings with IUPUI, and will serve as the No. 2 seed in the Mid-Con Tournament for the second straight season. The Crusaders will play IUPUI in the first semifinal match.

**Western Illinois (3-26, 3-9 Mid-Con):** Western Illinois closed its season with three-game home losses to IUPUI and Valparaiso. JoEllyn Dorsey and Jamie Hastings each had seven kills to lead the Westerwinds against IUPUI, while Christy Ottmers contributed 18 digs. Hastings posted her fourth double-double of the season with 14 kills and 11 digs in the regular-season finale. Western Illinois has not made the Mid-Con Tournament since the 1998 campaign.

### 2002 Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament Nov. 22-23 • Tulsa, Okla. • hosted by Oral Roberts

For the fifth straight season, Oral Roberts University will serve as host of the Mid-Continent Conference Volleyball Tournament. The top four finishers in the league standings will compete in the single-elimination event in Tulsa, Okla., with the winner receiving the Mid-Con's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Oral Roberts has won each of the last five Mid-Con Volleyball Tournaments, beating four different schools in the championship match (IUPUI, UMKC, Valparaiso and Youngstown State) during that time frame. The Golden Eagles are a perfect 10-0 in Mid-Con Tournament play since joining the league prior to the 1997 season.

Only three institutions have won Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament titles - former member Northern Illinois won the first two (1992-93), Valparaiso won the next three (1994-96), and Oral Roberts has won the last five (1997-2001).
