Patricia Menezes, Oral Roberts Sr., RS, Rio de Janeiro, Brazil

Oral Roberts' Patricia Menezes was instrumental in her team's second-place finish at the BYU Mizuno Classic. Menezes averaged 4.00 kills and 3.09 digs per game in three matches, while adding four service aces and nine blocks. Menezes, who was named to the all-tournament team, had a match-high 14 kills in a three-game sweep

of host BYU, and posted double-doubles in a four-game loss to No. 6 Florida (13 kills, 13 digs) and a four-game win over Wake Forest (17 kills, 12 digs).



Lindsey Zerr, UMKC Jr., MH, Gladstone, Mo.

UMKC's Lindsey Zerr won her second Mid-Con award in as many weeks after taking home MVP honors from the Southern Illinois Saluki Invitational. After posting a match-high 14 kills in a win at Evansville, Zerr posted team highs in kills in wins over Murray State (17), Central Michigan (14) and previously unbeaten Southern Illinois (20) as

UMKC took home the title. For the week, Zerr averaged 3.61 kills per game while hitting .269 and adding 16 blocks. The Kangaroos' 6-1 start is the best in school history.



Mid-Con Volleyball News and Notes



ORAL ROBERTS KEEPS UP WITH NATIONAL POWERS: Five-time defending Mid-Con Tournament champion Oral Roberts has been playing at a high level in the first two weeks of the season. After posting wins over defending Atlantic-10 champion Dayton and Big XII foe Baylor in the first week of the season, the Golden Eagles came back last week to sweep BYU on its own floor, push No. 6 Florida to four games, and top Atlantic Coast foe Wake Forest. Patricia Menezes, who shared Mid-Con Player of the Week honors with UMKC's Lindsey Zerr and was named to the Mizuno Classic all-tournament team, averaged 4.00 kills and 3.09 digs per game, and posted double-doubles against both Florida and Wake Forest. Oral Roberts' only losses this season have come to No. 5 Long Beach State and No. 6 Florida.

IUPUI'S PALLIKAN KEEPS POSTING BIG NUMBERS: IUPUI's Rebekah Pallikan has already surpassed her career high in kills two weeks into the season. The Jaguar junior was named to her second all-tournament team in as many weeks at the Mark Twain Invitational, hosted by Bradley, after averaging 4.55 kills per game and hitting .355. She did not have an attack error against Bradley (14-0-32) or SE Missouri State (18-0-31) in the final day of play.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Chicago State (2-7, 0-0 Mid-Con): Chicago State dropped three matches at a tournament hosted by Toledo, losing to Jacksonville State in four games, host Toledo in three, and former Mid-Con member Youngstown State in four. Andrea Rose was named to the all-tournament team after racking up 29 kills (2.64 kpg) and 11 blocks (1.00 bpg) in the three matches. Alison West posted a pair of double-doubles, and is tied for the league lead in that category with four. The three losses followed two consecutive wins by the Cougars over Belmont and Tennessee State, which was the first back-to-back wins for Chicago State volleyball since it joined the Mid-Con in 1994.

IUPUI (1-5, O-0 Mid-Con): IUPUI dropped three consecutive matches at the Mark Twain Invitational, hosted by Bradley. The Jaguars were up by two games over South Alabama before falling in five in the opening match, then lost to the host Braves in three games and SE Missouri State in four. The bright spot for the Jaguars was the play of Rebekah Pallikan, who made her second consecutive all-tournament team after racking up 50 kills (4.55 kpg) and hitting .355 in the three matches. Pallikan, who hit a sizzling .581 (18-0-31) in the loss to SE Missouri State, has reached double-figures in kills in each of the team's six matches in 2002. Karson Ammann and Tanna Smith split the setting chores over the weekend, and each collected their first career double-doubles against SE Missouri State.

UMKC (6-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): UMKC is off to the best start in school history, and pushed its win streak to five matches with four wins last week. The Kangaroos beat Evansville for the first time in school history with a five-game win on the road, then won all three matches to take home the title at the Saluki Invitational, hosted by Southern Illinois. UMKC beat Murray State in four games behind the strength of tournament MVP Lindsey Zerr's 17 kills and five blocks, then handled Central Michigan in four games, as Zerr had 14 more kills and hit .429. In the championship match, UMKC snapped the host Salukis' six-match season-opening win streak by prevailing in five games, thanks to Zerr's match-high 20 kills and Katie Keating's 18 kills and 24 digs. Zerr, who earned Mid-Con Player of the Week for the second straight week, averaged 3.61 kills and 0.89 blocks per game for the week, while Keating averaged 5.00 digs per game for the week after collecting at least 19 digs in each contest. Keating, who joined Zerr on the Saluki Invitational all-tournament team, ranks fourth on the school's career digs list (934).

Oakland (0-8, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland saw its season-opening losing streak reach eight matches after the Golden Grizzlies dropped five contests last week. Oakland lost in three games at Bowling Green, dropped its home opener to IPFW in four games, and lost to Virginia Tech (three), Akron (three) and Robert Morris (four) at a tournament hosted by Akron. Becca Saldana narrowly missed a triple-double against IPFW by collecting 47 assists, 11 digs and eight kills, while Patti Hunter put down a team-best 15 kills. The Golden Grizzlies dropped a close match to Robert Morris, which featured three Oakland players reaching double-figures in kills, led by Beth Ann Rourk's 16. In addition, Saldana (28), Rourk (26) and Katie Lozier (26) all collected at least 26 digs in the loss.

Oral Roberts (4-2, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts continued its impressive season-opening play at the BYU Mizuno Classic, as the Golden Eagles upset the host Cougars in three games on their home floor, pushed No. 6 Florida to four games, and took care of Wake Forest in four games. Mid-Con Player of the Week Patricia Menezes earned a spot on the all-tournament team after averaging 4.00 kills and 3.09 digs per game. She had a match-high 14 kills in the win over BYU (unofficially 33rd in the AVCA poll a week ago), while Anna Moreno had 38 assists and six service aces. Menezes collected 13 kills and 13 digs in the loss to Florida, while Becky Dreher posted 18 digs. Menezes led the Golden Eagles with 17 kills against Wake Forest, and added 12 digs for her third double-double of the season. Moreno just missed a triple-double with 11 kills, 49 assists and seven digs, and hit .556 (11-1-18). Menezes moved into seventh place on the Mid-Con's career kills chart (1,314) with 44 kills in three matches.

Valparaiso (2-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso opened the season by winning two of three matches for the first time since 1996, a year in which the Crusaders eventually went 26-9 and won the Mid-Con Tournament title. The Crusaders dropped a fourgame match to host Marquette to open the Marquette Challenge, but then won a three-game match over Austin Peay and a fourgame affair over Lehigh. Sara Silcox had spectacular defensive numbers for the Crusaders, as she collected at least 15 digs in each match, including a career-high and Mid-Con season-best 30 against Lehigh, and averaged 5.73 digs per game. Marion Hansen averaged 2.70 kills and 3.50 digs per game in the three matches, while Michelle Robinson posted a pair of double-double performances (11 kills, 16 digs vs. Marquette; 12 kills, 10 digs vs. Lehigh). Valparaiso averaged 3.36 team blocks per game in the opening weekend, which included 16 blocks from Heather Hynds.

Western Illinois (0-7, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois is still looking for its first win after dropping four matches at the AmeriHost Classic, hosted by UW-Green Bay. The Westerwinds lost in three games to all four of their opponents, which included Portland State, host UW-Green Bay, New Mexico State and Drake. For the fifth straight season, Oral Roberts University will serve as host of the Mid-Continent Conference Volleyball Tournament. The top four finishers in the league standings will compete in the single-elimination event in Tulsa, Okla., with the winner receiving the Mid-Con's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Oral Roberts has won each of the last five Mid-Con Volleyball Tournaments, beating four different schools in the championship match (IUPUI, UMKC, Valparaiso and Youngstown State) during that time frame. The Golden Eagles are a perfect 10-0 in Mid-Con Tournament play since joining the league prior to the 1997 season.

Only three institutions have won Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament titles - former member Northern Illinois won the first two (1992-93), Valparaiso won the next three (1994-96), and Oral Roberts has won the last five (1997-2001).
