Mid-Con Volleyball News and Notes

ORAL ROBERTS CONTINUES MID-CON DOMINATION: Not much changed in the Mid-Con in 2002, as perennial power Oral Roberts captured its fifth straight Mid-Con regular-season title, its sixth league tourney crown in a row, and made its eighth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance. Amy Farber Knowles was named the Mid-Con Coach of the Year, while six of her players, including the Mid-Con's first four-time first-teamer (Patricia Menezes), were named to the all-conference teams.

DIGS RECORDS CRUMBLE: The introduction of the libero into the collegiate game in 2002 brought forth a number of fallen records in the Mid-Con. Oral Roberts' Becky Dreher, who posted ten matches of 20 or more digs in 2002, obliterated the Mid-Con single-season digs (611) and digs per game (5.27) records on her way to being named the Mid-Con's Defensive Specialist of the Year. Valparaiso's Sara Silcox finished second in the Mid-Con in both categories (495, 4.50), and broke a Mid-Con Tourney match record with 38 digs against IUPUI in the semifinals. UMKC's Jana Lacer's 474 digs tied for fifth on the Mid-Con's season list, and she (10th, 1,206) and teammate Katie Keating (9th, 1,217) finished among the Mid-Con's all-time dig leaders.

IUPUI'S PALLIKAN BREAKS GOLDEN EAGLE STRANGLEHOLD: IUPUI's Rebekah Pallikan averaged a whopping 4.89 kills per game in 2002, which ranked second on the Mid-Con's single-season list. That helped her become the first non-Oral Roberts player since 1996 to win Mid-Con Player of the Year honors.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Chicago State (4-25, 1-11 Mid-Con): Chicago State failed to qualify for the Mid-Con Tournament for the ninth straight season. Chicago State's four wins in 2002 were its second-most since joining the Mid-Con in 1994 (five, 2000).

IUPUI (13-19, 9-3 Mid-Con): IUPUI reached the Mid-Con Tournament title match for the second time in three seasons by topping second-seeded Valparaiso in five games in the semifinals, but lost to Oral Roberts in four games in the championship match. The Jaguars became the first No. 3 seed to win a Mid-Con Tournament match since 1992. Rebekah Pallikan was named to the All Mid-Con first team and also became the first player from her school to be named the league's Player of the Year. She led the Mid-Con with 4.89 kills per game; that average ranks as the second-best ever on the Mid-Con's season list. Michelle Sobocinski was also named to the first team, while Erin Jones and Tracy Bailey were cited to the All-Freshman Team. Pallikan established a Mid-Con Tournament record with her 47 kills in two matches, and finished her third year at IUPUI with a career 3.99 kills per game average, which ranks second on the Mid-Con's all-time list.

UMKC (14-18, 5-7 Mid-Con): UMKC bowed out in the Mid-Con Tournament semifinals for the fourth straight season, losing in three games to eventual champion Oral Roberts. The Kangaroos established a school record with their 6-1 start to the 2002 season. Sara Foster was tabbed as a first-team all-league selection and Kristy Waltemeyer was selected to the All-Freshman Team. As a team, UMKC averaged 17.14 digs per game, which ranks 12th on the Mid-Con's season list. Jana Lacer compiled 474 digs, a total that ties for fifth on the league's season chart, and averaged 4.12 digs per game, which ties for 10th. Lacer (1,206; 10th) and Katie Keating (1,217; 9th) each finished their careers among the Mid-Con's all-time digs leaders, and Keating ended up as UMKC's career leader in that category.

Oakland (4-27, 4-8 Mid-Con): Oakland has failed to make the Mid-Con Tournament field in each of its first four seasons of league competition. The Golden Grizzlies placed Amanda Fowler on the league's All-Freshman Team. Oakland's four league wins were its most in a season since joining the Mid-Con.

Oral Roberts (22-11, 11-1 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts finished conference play with an 11-1 mark for its fifth straight league regular-season crown, and moved to 12-0 all-time in Mid-Con Tournament play and won its sixth straight Mid-Con Tournament title by beating UMKC in three games in the semifinals and IUPUI in four in the championship. Patricia Menezes became the third player in league history to win multiple Mid-Con Tournament MVP awards (she also won in 2000). Menezes became the first Mid-Con player to earn first-team all-conference accolades four straight seasons. She ended her career as the league's all-time leader in kills (1,669) and kills per game (4.02), and also ranks in the conference's career leaders in attacks (3,742; 3rd), hitting percentage (.299; 7th), and digs (1,235; 8th). She was joined on the all-conference first team by Anna Moreno, who also was named the Setter of the Year for the second time in her career (she also won in 2000). Moreno finished as the Mid-Con's career leader in service aces (177); her 1,325 assists in 2002 ranked 12th on the Mid-Con's season list, and her 11.94 assists per game ranked ninth. In addition, Moreno finished her career ranked fifth on the Mid-Con's career assists list (3,942) and fourth (11.04) on its career assists per game chart. Becky Dreher, who was joined on the All Mid-Con second team by Celeste Jones, Ivana Placko and April Syko, was named the Mid-Con's Defensive Specialist of the Year. Dreher established Mid-Con single-season marks with 611 digs and her 5.27 digs per game average; the latter number ranked among the nation's top five. She finished her second year at Oral Roberts as the Mid-Con's career leader in digs average (4.21), and had ten 20-dig matches in 2002, including a 40-dig effort against Arkansas State. Syko finished with 1,145 kills and 3,137 attacks in her career, which ranked 12th and 10th, respectively, on the Mid-Con's all-time lists. Amy Farber Knowles was named the Mid-Con Coach of the Year for the second time in her career. Oral Roberts made its eighth consecutive NCAA Tournament appearance, including its sixth in a row as a member of the Mid-Con, and had its fifth 20-win season in six years.

Valparaiso (20-10, 9-3 Mid-Con): Valparaiso lost in five games in the Mid-Con Tournament semifinals to IUPUI after finishing in a tie for second place in the final regular-season standings. Cyndi Norman, who led the league with 19 double-double matches, was honored on the all-conference first team for the second straight season. She finished her third year on campus with 3,487 career assists and a 10.63 assists per game average, which both rank ninth on the Mid-Con's career lists. Sara Silcox racked up a Mid-Con Tournament match-record 38 digs against IUPUI; Silcox's 495 digs rank as the second-highest single-season total in Mid-Con history, while her 4.50 average in 2002 ranks third. She finished her second year at Valpo with a career 3.52 digs per game average, which ranks fifth all-time in the Mid-Con. Heather Hynds and Michelle Robinson were named as all-conference second-teamers, and Lauren Moulton was named to the All-Freshman Team. Hynds finished her third year on campus ranked 11th on the Mid-Con's career blocks (353) and blocks per game (1.05) lists. The Crusaders, whose 19.78 digs per game average ranks second on the Mid-Con's season chart, posted their first 20-win season since 1996 under first-year coach Carin Zielinski-Avery.

Western Illinois (3-26, 3-9 Mid-Con): Western Illinois did not make the Mid-Con Tournament field for the fourth straight season, and for the ninth time in 11 seasons. The Westerwinds did place Jessica Manning on the league's All-Freshman Team; she was also named the Mid-Con Freshman of the Year. Manning's 3.88 digs per game average ranks 14th on the Mid-Con's single-season chart.

2002 Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament Nov. 22-23 • Tulsa, Okla. • hosted by Oral Roberts

For the fifth straight season, Oral Roberts University served as host of the Mid-Continent Conference Volleyball Tournament. The top four finishers in the league standings competed in the single-elimination event in Tulsa, Okla., with the Oral Roberts receiving the Mid-Con's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament by capturing its sixth straight crown.

Oral Roberts has won each of the last six Mid-Con Volleyball Tournaments, beating four different schools in the championship match (IUPUI, UMKC, Valparaiso and Youngstown State) during that time frame. The Golden Eagles are a perfect 12-0 in Mid-Con Tournament play since joining the league prior to the 1997 season.

Only three institutions have won Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament titles - former member Northern Illinois won the first two (1992-93), Valparaiso won the next three (1994-96), and Oral Roberts has won the last six (1997-2002).
