OFFENSIVE Becky Dreher, Oral Roberts Jr., OH, Prince George, B.C.

In the final week of the regular season, Oral Roberts' Becky Dreher completed her transition from libero to left side hitter in a big way, helping the Golden Eagles to a pair of road wins by posting back-to-back 20-kill matches and a pair of double-doubles. Against Chicago State in a four-game win (which clinched the No. 2 seed in the Mid-Con Tourney), Dreher put down a career-best 25 kills and added 22 digs while hitting 383; it was her second 20-20 match of the year. A night later, her team-best 23 kills and 15 digs helped the Golden Eagles push their win streak to six matches entering the Mid-Con Tourney. For the week, Dreher

averaged 6.00 kills and 4.63 digs per game while hitting .340. She has also twice been named the Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week this season. (Also nominated - Andrea Rose, CSU; Rebekah Pallikan, IUPUI; Lauren Moulton, VU)

DEFENSIVE Jenna Yurs, Western Illinois Jr., MB, Elgin, III.

In the final match of her first season at Western Illinois, Jenna Yurs did her best to help the Westerwinds in their quest for a Mid-Con Tourney bid, which fell short with a four-game loss at UMKC. In the contest, Yurs collected a match-high 11 blocks, her fourth double-figure blocks match of the season. She also added 15 kills for her third double-double of the season and hit .323. In a four-game win against Drake earlier in the week, Yurs had eight kills and three blocks (two solo). For the week, she averaged 1.75 blocks per game, and also added 2.88 kills per game. Her 1.27 blocks per game this season ranks second in the league. (Also

TOURNEY TITLE AND NCAA DREAMS ON THE LINE THIS WEEK IN "THE REGION": Four teams head to Northwest Indiana this weekend looking for a Mid-Continent Conference Volleyball Tournament title. Top-seeded Valparaiso, which won its first-ever Mid-Con regular-season crown after going 13-1 in league play, will host the event at the Athletics-Recreation Center, marking the first time the school's hosted the event since 1996. Oral Roberts, which has won six straight Mid-Con Tournaments since joining the league in 1997 and has made eight straight NCAA Tournament appearances since 1995, will be the No. 2 seed in the event, while IUPUI will be the No. 3 seed and UMKC will serve as the No. 4 seed. The winner of the Mid-Con Tourney receives the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament.

BAD BECKY: Becky Dreher was Oral Roberts' sparkplug as a libero in the first 23 matches of the season, but she's proven even more valuable in the nine matches since she has taken over as the team's left side hitter. Dreher, who twice earned Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week earlier this season, was cited as the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week after posting back-to-back 20-kill performances on the road in Oral Roberts wins. She collected a career-best 25 kills (along with 22 digs) in a win at Chicago State, and followed that up with 23 kills and 15 digs at IUPUI. She averaged 6.00 kills and 4.63 digs per game while hitting .340 for the week. Since moving to the outside, she's averaged 3.85 kills and 4.88 digs per game, and her team has gone 8-1 in that span. She continues to lead the Mid-Con with 4.98 digs per game; she should repeat as the league leader.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Centenary (5-28, 0-14 Mid-Con): Centenary completed its first season of Mid-Con play over the weekend by losing three-game matches at IUPUI and Chicago State; the losses extended the Ladies' losing streak to 19 matches. Tracee Byrd had a teamhigh 10 kills at IUPUI, while Kim Gladu and Casey Varnado each had 10 digs. Varnado averaged 3.67 digs and Gladu 3.33 over the weekend. They finished the league slate without a win (0-14), making them the 11th team in league history to go winless in a conference season, and the first since Chicago State went 0-14 in 1999.

Chicago State (8-22, 6-8 Mid-Con): Chicago State lost to Oral Roberts in four games before ending the season on a positive note by sweeping Centenary. The Cougars gave Oral Roberts a real test before falling, which ultimately ended the team's Mid-Con Tourney berth hopes. Stacey Cole put down a team-best 21 kills and added 12 digs for her 10th double-double of 2003, while Andrea Rose had 13 kills and 13 digs for her fifth double-double. Alison West added four aces and seven blocks. Rose wrapped up her Chicago State career with a spectacular match against Centenary, with a match-high 18 kills, eight blocks (four solo) and .517 hitting; she averaged 4.43 kills per game for the week. Despite posting its best season since joining the Mid-Con, the Cougars just missed making the Mid-Con Tournament. The team's eight wins were its most since joining the conference in 1994, and its six conference wins and fourth-place finish set school records.

IUPUI (16-14, 9-5 Mid-Con): IUPUI wrapped up the regular season by beating Centenary in three games and losing to visiting Oral Roberts in four. The Jaguars hit .370 (their fourth-best effort of the season) in the win over Centenary. Rebekah Pallikan had 14 kills and hit .312 in the win; she became the first IUPUI player in its NCAA Division I era to reach the 500-kill mark in a season in the win. Tracy Bailey hit .727 (8-0-11) herself in the victory. Pallikan put down a match-high 25 kills against Oral Roberts (her conference-best 13th 20-kill match of the season), hit .317, and added 14 digs for her league-best 16th double-double. Angela Vinson added 11 kills and hit .611 in a supporting role. Pallikan became the sixth player in Mid-Con history to record as many as 500 kills in a season, and needs only four kills to set a Mid-Con single-season record in that category (she currently has 533). IUPUI will rematch against Oral Roberts in the Mid-Con Tourney semifinals; the Jaguars' best finish in the league tourney since joining the Mid-Con was runner-up finishes in 2000 and 2002.

UMKC (8-24, 6-8 Mid-Con): UMKC found its way into the Mid-Con Tournament with a four-game win over visiting Western Illinois in its regular-season finale; the Kangaroos tied with Chicago State for four th in the league standings, but won a tiebreaker over the Cougars. Five players recorded at least 10 kills against Western Illinois, including Lindsey Zerr, who shook off effects from the flu and posted 16 kills and .387 hitting. Fellow seniors Sara Foster (17) and Jenni Watts (10) also reached double figures in kills to close their home careers in style. Angela Melka's 10 kills and team-best 16 digs gave her her seventh double-double of the year, while Kristy Waltemeyer had 59 assists and 10 digs for her team-best ninth double-double. UMKC, whose best finish in the Mid-Con Tournament was as the runner-up in 1997, will be making its seventh Mid-Con Tourney appearance, and will square off against top-seeded Valparaiso in the semifinals.

Oakland (6-21, 5-9 Mid-Con): Oakland closed its season by Iosing via sweeps at Central Michigan and Valparaiso. Sara Miller had a team-high 13 kills at Central Michigan, while Heather Lippert had seven kills, five blocks and hit .500. Miller's eight kills paced the Golden Grizzlies in their season-ending loss at Valpo, and Katie Lozier had 14 digs. Oakland finished in a tie for sixth place in the final Mid-Con standings, and is still looking for its first-ever Mid-Con Tournament berth.

Oral Roberts (20-12, 12-2 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts continued its hot streak to close the league play, winning at Chicago State and IUPUI (both in four games) to push its win streak to a season-high six matches. The win at Chicago State clinched the No. 2 seed in the Mid-Con Tournament. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Becky Dreher had her best week since moving to the outside hitter position from the libero spot; that started with her second 20-20 match of the season, as she collected a career-high 25 kills as well as 22 digs against Chicago State. Maja Devic added 13 kills and hit .500 in that victory. Dreher posted her third 20-kill match in seven contests with 23 kills at IUPUI; she added 15 digs for her fourth double-double of the season. Ori Zuzic (16), Kim Snow (14), Devic (13) and Cristiane Alves (13) all reached double figures in kills in the win as well, while Maura Cicala dished out a Mid-Con season-best 73 assists. Dreher averaged 6.00 kills and 4.63 kills per game while hitting .340 for the week. For the first time in six years, Oral Roberts did not win the Mid-Con regular-season title; the Golden Eagles will rematch against IUPUI in the Mid-Con Tourney semifinals, and will serve as the No. 2 seed for the second time since joining the Mid-Con.

Valparaiso (25-7,13-1 Mid-Con): Valparaiso's win over Oakland in the regular-season finale was one for the record books. The Crusaders wrapped up sole possession of their first-ever Mid-Con regular-season crown, moved to within one win of the school season record with their 25th of 2003, and gave head coach Carin Avery her 100th career win. Valpo hit .454 in the win, committing just one hitting error while collecting 50 kills. Lauren Moulton paced the Crusaders with 14 kills and .667 hitting (14-0-21). Marion Hansen collected her 11th double-double of the year with 18 kills and 11 digs, and also hit .407. Michelle Robinson added 10 kills and .435 hitting herself while Sara Silroy led all players with 18 digs. Valpa enters the Mid-Con Tournar

Robinson added 10 kills and .435 hitting herself, while Sara Silcox led all players with 18 digs. Valpo enters the Mid-Con Tournament as the top seed for the first time in school history, and will face UMKC in the semifinal round.

Western Illinois (7-22, 5-9 Mid-Con): Western Illinois beat Drake in four games in its home finale before dropping a four-game contest at UMKC, which kept the Westerwinds out of the Mid-Con Tournament. Ashley Baker was the catalyst in the win over Drake, recording a match-high 21 kills (her third 20-kill match of the season) and four aces. Patty Melinauskas added 14 kills, and Kali Landis recorded her 15th double-double with 11 kills and 14 digs. Melinauskas racked up a match- and career-high 19 kills in the loss at UMKC, hitting .485 in the process. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Jenna Yurs collected her third double-double of the season with 15 kills and a match-high 11 blocks (her fourth double-figure block match of 2003). Yurs averaged 1.75 blocks per game for the week, and her 1.27 blocks per game in 2003 ranks second in the league. The Westerwinds just missed out on their third Mid-Con Tourney appearance, finishing in a tie for sixth place (one game out of fourth), but more than doubled its win total from 2002, when they went 3-26.
