OFFENSIVE Stacey Cole, Chicago State Jr., OH, Waterdown, Ontario

Chicago State's Stacey Cole continued her hot play in three matches last week, which led to her second consecutive Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week selection (her third this season). Cole started the weekend by putting down a match-high 20 kills, hitting .316 and adding two aces in a three-game loss at IPFW: it marked her fourth straight match with at least 20 kills. That streak ended - barely - in a three-game loss at IUPUI, as she collected 19 kills and 11 digs for her team-best eighth double-double while hitting .283. She completed the weekend by racking up a match-high 18 kills and three of her team's 17 service aces in a four-game

win over visiting The Citadel, the team's sixth win of the season (its most in one year since joining the Mid-Con). For the week, Cole averaged 5.70 kills and 0.60 aces per game while hitting .286. DEFENSIVE Sara Silcox, Valparaiso Jr., L, Michigan City, Ind.

Valparaiso's Sara Silcox continued her fine season as the Crusaders' last line of defense. Her team won two of three matches, including a pair of contests on the road in league play to stay perfect (11-0) in conference competition. Silcox started her week by being the bright spot in the Crusaders' three-game loss to visiting Loyola, as she collected a match-high 21 digs. In a three-game win at Western Illinois, Silcox collected 13 digs, and she followed that up with 17 more in a fivegame triumph at UMKC. Silcox averaged 4.64 digs per game in the three contests, lifting her season average to 4.60 per game, which ranks third in the league.

She's posted 11 consecutive matches with at least 10 digs.. Mid-Con Volleyball News and Notes



VALPO INCHES CLOSER TO TITLE: Valparaiso enters the next-to-last weekend of conference play with a chance to clicnh the Mid-Con regular-season title outright. The Crusaders are currently 11-0 and are scheduled to play their final three league matches at their own Athletics-Recreation Center. Valpo has never won a Mid-Con regular-season crown, though it did capture four straight divisional crowns from 1994 through 1997. Valpo is on the verge of snapping Oral Roberts' five-year streak of consecutive regular-season championships. Last weekend, the Crusaders closed the road portion of their conference slate with wins at Western Illinois and UMKC; they went 7-0 on the road in conference play.

BACK-TO-BACK AWARDS FOR COLE: Chicago State's Stacey Cole won her second straight Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week award after averaging 5.70 kills and 0.60 aces per game to go with .286 hitting in three matches last week. Cole collected her fourth straight 20-kill match at IPFW when she put down a match-high 20 kills in a three-game loss. She ranks second in the Mid-Con with her 4.44 kills per game in 2003.

PLAYOFF PICTURE MUDDLED: With just two weeks left in the conference season, the top three teams in the Mid-Con standings - Valparaiso, Oral Roberts and IUPUI - appear to have locked up conference tourney bids. However, the battle for that fourth spot in the 2003 Mid-Con Volleyball Tournament may go down to the wire. Four teams - Chicago State, UMKC, Oakland and Western Illinois - are all within a half game of fourth place in the league standings.

HERE AND THERE...: Chicago State's win over The Citadel was its sixth victory this season, the most for a Cougar volleyball team since joining the Mid-Con in 1994... IUPUI's Tracy Bailey set a school record (15-19 attacks) by hitting .722 (13-0-18) in a three-game win over Chicago State... Oakland's Sara Miller and Stephanie Linz had 21 and 20 kills, respectively, in a four-game win at Western Illinois, the team's first-ever win in Macomb... Centenary has not yet won a game in Mid-Con play, having been swept in all 10 of its league contests.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Centenary (5-23, 0-10 Mid-Con): Centenary's losing streak reached 14 matches as the Ladies lost at home to Oral Roberts. The Ladies were led by Tracee Byrd's 10 kills, while Lauren Sledge had seven kills, 15 assists and a .389 hitting percentage. Centenary, which is 0-10 in the Mid-Con, is still looking for its first game win in league play. The Ladies host Northwestern State before closing their home schedule against Western Illinois and UMKC over the weekend.

Chicago State (6-20, 4-6 Mid-Con): Chicago State played three matches in as many days for the second straight weekend, and beat The Citadel in four games after falling at both IPFW and IUPUI. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Stacey Cole, who earned that honor for the second straight week, posted 20 kills against IPFW (her fourth straight 20-kill contest) and hit .316. Cole posted her eighth double-double of the year with 19 kills and 11 digs at IUPUI, then led all players with 18 kills against The Citadel. The Cougars racked up 17 service aces in the win, with Alison west and Christina Davis each landing five. West (12), Davis (10) and Andrea Rose (10) reach posted double figures in kills in the victory as well, which gave Chicago State six wins, its most in one season since joining the Mid-Con in 1994. Cole averaged 5.70 kills and 0.60 aces per game last week while hitting .286. The Cougars close their road schedule at Oakland and Valparaiso this weekend.

IUPUI (14-11, 7-3 Mid-Con): IUPUI pushed its season-best win streak to five matches by sweeping contests from Indiana State and Chicago State at home. After losing 14 straight contests to Indiana State dating back to 1979, the Jaguars topped the Sycamores for the first time in the series. Rebekah Pallikan had 12 kills and 11 digs for her 12th double-double, while Tracy Bailey had eight kills and hit .333. Bailey was terrific in the win over Chicago State, setting a school record (15-19 attacks) by hitting .722 (13-0-18). Pallikan hit .500 herself and led her team with 16 kills, and Tiffany Holladay contributed 11 kills. Bailey hit a combined .513 (21-1-39) in the two matches last week, and averaged 3.50 kills per game. The Jaguars' .385 team hitting percentage against Chicago State as the team's third-best effort of the year. After playing at Illinois-Chicago, IUPUI plays at Valparaiso and Oakland to close its road schedule.

UMKC (6-22, 4-7 Mid-Con): UMKC put in a bunch of time on the court last week, falling at Drake in five games, beat Oakland in four at home, and pushed visiting league leader Valparaiso to five games before ultimately falling short. Sara Foster and Lindsey Zerr collected 24 and 23 kills, respectively, in the loss at Drake; Zerr also hit .395 and added five blocks. She led the Kangaroos with 15 kills against Oakland while Foster added 11 and eight blocks. Vanessa Portela led UMKC with 17 kills against Valpo, while Zerr (15) and Foster (13) reached double figures. Kristy Waltemeyer posted three straight double-doubles last week (lifting her team-best total to eight), averaging 11.57 assists and 2.57 digs per game while also hitting .433. UMKC plays host to SW Missouri State before playing at Oral Roberts and Centenary this weekend.

Oakland (5-16, 4-7 Mid-Con): Oakland dropped a contest at UMKC before completing a regular-season sweep of Western Illinois with a five-game win on the road, its first-ever win in Macomb. The Golden Grizzlies placed four players in double figures in kills - Heather Lippert (13), Sara Miller (11), Patti Hunter (10) and Cortney Varterasian (10) - at UMKC, and Lauren Bramos collected five of the team's 11 aces. Miller came back to put away a season-high 21 kills (including eight in game four) and hit .340 at Western Illinois. Stephanie Linz added 20 kills of her own while hitting .357, and Varterasian had 10 more. Bramos and Katie Lozier tied for team defenisve honors with 16 kills. Miller averaged 4.00 kills per game in the two matches, while Bramos averaged 3.50 digs and 1.00 aces per game; her five aces against UMKC tied for the most by an Oakland player in one match in the school's NCAA Division I era. The Golden Grizzlies host Toledo and play at IPFW before hosting Chicago State and IUPUI.

Oral Roberts (16-12, 8-2 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts collected a three-game win at Centenary in its only match last week. Becky Dreher had 14 kills, and in her most extensive action of the season, Michelle Withey had 14 kills, four blocks (three solo) and hit .435. Keri Meyerson posted her second 20-dig match of the season, collecting a match-high 22 in just three games. The Golden Eagles host UMKC and Western Illinois this weekend to close their home schedule; they need four wins to record their sixth 20-win season in seven years since joining the Mid-Con.
