OFFENSIVE

Ashley Baker, Western Illinois
 Fr., OH, Effingham, Ill.

Western Illinois' Ashley Baker had a breakout performance in her team's four-game upset of league preseason favorite IUPUI in the Mid-Con opener for both teams. The rookie collected a career-best 22 kills, which nearly doubled her previous season-best of 12. Baker also hit a scorching .486 (22-4-37) and posted four blocks in the win, which was the Westerwinds' first over IUPUI since the 1999 season. It also gave Western Illinois its first back-to-back wins since that same 1999 campaign. She also added six kills and three blocks in a three-game win over Chicago State the next day, which put the Westerwinds in a first-place tie in the Mid-Con standings after the first week of conference play. For the week, Baker averaged 4.00 kills and 1.00 blocks per game and hit .400. DEFENSIVE

Jennifer Alexander, Western Illinois

Western Illinois' Jennifer Alexander didn't let too many balls fall on her side of the court last week, which helped the Westerwinds to a pair of wins in the first week of conference play. She sparkled defensively in the Mid-Con opener, a four-game win over IUPUI, tallying a league season-high and career-best 34 digs. She backed that up with 12 digs in a three-game win over Chicago State. For the week, Alexander averaged a whopping 6.57 digs per game, easily the best rate in the league. Her performance in the win over IUPUI was just the second 30-dig effort this season in the Mid-Con; she now leads the Mid-Con with her 4.75 digs per game average. Mid-Con Volleyball News and Notes

BREAK UP THE WESTERWINDS!: For the first time since the 2000 season, Western Illinois has won three straight volleyball matches. The Westerwinds topped Mid-Con preseason favorite IUPUI in four games to start league play and also beat Chicago State. Western Illinois boasted the Mid-Con Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week in the person of Ashley Baker and Jennifer Alexander; the former had a career-best 22 kills and hit .486 against IUPUI, while the latter posted a career-best 34 digs. Coming off a shoulder injury that had limited her playing time on offense this year, Jessica Manning posted back-to-back double-doubles, as did Kali Landis.

SO MUCH FOR THAT STREAK: Oral Roberts opened conference play with a win over Oakland, which extended the Golden Eagles' consecutive wins over Mid-Con foes at home to 47, dating back to 1997. That string was broken, however, by Valparaiso the next night, as the Crusaders played in a first-place tie with Western Illinois by beating Oral Roberts in three games.

VALPO ROLLIN': Valparaiso continued to be the best the Mid-Con has to offer in volleyball this season, as the Crusaders won three straight matches last week to push their record to 14-4. Valpo is doing it with a balanced offense (Michelle Robinson's 3.72 kills per game lead the team, but five players average at least 2.41 kills) and with a terrific defense. The Crusaders lead the Mid-Con and rank among the nation's best in team digs (19.11) and blocks (2.91).

HERE AND THERE...: Valparaiso's win at DePaul was its first against the Blue Demons since 1995... the Crusaders averaged 3.80 blocks per game for the week, and outblocked opponents 38-9... Valpo's Sara Silcox moved past the 1,000-dig plateau in her career at Centenary (she now has 1,009)... Oral Roberts' Becky Dreher has also moved past 1,000 career digs, with 1,088 entering this week... IUPUI's Angela Vinson set a school Division I era record with 10 blocks in her team's five-game win at UMKC... behind a season-best 20 kills from Stephanie Linz, Oakland stopped an eight-match losing streak with a win at Centenary.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Centenary (5-13, 0-2 Mid-Con): Centenary began its first Mid-Con league slate with a home losses to Valparaiso and Oakland. Kelley Heckman posted back-to-back double-doubles, lifting her team-best total to five. Heckman had 10 kills and a team-best 18 digs against Valpo, while Ashley Templer also contributed a double-double of 11 kills and 10 digs. In the loss to Oakland, Templer led the Ladies with 11 kills, while Heckman had 10 kills to go with 14 digs. Heckman averaged 5.33 digs per game for the week. Centenary plays at TCU this week before heading to Oral Roberts for its first road league match of the season.

Chicago State (1-13, 0-2 Mid-Con): Chicago State dropped three matches last week, including two in conference play, which extended the Cougars' losing streak to six matches. Chicago State gave visiting Illinois-Chicago all it could handle in its home opener, a four-game loss. Stacey Cole posted her first double-double of the season with a match-high 17 kills and 10 digs. The Cougars lost in three games to both UMKC and Western Illinois on the road. In the latter defeat, Andrea Rose recorded a season-high 24 kills and hit .457. For the week, she averaged 4.10 kills per game, while Alison West averaged 2.70 digs per game for the week, with a high of 14 at UMKC. The Cougars host IUPUI in their only match of the week.

IUPUI (5-8, 1-1 Mid-Con): Preseason favorite IUPUI dropped its Mid-Con opener on the road at Western Illinois in four games, but rebounded by holding on for a five-game win at UMKC. Tanna Smith had back-to-back double-doubles on the road trip, including a 48-assist, career-high 18-dig effort at Western Illinois, which marked IUPUI's first loss to the Westerwinds since the 1999 season. Rebekah Pallikan led the Jaguars with 20 kills in the loss, while Tiffany Holladay tied a career high with 17 kills and hit .341. Pallikan posted her fifth double-double of the season with 16 kills and 11 digs at UMKC while also adding seven blocks. Tracy Bailey led all players with 17 kills, while Smith (48 assists, 10 digs) and Angela Vinson (10 kills, 10 blocks) each posted double-doubles. IUPUI racked up 18.0 team blocks in the win, which set a school Division I era record. Pallikan's 20 kills at Western Illinois marked her seventh such performance of the season, Erin Jones' 23 digs at UMKC were a season high, and Vinson's 10 blocks at UMKC set a school Division I era match record. The Jaguars host Butler and IPFW this week before hitting the road to play at Chicago State this weekend.

UMKC (3-15, 1-1 Mid-Con): UMKC lost a pair of non-conference matches before splitting the first two Mid-Con matches of the season at home. Lindsey Zerr helped the Kangaroos push visiting Creighton to four games with a team-high 18 kills, seven blocks and .412 hitting, while Vanessa Portela added 16 kills and 10 digs. Five players had at least seven kills in UMKC's three-game win over Chicago State, with Portela, Zerr and Sara Foster leading the way with nine each. Foster also added seven blocks and hit .571 in the win. The Kangaroos rallied from a two-game deficit to force a fifth game against IUPUI but came up short. Five players - led by Portela and Angela Melka with 14 each - posted double figures in kills; Melka contributed a match-high 27 digs. Zerr averaged 3.13 kills per game for the week, while Melka averaged 4.33 digs. UMKC plays at Valparaiso and Oakland this weekend.

Oakland (2-9, 1-1 Mid-Con): After losing its home opener to Central Michigan and its conference opener at Oral Roberts, Oakland stopped an eight-match losing streak with a three-game win at Centenary. No player recorded more than five kills in either of the losses, but Stephanie Linz had a breakout effort in the victory at Centenary. She racked up an Oakland season-high to that win with a double-double of 37 assists and 13 digs, as well as a match-high seven service aces. Lauren Bramos reached double figures in digs twice last week and averaged 3.11 digs per game. The Golden Grizzlies host Western Illinois and UMKC this week in league play.

Oral Roberts (8-10, 1-1 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts opened the week by avenging an early-season loss to Arkansas-Little Rock, beat Oakland to start conference play, but lost to visiting Valparaiso in three games. That marked the first-ever home loss for the Golden Eagles against a Mid-Con opponent since joining the league; the Golden Eagles had gone 47-0 against Mid-Con foes at home prior to the loss. Five players reached double figures in kills in the win over Arkansas-Little Rock. Becky Brunelle posted a team-best 18 kills to go with 20 digs, while Kim Snow added 17 kills and Ori Zuzic 16. Brunelle collected her team-best seventh double-double of the year with 12 kills and 10 digs against Oakland, but it was Ori Zuzic who led the way with 16 kills and .542 hitting. Snow paced the Golden Eagles against Valpo in the loss, with a match-high 17 kills and .429 hitting. Snow averaged 4.09 kills per game for the week, while Becky Dreher averaged 4.91 digs. The Golden Eagles continue their six-match homestand against Arkansas State and Centenary.

Valparaiso (14-4, 2-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso picked up a four-game win at DePaul, its first over the Blue Demons since 1995, then started conference play with wins at Centenary and Oral Roberts. The Crusaders hit a sizzling .335 in the win at DePaul, as Lauren Moulton (17), Michelle Robinson (15), Marion Hansen (12) and Liz Mikos (10) all recorded double figures in kills. Moulton also hit .469 in the win, while Mikos just missed a double-double with nine blocks. Valpo won game three at DePaul by a 39-37 score, which accounts for the most points in a game by a Mid-Con team since the rally scoring era began in 2001. Mikos and Robinson tied for team honors with 10 kills at Centenary and Katie Bova recorded a double-double with 15 assists and a career-best 22 digs. Libero Sara Silcox reached the 1,000-dig plateau in her career against Centenary (she now has 1,009). Valpo's win at Oral Roberts snapped the hosts' 47-match win streak against Mid-Con opponents at home. The Crusaders were led by Robinson's 12 kills, while Mikos had seven kills and hit .700. Mikos averaged 2.20 blocks per game for the week, which lifted her season average to 1.74, tops in the Mid-Con; she also averaged 2.70 kills and hit .385. Robinson averaged 4.11 kills per game, while Heather Hynds totalled 16 blocks and hit .387. The Crusaders outblocked their opponents by a 38-9 margin, averaging 3.80 blocks per game. Valpo puts its 13-match home win streak on the line against UMKC and Western Illinois this weekend.

Western Illinois (3-12, 2-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois pushed its win streak to three matches (its longest win streak since the 2000 season) by topping preseason favorite IUPUI and Chicago State in its first home action of the season. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week posted a career-best 22 kills and hit .486 in the win, but she had plenty of help. Jessica Manning posted the first of back-to-back double-doubles with 13 kills and 18 digs, Kali Landis posted 14 kills and 21 digs of her own, and Jenna Yurs had 12 kills, seven blocks and hit .346. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Jennifer Alexander racked up a career- and Mid-Con season-best 34 digs; the win was the Westerwinds' first over IUPUI since the 1999 season. Landis came back with her team-best eighth double-double of the season with 14 kills and 10 digs against Chicago State, while Manning - who was playing at full strength for the first time this season - added 13 kills and a match-high 19 digs. Baker averaged 4.00 kills and 1.00 blocks per game for the week while hitting .400, while Alexander averaged a whopping 6.57 digs per game over the weekend and took over the Mid-Con lead in that category at 4.75 per game. Western Illinois plays at Oakland and Valparaiso this weekend.
