Valparaiso's Cyndi Norman guided her team to its own Popcorn Classic title over the weekend, as the Crusaders remained undefeated (8-0) on the season. Norman averaged 12.12 assists per game in three matches, and was named to the all-tournament team for her efforts. Norman's distribution helped the Crusaders hit .242 as a team in three matches. Norman helped that cause

herself by hitting .600 (9-0-15); she also averaged 2.38 digs per game. Norman has moved into sixth place on the Mid-Con's career assists list (3,782). IUPUI's Rebekah Pallikan, who was named the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week the first week of the season, showed off her defensive prowess on her way to all-tourney honors at Indiana's TSI/Taylor Invitational. Pallikan collected 14 blocks (1.27 per game) and 37 digs (3.36 per game) in three matches. She collected her first two double-doubles of the season, with 20 kills and 13

digs and six blocks against UW-Green Bay, and 20 kills, 16 digs and six blocks against SE Missouri State. She also averaged 4.55 kills per game in three matches, and leads the Mid-Con with her 5.33 kills per game. VALPO MAKES MID-CON HISTORY: Northern Illinois dominated the early days of Mid-Con volleyball, going a combined 58-11 in two seasons and winning back-to-back Mid-Con regular-season and tournament titles. Oral Roberts has ruled the roost since joining the league in 1997, with five 20-win seasons in six years and six consecutive Mid-Con Tourney and NCAA Tournament appearances. However, no Mid-Con volleyball squad has ever accomplished what head coach Carin Avery's Valparaiso squad has done this season. The Crusaders' 8-0 start is the best in Mid-Con volleyball annals (Western Illinois and Illinois-Chicago both started the 1993 season with 5-0 records). Valpo won its second straight tournament, its own Popcorn Classic, over the weekend. A balanced group, six different players have led the squad in kills in the first eight matches of the season, led by Michelle Robinson's 3.91 kills per game. However, it's have cled the squad in kills in the first eight matches of the season, led by Michelle Robinson's 3.91 kills per game, and is limiting opponents to .112 hitting. Liz Mikos (1.57), Sarah Schmalz (1.10) and Heather Hynds (1.00) are all averaging at least a block per game, while libero Sara Silcox paces the defense with 4.24 digs per game. Cyndi Norman, this week's Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week, averages 11.80 assists per game. The two-time first-team All Mid-Con honoree has moved into sixth place on the Mid-Con's career assists chart (3,782).

OFFENSE, DEFENSE - PALLIKAN DOES IT ALL: A week after being named the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week, IUPUI's Rebekah Pallikan earned Defensive Player of the Week honors after being named to her second straight all-tourney team at the Indiana TIS/Taylor Invitational. Pallikan averaged 3.36 digs and 1.27 blocks game in three matches over the weekend. She continues to lead the Mid-Con with her 5.53 kills per game, and has recorded at least 20 kills in four of seven matches in 2003.

HERE AND THERE...: Centenary's volleyball squad landed a Mid-Con season-high 19 service aces in a three-game win over Arkansas-Pine Bluff... Oral Roberts' Orieta Zuzic has averaged 5.05 kills per game in her first six matches on campus, and has reached double figures in kills in all but one match... IUPUI's 4-3 start is team's best since moving to the NCAA Division I level prior to the 1998 season... UMKC coach Steve Dallman earned his 100th career victory against UAB.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

Centenary (3-6, 0-0 Mid-Con): After extending its season-opening losing streak to five matches, Centenary took three straight contests - defeating Grambling State, Prairie View A&M and Arkansas-Pine Bluff - before losing to Northwestern State in the championship match of the Centenary Volleyball Tournament. Ashley Templer, who averaged 3.30 kills and 2.55 digs per game in the week's six contests, was named to her second consecutive all-tournament team, on which she was joined by teammate Gretchen Conlin. Templer had a season-high 18 kills at Jackson State, and posted her first career double-double with 16 kills and 10 digs against Prairie View A&M. The Ladies racked up a Mid-Con season-high 19 service aces in the win against Arkansas-Pine Bluff, with Kelley Heckman and Lauren Sledge serving up five and four, respectively. Centenary faces No. 1-ranked Southern California in the first match at the Texas A&M Invitational this weekend.

Chicago State (0-4, 0-0 Mid-Con): Chicago State dropped its four matches of the season to extend its losing streak to 17 matches, dating back to last season. The Cougars gave state-rival Northern Illinois more than it bargained for in their opener, as

they forced the hosts to come from behind to win each game of the match. Chicago State also dropped three contests at the Portland Pilot Review. Transfer Stacey Cole, who starred at Louisiana-Lafayette last season, averaged 3.17 kills per game in her first four matches at Chicago State, and collected a team-high nien service aces, including three each against Portland and Portland State. Chicago State remains in Portland this week, with five matches on the schedule, including the PSU Viking Classic.

IUPUI (4-3 0-0 Mid-Con): IUPUI dropped two of three matches at the Indiana TIS/Taylor Invitational. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Rebekah Pallikan continued her all-around solid play for the Jaguars, averaging 4.55 kills, 3.36 digs and 1.27 blocks per game in the event. She was named to her second straight all-tournament team in 2003, thanks in part to her first two double-doubles of the season. She had 20 kills, 13 digs and six blocks in a four-game loss to then-undefeated UW-Green Bay, and added 20 kills, 16 digs and six blocks in a win over SE Missouri State. She has racked up at least 20 kills in four of seven matches this season, and leads the Mid-Con with her 5.53 kills per game. Tracy Bailey had a terrific tournament for the Jaguars as well, which included a career-high 18 kills and .455 hitting against SE Missouri State; she has hit at least .300 in all but one match this season. IUPUI is off to a 4-3 start, its best since moving to the NCAA Division I level. IUPUI is idle this week.

UMKC (1-6, 0-0 Mid-Con): UMKC lost three of four matches at Northern Arizona's Fiesta Bowl Classic, but managed to pick up its first win of the season, a five-game marathon against UAB. Jenni Watts, a former Western Illinois women's basketball player, posted three straight double-digit kill totals against UTEP (11), UAB (12) and Northern Arizona (11). Sara Foster racked up 19 kills and hit .425 in the win against UAB, and had 15 kills and hit .636 against Northern Arizona. Kristy Waltemeyer was named to her second straight all-tourney team after averaging 10.07 assists per game in the event. Heather Stapleton was cited as the tourney's Most Outstanding Libero after collecting 2.60 digs per game in four matches. The win against UAB was the 100th of head coach Steve Dallman's career. UMKC plays at No. 12/16 Kansas State this week before hosting the UMKC Kangaroo Classic this weekend.

Oakland (0-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland opened the year with a three-game loss at Eastern Michigan. The Golden Grizzlies were led by Stephanie Linz in head coach Dave Schmidlin's debut, as she collected a team-high seven kills and hit .389 (7-0-18). After a nine-day layoff, Oakland will participate in the Cleveland State Invitational this weekend.

Oral Roberts (2-4, 0-0 Mid-Con): For the second straight week, Oral Roberts won one of three matches, this time at the Texas-Arlington Invitational. The Golden Eagles came from behind to beat the host Mavericks, the 2002 Southland Conference champs, in four games, thanks to Orieta Zuzic, who racked up a match-high 24 kills and hit .290. She led four players in double figures in kills, while Becky Brunelle (14, 15) and Cristiane Alves (11, 11) added kills-digs double-doubles. Becky Dreher, who aveaged 5.10 digs per game for the week, collected a match-high 25 digs against Texas-Arlington. Zuzic averaged 4.80 kills per game for the week; she's reached double figures in kills in five of six matches, and leads the team with her 5.05 kills per game in 2003. Oral Roberts hosts Kansas this week before playing in the Wichita Classic this weekend.

Valparaiso (8-0,0-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso extended its school record for "best start" to 8-0 by winning its own Popcorn Classic, taking matches from previously unbeaten Cleveland State, as well as East Tennessee State and Indiana State. The title is the second in a row for the Crusaders, whose 8-0 start is the best in Mid-Con volleyball history. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Cydni Norman averaged 12.12 assists per game, hit .600 (9-0-15) and guided Valpo to .242 hitting for the weekend. She was joined on the all-tourney team by tourney MVP Sarah Schmalz (.552 in three matches) and Michelle Robinson (4.43 kpg). Robinson posted her first double-double of the season with a team-high 19 kills and 10 digs against Indiana State, while Norman (58 assists, 13 digs) and Marion Hansen (16 kills, 19 digs) also posted double-doubles. Opponents are hitting just .112 against the Crusaders, thanks in part to their 19.30 digs and 2.89 blocks per game as a team. Norman has moved into sixth place on the Mid-Con's career assists list (3,782). Valpo puts its unbeaten streak on the line this week with a match at No. 15/NR Notre Dame, as well as an appearance at the Northern Illinois Invitational.

Western Illinois (0-6, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois dropped three matches at lowa State's Cyclone Challenge, but all three were to programs from major conferences (Kentucky-SEC, lowa State-Big XII, lowa-Big Ten). Kali Landis was named to her second straight all-tourney team after averaging 3.30 kills per game in the event. She led the squad with 17 kills against Kentucky in a four-game loss, and posted her fourth double-double of the season with 12 kills and 12 digs against lowa State. After playing Saint Louis in a mid-week match, the Westerwinds play at the Eastern Michigan Tourney this weekend.
