After entering the game in the 29th minute, he tied the match in the 32nd minute, and added another score in the middle of the second half. He assisted on Daniel Bustos' game-winner in the 107th minute.

Western Illinois' Chris Frenz held his own in goal as his team beat UMKC, 3-2, in double overtime. Frenz allowed a pair of scores in the contest, but survived a flurry of shots late in the second half. Six of Frenz's seven saves in the contest came after halftime, including five in the second half and a diving stop in the first overtime. Frenz's goals against average is 0.69 this season; he moved his record to 5-3 with the win, while Western Illinois evened its season mark at 7-7.

Mid-Con Men's Soccer News and Notes

INTERESTING CONFERENCE RACE SHAPES UP: With three full weeks of conference play gone, all six Mid-Con men's soccer teams are in the hunt for a Mid-Con Tournament berth. With the wins by Oakland and Western Illinois last week, all six league teams sit within a game of each other in the standings: Oakland, Valparaiso and Western Illinois are tied for first with a 2-1 record, and IUPUI, UMKC and Oral Roberts are tied for fourth at 1-2.

THIS GUY'S EVERYWHERE: Western Illinois' Justin Langan continued his spectacular dual season over the weekend. He kicked a 47-yard field goal and seven extra points in his football team's win over Indiana State, then made an immediate impact in the Leathernecks' win over UMKC on the soccer field. Just three minutes after entering the match off the bench, Langan provided the game-tying goal in the first half. He scored the go-ahead goal in the second half, then assisted on Daniel Bustos' game-winner in the 107th minute, which gave Western Illinois a 3-2 win. Langan was named the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts.

CENTENARY COLLEGE TO JOIN MID-CON: Next season, the Mid-Con will sponsor a seven-team men's soccer league for the first time since 1997. Centenary College of Louisiana will begin league play in 2003, but got a nice start on its future league foes last week. The Gents went 3-0 against Mid-Con teams last week, beating Oral Roberts (2-1), Valparaiso (5-2) and IUPUI (2-1, 20T). Centenary is 3-2 against Mid-Con teams this season.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (2-12-1, 1-2 Mid-Con): IUPUI lost to future Mid-Con opponent Centenary, 2-1 in double overtime, in its only match last week. Mike Sullivan tied the match in the 89th minute, only to see the visiting Gents score the game-winner in the 107th minute. Drew Deffner made four saves in the loss; he's made five straight starts, and posted a 2.13 goals against average in that time frame. IUPUI played without leading scorer Ben Higginbotham, who sat out the match after receiving his fifth yellow card of the season last week.

UMKC (4-7-1, 1-2 Mid-Con): UMKC dropped a 3-2 decision in double overtime at Western Illinois. Dan Hilson gave UMKC an early lead, and Brian Wallace tied the match in the 77th minute. Hilson's goal was the tenth of his career, which ranks tenth on the school's career list. In addition, his 37 career points ties for sixth on the school's all-time list. The Kangaroos have lost four of their last five matches, and are 0-2-1 in overtime after winning their season-opener in an extra session.

Oakland (6-5-2, 2-1 Mid-Con): Oakland fell to Ohio State at home (3-0) before coming from behind to pick up a road conference win at Oral Roberts (3-0). Jeff Wiese made seven saves in the loss against Ohio State. After falling behind by a 2-0 score in the first 17 minutes of the match, the Golden Grizzlies stormed back. Goals by Chris Edwards in each half knotted the score, and Mike Matalavy provided the game-winner in the 69th minute. Oakland is ranked sixth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Region this week, its highest rank of the season.

Oral Roberts (6-7, 1-2 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts continued its downward slide last week, losing for the seventh time in eight matches. The Golden Eagles fell at future Mid-Con foe Centenary (2-1), then dropped a home conference match to Oakland (3-2). Ryan Bush gave Oral Roberts the lead at Centenary, but the host Gents got a pair of scores off the bench in the second half to take away the win. Goals by Trey Vaut and Sun Potter put the Golden Eagles up early against Oakland, but Oakland recovered to pick up the victory.

Valparaiso (5-8-1, 2-1 Mid-Con): Valparaiso dropped its lone match last week to future Mid-Con league foe opponent Centenary, 5-2. Brian Hirth scored his first career goal in the match, while Ben Olson added his team-best eighth of the season in the waning moments of the game. Centenary scored four second-half goals off of reserve goalie Marc Cilfone.

Western Illinois (7-7, 2-1 Mid-Con): Western Illinois pulled its record even on the season with a 3-2, double-overtime win at home against UMKC. After booting a field goal and seven extra points in the Leatherneck football team's win over Indiana State, Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Justin Langan became the difference maker in the win. He scored just three minutes after coming off the bench in the first half, and gave Western Illinois the lead in the middle of the second half. Finally, Langan assisted on Daniel Bustos' game-winning score in the 107th minute. The goal was Bustos' first of the season. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Chris Frenz allowed two goals, but made six of his seven saves after halftime, including a game-saving diving stop in the first overtime. On days when Langan plays both football and soccer, Western Illinois is undefeated in each sport (3-0 in football, 3-0 in soccer).

2002 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament Nov. 15-17 • hosted by top seed

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament will be held on November 15 and 17, but the site of the tournament is still up for grabs. The team that earns the top seed for the single-elimination tourney will also serve as the host; the top four finishers in the league standings will qualify for the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Three teams have won their first Mid-Con Tournament crowns in the past three years - Oral Roberts (1999), IUPUI (2000), and UMKC (2001), while Valparaiso captured its only title in 1996. Former members Central Connecticut State (1994-95) and Howard (1997-98) are the only teams to post repeats.
