UMKC's Dan Hilson helped the Kangaroos to a big win in their Mid-Con opener over visiting IUPUI. UMKC established school records for goals in a match and margin of victory in the 7-1 triumph, and Hilson had a hand in each of the team's middle three scores. He tallied the

Kangaroos' third and fourth goals, then assisted on the fifth. Hilson's outburst made him only the sixth player in school history to record as many as five points in a match. His assist gave him 16 for his career, which tied the school career record in that category.

final 45 minutes. Rzepka also added some offensive support to help seal the win, assisting on Philip Braathen's game-winning tally in the 30th minute, and also helping on Shahar Ktovim's score ten minutes later.

Mid-Con Men's Soccer News and Notes



WITH CONFERENCE PLAY IN FULL SWING, THREE TIED ATOP THE LEADER BOARD: All six Mid-Con men's soccer teams have at least one conference match under their belts, and after a full weekend of action three teams are tied at the top of the league standings - UMKC, which beat IUPUI by a 7-1 count; Oakland, which topped Western Illinois by a 4-1 score; and Oral Roberts, which held off Valparaiso, 2-1.

UMKC SPREADS THE WEALTH IN BIG WIN: UMKC snapped a two-match losing streak and took a step towards getting back to the .500 mark with a resounding 7-1 win over visiting IUPUI to open league play. Five different players scored a goal in the victory, including Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Dan Hilson and Mike Rosenthal, who became the sixth and seventh players in school history to record as many as five points in a match (each had two goals and an assist). UMKC tied school records for goals in a match and margin of victory while moving its record to 4-5-1.

ORAL ROBERTS WELCOMES POTTER'S RETURN: Oral Roberts' Sun Potter scored 16 points in the first five matches of the season, all of which were Golden Eagle wins. However, Potter suffered a shoulder injury and missed the team's next four contests, all of which it lost. Potter finally returned to the line-up at Valparaiso, and he didn't take long to make an impact. He netted the first goal of the match in the fifth minute, and assisted on Trey Vaut's game-winner in the 32nd minute. Potter now has 19 points in just six matches this season, on eight goals and three assists.

OPENING VICTORIES ARE PAR FOR THE COURSE AT OAKLAND: Now in its fourth year playing in the Mid-Con, Oakland has made a habit of winning its conference-opening match. The Golden Grizzlies did the trick for the fourth straight season, topping visiting Western Illinois by a 4-1 score. Four different players accounted for the team's goals, and Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Ryan Rzepka had a pair of assists while helping limit Western Illinois to just seven shots in the match.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (0-10-1, 0-2 Mid-Con): IUPUI suffered a big loss in its only match last week, falling at UMKC (7-1) in league play. Down just 2-0 at the break, the Jaguars allowed the Kangaroos five second-half goals, including four in an 18-minute span. Ricky Del Toro spoiled the shutout with his first career goal in the 87th minute.

UMKC (4-5-1, 1-0 Mid-Con): UMKC tied a pair of school records in its only match last week, as the Kangaroos took care of IUPUI (7-1) at home in their league opener. UMKC tied school single-match records for goals and margin of victory in the triumph. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Dan Hilson became the sixth player in school history to record as many as five points in a match when he scored the team's third and fourth goals and assisted on the fifth. Mike Rosenthal joined him on that list, becoming the seventh by scoring the team's first and last goals and adding an assist. Tim Collico had the game-winner, while Drew Perkins and John Roy also joined in the scoring. Hilson's assist was the 16th of his career, tying him for the school career record in that category. Perkins' goal was the 11th of his career, tying him for eighth on the school's career list.

Oakland (4-3-2, 1-0 Mid-Con): In its sole contest, Oakland won its Mid-Con opener for the fourth straight year, beating Western Illinois (4-1) at home. All of the match's scoring came in a 22-minute span in the first half. Doug Rice put the Golden Grizzlies on the board with a penalty kick, and after Western Illinois tied it up on its own penalty kick, Oakland scored three goals in an 11-minute span before halftime. Philip Braathen netted the game-winner a few minutes after the Leathernecks tied the contest, and Stephen Bentley and Shahar Ktovim added insurance scores. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Ryan Rzepka helped limit Western Illinois to seven shots for the match (five in the second half), and assisted on goals by Braathen and Ktovim. Oakland is ranked tenth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Region this week.

Oral Roberts (6-4, 1-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts snapped a four-match losing streak by beating Valparaiso on the road (2-1) in its conference opener. Sun Potter returned from injury to make a big impact for the Golden Eagles; he took a Trey Vaut feed in the fifth minute and scored to get Oral Roberts on the board, and returned the favor for Vaut in the 32nd minute on the gamewinner. Hector Zapata made five saves in goal for the Golden Eagles, who are ranked tenth in the NSCAA Midwest Region this week. In just six matches this season, Potter has 19 points (8 goals, 3 assists); Oral Roberts is 6-0 when he plays and winless when he's not in the line-up.

Valparaiso (3-7-1, 1-1 Mid-Con): Valparaiso lost a home conference match to Oral Roberts (2-1), then fell on the road at state-rival Butler (2-0). Valparaiso tried to come back against Oral Roberts after allowing two first-half tallies, but Ben Olson's goal in the 76th minute wasn't enough. Marc Cilfone made five saves in the loss, then made six in the defeat at Butler, who also scored twice in the first half and held on for the win. The Crusaders play six of their last seven matches of the year on the road, including three league match-ups.

Western Illinois (5-7, O-1 Mid-Con): Western Illinois dropped a 4-1 decision at Oakland to start conference play, but rebounded to top IPFW (2-1) in overtime. Lorenzo Zignago tied the Oakland match in the 27th minute on a penalty kick, but the Leathernecks allowed three scores in the next 15 minutes, which sealed up the win. The Leathernecks fell behind early at IPFW, but Justin Langan knotted the contest in the middle of the first half, and Jake Horn took a Boris Bacsovics pass and put in the game-winner in the 98th minute. Chris Frenz did not allow a goal in two games of relief for the Leathernecks, making eight saves in 97:28 of action.

2002 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament Nov. 15-17 • hosted by top seed

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament will be held on November 15 and 17, but the site of the tournament is still up for grabs. The team that earns the top seed for the single-elimination tourney will also serve as the host; the top four finishers in the league standings will qualify for the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Three teams have won their first Mid-Con Tournament crowns in the past three years - Oral Roberts (1999), IUPUI (2000), and UMKC (2001), while Valparaiso captured its only title in 1996. Former members Central Connecticut State (1994-95) and Howard (1997-98) are the only teams to post repeats.
