UMKC's Dan Hilson helped the Kangaroos split a pair of matches last week, picking up a goal and an assist in the process. In a 4-2 loss to Rockhurst, Hilson fed Drew Perkins with his 14th career assist, which ranks him second on the school's all-time list. Hilson then scored the game-winning goal on a penalty kick with four seconds left in regulation in UMKC's 1-0 win over visiting Drury. Both of Hilson's scores this season have been game-winning, penalty kick goals; he is tied for the team lead in scoring with six points.

Mid-Con Men's Soccer News and Notes

AND BACK TO EARTH...: After posting a combined 7-4-1 record a week ago, Mid-Con men's soccer teams didn't fare as well last week. The six league teams combined to post a 1-8-1 record last week, with IUPUI, Valparaiso and Western Illinois all suffering a pair of losses. Four of the eight losses were to NSCAA region-ranked teams, and four of the eight losses were also by only one goal.

HILSON, BISHOP EARN PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARDS: Despite the fact that both of their teams suffered losses last week, UMKC's Dan Hilson and Oral Roberts' Dan Bishop were honored as the Mid-Con Offensive and Defensive Players of the Week, respectively. Hilson picked up his 14th career assist (second all-time at UMKC) against Rockhurst, and scored the game-winning goal with a penalty kick in the 90th minute in a 1-0 win over Drury. Bishop came off the bench to score his second goal of the season, knotting the match against No. 24 (NSCAA) Tulsa, which the Golden Eagles would ultimately lose, 2-1.

LEATHERNECKS' LANGAN HONORED FOR FOOTBALL EFFORTS: His soccer team may have dropped a pair of matches, but Justin Langan's Leatherneck football squad pulled off a huge win at Northern Illinois, 29-26. Langan's efforts in that game earned him Gateway Conference Special Teams Player of the Week honors. He hit three field goals - including a pair of career-long 47-yarders - and two extra points, accounting for 11 points. Western Illinois is 3-0 for the first time since the 1999 season, and is ranked No. 12 in the Sports Network I-AA Top 25.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (0-7-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): IUPUI lost a pair of games last weekend, falling at San Diego State (4-1) and No. 13/15 San Diego (3-0). Against San Diego State, the Jaguars outshot the Aztecs by a 13-12 margin, but the hosts were quite efficient, scoring four times on six-second half shots. Ben Higginbotham's header off of a Shayne McIntyre free kick in the 76th avoided the shutout. After relieving Drew Deffner in that match, Dave Palmer earned a start against San Diego and made nine saves while facing 31 shots. IUPUI has used more than one goalie in four of eight matches this season. Higginbotham now ranks seventh on the school's career points list (44), eighth in career goals (16) and is tied for tenth in career assists (11).

UMKC (3-3-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): UMKC started the week by dropping a 4-2 decision at home to Rockhurst, but then topped visiting Drury, 1-0. The Rockhurst match featured five goals in the first 32 minutes. After falling behind by a 2-0 score in the first 19:24 match, Drew Perkins and Ryan Barber netted their second scores of the season to knot the match. Goalie Beau Williams received a red card near the end of the match, which gave Todd Dohلمان a start against Drury, who made three saves while posting his first career shutout. Dohلمان's start in goal was the first for someone besides Williams since October 29, 2000. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Dan Hilson netted the game-winning goal on a penalty kick with just four seconds left in regulation. Hilson, who also had an assist earlier in the week, ranks second on the school's career assists list with 14. The Kangaroos are ranked tenth in the NSCAA Midwest Region this week.

Oakland (2-2-2, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland had its match against Michigan rescheduled to November 10 because of heavy rain, and then rallied to post a 1-1 tie at Akron. The Golden Grizzlies put only one of their nine shots on goal, but Doug Rice made it count when he scored the equalizer in the 63rd minute off of an Anders Vollen chip pass. Jeff Wiese made two saves in the tie, which featured 52 fouls. Oakland has not lost in its last four matches, but dropped out of the NSCAA Great Lakes Region rankings after sitting in tenth last week.

Oral Roberts (5-2, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts just missed an upset of No. 24 (NSCAA) Tulsa, losing by a 2-1 score to its crosstown rival in front of 1,812 fans in its home opener. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Dan Bishop came off the bench to knot the match late in the first half, taking a Trey Vaut feed and blasting it in from eight yards out. Tulsa answered just more than two minutes later however, and the Golden Eagles couldn't find the equalizer in the second half, though several opportunities hit the crossbar or goalpost. Oral Roberts, which has lost two straight matches (both to nationally ranked foes), is still ranked seventh in the NSCAA Midwest Region this week.

Valparaiso (2-5-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso dropped a pair of matches to NSCAA Great Lakes Region-ranked foes, at No. 22 (NSCAA) Michigan State (4-0) and at home to Detroit (2-1). The Crusaders surrendered a hat trick to the Spartans' Brett Konley and were outshot by a 20-10 margin in the loss. Valpo took a lead in the second minute against Detroit on Ben Olson's score, but the Titans scored twice in the seven minutes late in the second half to take away the win. Jeff Oleck made nine saves in the loss.

Western Illinois (2-5, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois fell to state rivals Eastern Illinois and Northern Illinois by identical 1-0 counts at home. The Leathernecks put nine shots on goal against Eastern Illinois, compared to five for the visitors, but couldn't find the back of the net. After giving up a first-half goal against Eastern Illinois in a loss, Western Illinois did the same thing against Northern Illinois. Despite not scoring in two matches, Western Illinois outshot its foes by a 23-20 margin for the week. The Leathernecks' goalie duo of Chris Frenz (0.75) and Armen Tonianse (2.00) have combined to post a goals against average of 1.29, compared to a 1.76 GAA last season for Tonianse and Jacob Gutierrez. After playing in both matches, the Leathernecks' Justin Langan booted three field goals - including a pair of career-long 47-yarders - and two extra points in the football team's upset win at Northern Illinois. Langan, who tied a school record by hitting the three field goals, was named the Gateway Conference's Special Teams Player of the Week.

2002 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament Nov. 15-17 • hosted by top seed

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament will be held on November 15 and 17, but the site of the tournament is still up for grabs. The team that earns the top seed for the single-elimination tourney will also serve as the host; the top four finishers in the league standings will qualify for the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Three teams have won their first Mid-Con Tournament crowns in the past three years - Oral Roberts (1999), IUPUI (2000), and UMKC (2001), while Valparaiso captured its only title in 1996. Former members Central Connecticut State (1994-95) and Howard (1997-98) are the only teams to post repeats.
