## Mid-Con Men's Soccer News and Notes



DOUBLE OR NOTHING FOR WESTERN ILLINOIS: Western Illinois has four wins this season, and a Leatherneck has tallied a multi-goal match in each of the victories. Justin Langan scored twice against UW-Green Bay in a 3-0 win on Sept. 7, and Lorenzo Zignago did the same against Drury in a 3-0 win on Sept. 14. Last week, Langan repeated his feat in a 2-1 win over Wright State, and Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Bob Wallace tallied a pair of scores in a 3-1 win over Centenary.

MID-CON KEEPS TWO REGION-RANKED TEAMS: For the first time this season, UMKC has fallen out of the NSCAA Midwest Region rankings, but the Mid-Con still has two teams that are regionally ranked. Oakland is tied for tenth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Region after its 2-1 upset of previously unbeaten Detroit, and Oral Roberts is tied for tenth in the NSCAA Midwest Region.

IUPUI (0-9-1, 0-1 Mid-Con): IUPUI dropped both of its matches over the weekend, falling at Valparaiso in the leagueopener (2-0) and at Kentucky (4-0). The Jaguars failed to find the back of the net on the weekend, which extended the team's winless streak to 11 matches, dating back to last season's Mid-Con title game.

UMKC (3-5-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): UMKC fell below the .500 mark with a pair of one-goal losses in a tournament hosted by Denver. The Kangaroos lost to the host Pioneers by a 3-2 count, then fell to Air Force, 2-1. UMKC scored the fastest two goals in school history to take an early 2-0 lead against Denver, as Mike Rosenthal scored at the 4:28 mark, and M.J. Serota added another goal just 17 seconds later. Denver scored three unanswered goals, however, to take home the win. Tim Collico scored early to give UMKC another lead, but Air Force wore the Kangaroos down by unloading 23 shots (compared to UMKC's 5), the most by a UMKC opponent since last September. Beau Williams moved into fifth place on the Mid-Con's career minutes played list (4,879:48). The goals by Collico and Serota were the first of their college careers. Eight different players have scored UMKC's 12 goals this season.

Oakland (3-3-2, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland pushed its unbeaten streak to five matches with a home win over crosstown rival Detroit (2-1), but then lost at home to Wright State (1-0) in double overtime. The Golden Grizzlies handed regionally ranked Detroit its first loss of the season, as Philip Braathen tallied the equalizer late in the first half and Doug Rice provided the gamewinner on a penalty kick in the 74th minute. Goalie Jeff Wiese's only save of the contest came on a penalty kick attempt in the last 10 minutes of the match. Despite the loss to Wright State, in which Wiese made four saves, Oakland moved back up to tenth in NSCAA Great Lakes Region rankings.

Oral Roberts (5-4, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts suffered a pair of defeats on the road, falling at No. 12/15 (NSCAA/ Soccer Times) Bradley (5-0), and at SW Missouri State (2-1) in overtime. Bradley tallied one goal in the middle of the first half, but racked up four scores in the final stanza. Hector Zapata made seven saves for the Golden Eagles, who were shut out for the second time this season. Dave Leung gave Oral Roberts a lead against SW Missouri State, but the host Bears tallied a score late in the first half and won the game in the second minute of overtime. The Golden Eagles managed only five shots in the match. Three of the team's last four opponents have been nationally ranked (Creighton, Tulsa, Bradley), and Oral Roberts has not won since leading scorer Sun Potter went down a with a shoulder injury. Despite its four-match losing streak, Oral Roberts is still tied for tenth in the NSCAA Midwest Region.

Valparaiso (3-5-1,1-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso won its only match last week, topping IUPUI (2-0) in the conference opener. Mickey Miller II scored his first career goal in the 16th minute, which turned out to be the game-winner. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Nate Hyde tallied his first collegiate score in the 63rd minute to seal up the win. Jeff Oleck made four saves for the Crusaders while posting his third shutout of the season.

Western Illinois (4-6, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois won two of three home matches last week, beating Wright State (2-1), losing to Drake (3-1) and topping Centenary (3-1). Justin Langan tallied his second multi-goal match of the season against Wright State, including the game-winner in the 56th minute, less than two minutes after the visiting Raiders had tied the match. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Bob Wallace scored three goals in the final two matches of the week. After tallying the team's lone score against Drake, Wallace scored the Leathernecks' first two goals in the win over Centenary, both on headers. In each of Western Illinois' wins this season, a Leatherneck has posted a multi-goal game. After kicking a pair of field goals and four extra points in a 41-13 homecoming win over Sam Houston State, Langan jogged from the football field to the soccer field to help his team beat Centenary, earning Western Illinois two wins in two sports on the same day.

## 2002 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament Nov. 15-17 • hosted by top seed

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament will be held on November 15 and 17, but the site of the tournament is still up for grabs. The team that earns the top seed for the single-elimination tourney will also serve as the host; the top four finishers in the league standings will qualify for the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Three teams have won their first Mid-Con Tournament crowns in the past three years - Oral Roberts (1999), IUPUI (2000), and UMKC (2001), while Valparaiso captured its only title in 1996. Former members Central Connecticut State (1994-95) and Howard (1997-98) are the only teams to post repeats.
