Oral Roberts' Trey Vaut earned MVP honors at the Centenary Classic, helping his team to a pair of lopsided shutout wins. In a 4-0 triumph over Atlantic Sun preseason favorite Stetson, Vaut put the Golden Eagles on the board with a penalty kick in the sixth minute. He then

scored twice in Oral Roberts' 5-0 victory over Lipscomb, netting both of his goals in the second half. Vaut's play helped Oral Roberts extend its record to 3-0, the best start to a season in Oral Roberts men's soccer history.

Valparaiso's Jeff Oleck helped the Crusaders to an undefeated week, and picked up his first two career shutouts in the process. In a 2-0 win over Northwestern on the road, Oleck made five stops to keep the Wildcats off the scoreboard. The rookie netminder then kept

Evansville, which was unbeaten and untied and ranked eighth in the Great Lakes Region, out of the net for 110 minutes in 90-degree heat, making six saves in a scoreless tie. Oleck lowered his goals against average by 2.37 (from 4.50 to 2.13) with the blankings.

ORAL ROBERTS OFF TO BEST START IN SCHOOL HISTORY: Oral Roberts has turned itself into a goal-scoring machine in the early portion of the season. The Golden Eagles, who at 3-0 are off to the best start in school history, have found the back of the net 14 times in the first three matches, and have increased their scoring output in each match. Oral Roberts opened the season with a 3-1 win over Centenary, then beat Atlantic Sun preseason favorite Stetson by a 4-0 score and Lipscomb by a 5-0 count at the Centenary Classic. Tournament MVP and Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Trey Vaut scored three times, while goalie Hector Zapata posted back-to-back shutouts.

ORAL ROBERTS' POTTER SEES SCORING STREAK GROW: Oral Roberts' Sun Potter has posted multiple-point scoring efforts in each of his team's first three matches, and is on pace to rank among the Mid-Con's all-time single-season scoring leaders. Potter, who posted his first career hat trick in the first match of the season against Centenary, had two goals and an assist against Stetson and a goal and an assist versus Lipscomb. Potter already has 14 points on six goals and two assists in the young season, and is averaging an astounding 4.67 points per game. He scored 23 points on nine goals and five assists last season as a rookie, when he was named to the all-conference first team and was the Mid-Con Newcomer of the Year.

VALPARAISO REVERSES COURSE, POSTS UNDEFEATED WEEK: In the first week of the season. Valparaiso allowed a total of nine goals in losses to Denver and Air Force. However, the Crusaders fixed their defense over the next week, which led to an undefeated weekend. The Crusaders earned their first win of the season at Nor thwestern by a 2-0 score, and followed that up by posting a scoreless tie against regionally ranked Evansville. Rookie Jeff Oleck posted back-to-back shutouts, which not only lowered his goals against average from 4.50 to 2.13, but also earned him Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week honors.

UMKC WONDERING, "WHEN'S THE BREAK IN THE SCHEDULE?": UMKC is in the midst of its toughest non-conference competition of the season. The Kangaroos held their own at the Tulsa Golden Hurricane Classic, tying No. 18 (Soccer Times) Bradley, 1-1, and falling in overtime to the host, 2-1. Both teams were ranked ahead of UMKC in the NSCAA Midwest Region - Bradley and Tulsa (now 12th in the NSCAA national poll) were ranked 2nd and 4th, respectively, while the Kangaroos were sixth. Despite not winning a match over the weekend, UMKC dropped only one spot to seventh in the region. This week, the Kangaroos face No. 12 (Soccer Times) SMU at the SMU Nike Classic, and also square off against TCU.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (0-4, 0-0 Mid-Con): IUPUI is still looking for its first win of the season after seeing its season-opening losing streak reach four matches. The laguars dropped a lopsided, 8-0 decision at Michigan before narrowly missing an upset over regionally ranked Michigan State in a 2-1 loss. Drew Deffner, who started the year as a team manager, played the second half in goal for IUPUI in the loss to Michigan, and made six saves in the loss to Michigan State.

UMKC (1-1-1, O-0 Mid-Con): Despite not winning a match, UMKC had a relatively successful week, considering the level of competition the Kangaroos faced. UMKC tied No. 18 (Soccer Times) Bradley, 1-1, in the opening match of the Tulsa Golden Hurricane Classic, the team's first regular-season tie since 1996. John Clark scored UMKC's goal, while Beau Williams stopped six Bradley shots to forge the tie. UMKC outshot Bradley by a 5-1 margin in the overtime periods. The Kangaroos then pushed Tulsa, which was ranked fourth in NSCAA Midwest Region, to overtime before falling by a 2-1 score. Clark, Jason Woods, Brian Wallace and Eric Zobrist were all named to the all-tournament team. Each of UMKC's matches this season have gone into overtime, equaling the number of extra-session contests the Kangaroos played a year ago. The schedule doesn't get any easier for UMKC this week, as the Kangaroos match up with No. 12 (Soccer Times) SMU in Dallas. The Kangaroos are ranked No. 7 in the Midwest Region this week.

Oakland (O-2-1, O-0 Mid-Con): Oakland snapped a two-match losing streak to open the season by tying visiting Dayton by a 2-2 score. The Golden Grizzlies were a man down for all but five minutes of the match, after Bret McNabb was sent off with a red card early. Philip Braathen gave Oakland a lead just before the half, and after Dayton took the lead with two goals in the middle of the second stanza, Shahar Ktovim came off the bench to knot the match in the 82nd minute. Jeff Wiese made ten saves in goal for Oakland, including three in the second overtime period.

Oral Roberts (3-0, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts secured the best start in school history after posting a pair of shutout wins over Stetson (4-0) and Lipscomb (5-0). The two wins not only pushed the Golden Eagles' record to a perfect 3-0, but also gave the title at the Centenary Classic. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Trey Vaut was named the MVP of the tournament after scoring the game-winning goal against Stetson (the preseason favorite in the Atlantic Sun) and netting a pair of second-half goals against Lipscomb. Sun Potter continued his torrid scoring streak as well, scoring twice against Stetson and once against Lipscomb. Potter now has six goals and two assists for 14 points in just three games, good for a whopping 4.67 points per game average. Hector Zapata posted back-to-back shutouts, making three saves in each contest. Potter and Zapata joined Vaut on the all-tournament team.

Valparaiso (1-2-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso enjoyed a perfect week by beating Northwestern on the road (2-0) and battling Evansville to a scoreless tie. The Crusaders earned their first win of the season against the Wildcats, despite being outshot by an 11-7 count. Ben Olson scored the game-winning goal in the last minute of the first half, while Billy Wanecke added insurance with just 18 seconds left in regulation. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Jeff Oleck posted the first of his back-to-back shutouts by making five saves. Oleck withstood 90-degree heat to keep Evansville, which was ranked eighth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Region, scoreless for 110 minutes by making six saves. The physical match featured 39 fouls and nine cautions (six for Evansville, three for Valparaiso). The scoreless tie was only the third in the program's 20-year history.

Western Illinois (1-3, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois lost to Northwestern by a 2-0 score in its home opener, then split a pair of matches over the weekend. The Leathernecks earned their first win of the season by beating UW-Green Bay (3-0) before falling to host UW-Milwaukee (4-1) at a tournament hosted by the Panthers. Justin Langan scored a pair of goals, including the game-winner, in the win over the Phoenix. The Leathernecks outshot their foe by a 17-8 margin. Bob Wallace assisted on Langan's second goal, as well as the first career tally by Stephen Gorton. UW-Milwaukee outshot Western Illinois by a 25-5 margin in the second match of the tournament; Western Illinois averted the shutout with Mike Smith's goal in the final ten minutes of play.

2002 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament Nov. 15-17 • hosted by top seed

The 2002 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament will be held on November 15 and 17, but the site of the tournament is still up for grabs. The team that earns the top seed for the single-elimination tourney will also serve as the host; the top four finishers in the league standings will qualify for the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament.

Three teams have won their first Mid-Con Tournament crowns in the past three years - Oral Roberts (1999), IUPUI (2000), and UMKC (2001), while Valparaiso captured its only title in 1996. Former members Central Connecticut State (1994-95) and Howard (1997-98) are the only teams to post repeats.
