UMKC's Ryan Barber led his squad, scoring two goals in the Kangaroos' 3-2 come-from-behind home victory against Western Illinois. With the win, UMKC handed the Leathernecks their first league

loss of the season and moved into sole possession of first-place in the conference standings. Both of Barber's goals allowed the Kangaroos, now the league's only unbeaten team in league play, to pull to a tie. His first goal at 48:47 gave UMKC a 1-1 tie, while his second goal at 69:11 pulled the Kangaroos into a 2-2 deadlock. IUPUI's Peter Brasovan replaced injured teammate Drew Deffner in net, recording an outstanding effort as the Jaguars went 1-1 last week. The freshman turned in ten saves in IUPUI's 1-0 loss to

Indiana, limiting the Hoosiers (ranked 6th in the NSCAA Midwest Region) to just one goal despite facing 32 shots. Brasovan then was credited with his first career shutout, making four saves in the Jaguars' 1-0 win over conference rival Valparaiso - their first win against the Crusaders in 12 years. AROUND THE MID-CON...

UMKC HANDS WESTERN ILLINOIS FIRST CONFERENCE LOSS: UMKC took over sole possession of the top spot in the league standings last week, posting a 3-2 win over visiting Western Illinois. The Lethernecks, who dropped to second place with the loss, were previously undefeated in conference play. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Ryan Barber led the Kangaroo charge, collecting his first multi-goal game of the season in the win, while teammate John Clark scored the game-winning goal. Both of Barber's scores erased deficits and brought the Kangaroos even. UMKC will look to maintain its perfect league record next week as it travels to Tulsa to take on Oral Roberts.

IUPUI POSTS FIRST WIN OVER VALPO IN 12 YEARS: IUPUI picked up its first win over Valparaiso since joining the Mid-Con, as it blanked the Crusaders, 1-0 last week. The victory was the first for the Jaguars against Valpo since 1991. Adrian Conrad netted IUPUI's only goal, his first of the season, off a corner kick from Michael Bowditch. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Peter Brasovan manned the goal, collecting four saves for his first career shutout.

OAKLAND AND ORAL BATTLING FOR THIRD: Both Oakland and Oral Roberts posted wins last week placing them both in a tie for third in the Mid-Continent Conference standings. Both teams defeated league foe Centenary via shutout last week - Oakland beat the Gents (1-0) after Oral Roberts had blanked them (4-0) earlier in the week. Oakland takes on Valparaiso and Oral Roberts hosts Mid-Con front-runner UMKC this week.

TINY TIDBITS: Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Peter Brasovan made his first career start against Indiana, allowing one score and making 10 saves while facing 32 shots in a loss to Indiana. He came back to shutout Valparaiso, 1-0, later in the week... UMKC's Drew Perkins took over the school's career lead in scoring when he picked up an assist against Western Illinois. He now has 54 points in three seasons... Western Illinois had not allowed a goal in more than 445 minutes before surrendering a tally in the 86th minute against Detroit in a 3-1 win.

The top four finishers in the Mid-Con regular-season standings will advance to the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Men's College Cup. Oakland became the first-ever tourney host to win the event last season. The Mid-Con has had four first-time champions in the last four years (Oral Roberts - 1999; IUPUI - 2000; UMKC - 2001; Oakland - 2002).
