AROUND THE MID-CON...

UMKC MAINTAINS LEAD: After starting the season 1-5-1, UMKC has put together a six-match unbeaten streak, its longest since the 1999 season, with its most recent win coming last week against conference foe Oral Roberts (3-2) on the road. The Kangaroos, who were picked to finish second in the league preseason poll, are the only conference squad without a loss and currently hold the top spot in the league standings. With two weeks left to play, the Kangaroos will look to maintain their lead as they take on Mid-Con preseason favorite Oakland (3-1 Mid-Con) at home this weekend.

MID-CON RACE RESUMES: The 2003 race to the Mid-Con tournament is underway and three squads are head-to-head in the league standings, with UMKC (4-0) currently holding the top spot with 12 points. The Kangaroos have yet to play Mid-Con preseason favorite Oakland and will take on the Golden Grizzlies this weekend. Western Illinois (3-1-1) trails UMKC by two points with 10, with its only loss coming at the hands of the league-leading Kangaroos. The Leathernecks conclude their conference play this week as they travel to Valparaiso. Oakland (3-1) trails Western Illinois by a point, with nine. The Golden Grizzlies, whose loss was to the Leathernecks, have yet to take on league-leading UMKC, and will do so this week. Oral Roberts (2-2) is also in the hunt for a trip to Rochester. The Golden Eagles (six points) have yet to play IUPUI and Oakland. IUPUI needs a win against Oral Roberts this weekend to keep its Mid-Con Tourney hopes alive.

TINY TIDBITS: Centenary's 2-0 blanking of Belhaven was the first shutout for the Gents this season... IUPUI's Drew Deffner made his first start in two weeks against Western Illinois after missing three matches to injury... UMKC head coach Rick Benben tallied his 50th career victory at UMKC with the 3-2 win at Oral Roberts... Oakland will take a three-match winning streak to Cincinnati as they take on the No. 19 Bearcats... Valparaiso lost its third match in four outings last week against Oakland (6-0)... Western Illinois' Justin Langan netted two goals in the Leathernecks' 2-2 tie with IUPUI. Those goals moved him into fifth place on Western's all-time scoring list with 80 points (31 g, 18 a). His 31 career goals ranks him fifth in school history in that category.

2003 MID-CON TOURNEY RETURNS TO OAKLAND

By virtue of winning the 2002 Mid-Con regular-season title, Oakland will again serve as the host for the 2003 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament, which will be held on Nov. 14 and 16, at the OU Soccer Field in Rochester, Mich. The top four finishers in the Mid-Con regular-season standings will advance to the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Men's College Cup. Oakland became the first-ever tourney host to win the event last season. The Mid-Con has had four first-time champions in the last four years (Oral Roberts - 1999; IUPUI - 2000; UMKC - 2001; Oakland - 2002).
