Tournament by netting the game-winning goal against the Jaguars' in the second overtime period, while collecting three assists earlier in the week to help Oral Roberts to the win over visiting Drury (his second three-assist game of the year). AROUND THE MID-CON ...

TOURNAMENT FIELD SET: The 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Tournament field has been set with one week remaining in league play. UMKC, Oakland, Oral Roberts and Western Illinois will participate in the single-elimination event to be held on the campus of Oakland University in Rochester, Mich., on November 14th and 16th. The seeds will be set following the conclusion of league play this week as UMKC hosts Centenary and Oakland plays at Oral Roberts. Western Illinois has concluded conference play and is currently the front-runner with a 4-1-1 (13 points) record. The champion of the Mid-Con Tournament will receive an automatic bid to the NCAA College Cup.

OAKLAND HANDS UMKC FIRST CONFERENCE LOSS: UMKC lost its first conference match of the season last week, as it fell to visiting Oakland by a 2-1 count. The loss dropped the Kangaroos into second place in the league standings, as they're tied with the Golden Grizzlies with a 4-1 record. Philip Braathen scored his third game-winning goal of the season on a breakaway in the 79th minute, while Chris Edwards also scored to help Oakland to the win. With the loss, UMKC saw its seven-match winning streak come to an end.

WESTERN ILLINOIS MOVES INTO FIRST: Western Illinois (4-1-1 Mid-Con) moved into the top spot in the league standings last week, as it defeated host Valparaiso, 2-0. The Leathernecks, who were picked third in the Mid-Con Preseason Poll, received the game-winning goal in the 12th minute from Justin Langan. Western Illinois will make the trip to the Mid-Con Tournament, but will have to sit tight as their seed is decided as other squads finish conference competition.

MARVELOUS MENDUINA: Oral Roberts' Miguel Menduina has been named the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week for the second straight week, as he led the Golden Eagles to a 2-0 record and a Mid-Con Tournament berth last week. The senior netted the game-winning goal in Oral Roberts' 2-1 double-overtime win over IUPUI, while collecting three assists (his second three-assist match of the year) earlier in the week to help the Golden Eagles to a win over visiting Drury (6-1). 2003 MID-CON TOURNEY RETURNS TO OAKLAND

By virtue of winning the 2002 Mid-Con regular-season title, Oakland will again serve as the host for the 2003 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament, which will be held on Nov. 14 and 16, at the OU Soccer Field in Rochester, Mich. The top four finishers in the Mid-Con regular-season standings will advance to the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Men's College Cup. Oakland became the first-ever tourney host to win the event last season. The Mid-Con has had four first-time champions in the last four years (Oral Roberts - 1999; IUPUI - 2000; UMKC - 2001; Oakland - 2002).
