Oral Roberts' Trey Vaut helped the Golden Eagles to a second-place finish at Bradley's Holiday Inn City Centre Classic, and earned himself a place on the all-tourney team in the process. Vaut gave Oral

Roberts an early lead with his first goal of the season against Bradley in the opener, a game the host Braves came back to win, 2-1. In a 4-0 triumph over Eastern Illinois, Vaut added his second goal of the young season on a penalty kick early in the second half, and assisted on Jonathan Ball's insurance goal later in the match. Vaut, a two-time first-team All Mid-Con performer, tallied five points on his two goals and assist.

Oakland's Jeff Wiese worked overtime while helping the Golden Grizzlies to a share of the Portland Nike Invitational title. Wiese was terrific in goal for Oakland, allowing two goals in 211:05 of work,

good for a 0.85 GAA. Wiese made four saves while giving his teammates time to post a 2-1, double-overtime win against No. 22 (NSCAA) Portland in the season-opener, and collected three of his four stops in two extra sessions in a 1-1 tie against Washington in what turned out to be the championship match. Wiese was last season's Mid-Con Newcomer of the Year.

## AROUND THE MID-CON...

OAKLAND BEGINS THIS SEASON WHERE IT LEFT OFF LAST YEAR: Oakland, last year's Mid-Con regular-season and tournament champion, began the 2003 season well, defeating No. 22 (NSCAA) Portland 2-1 in double-overtime and tying Washington (1-1) also in double-overtime, at the Portland Nike Invitational. The Golden Grizzlies, who are also picked to finish first in this year's Mid-Con preseason poll, were led by Philip Braathen (2g), while goalkeeper Jeff Wiese tallied eight saves on his way to Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week honors.

GOLDEN GRIZZLIES RANKED IN LATEST POLL : Oakland's double-overtime win over No. 22 (NSCAA) Portland has turned some heads, as the Golden Grizzlies are now ranked 30th in the lastest College Soccer News Top 30 poll. Oakland followed the win with a 1-1 tie against Washington, but since the game was on Monday it was not included in consideration for the ranking. Oakland is also ranked fourth in the Great Lakes Region by the NSCAA this week as well.

MID-CON TEAMS HAVE ROUGH GO IN FIRST WEEK OF PLAY: The Mid-Con men's soccer teams struggled in the first week, posting a 3-8-1 record in the first few days of play. Three teams posted wins - Oakland defeated Portland 2-1, Oral Roberts blanked Eastern Illinois 4-0 and Western Illinois beat Wright State 4-2. Centenary (0-2), IUPUI (0-2), UMKC (0-1) and Valparaiso (0-1) are all still looking for their first wins.

OVERTIME WOES: This week in Mid-Con action, four matches went into extra minutes resulting in two losses, one tie and one victory. Centenary and Western Illinois posted the two losses the Gents fell 3-2 in double overtime to IPFW at the 'Pops' Drayer Classic and the Leathernecks dropped a 3-2 decision to Drake in two extra sessions. Oakland played two double-overtime matches, tying Washington 1-1 and defeating Portland 2-1.

VAUT TRYING TO MAKE IT THREE IN A ROW: Oral Roberts' Trey Vaut has been named to the All Mid-Con first team each of the last two years, and got a head start on another citation in the first week of the season. Vaut was named the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week after recording a pair of goals and adding an assist on his way to all-tourney honors at Bradley.

WIESE NAMED TO SOCCER AMERICA TEAM OF THE WEEK: Oakland goalie Jeff Wiese was named to Soccer America's Team of the Week following his performance at Portland's Nike Invitational.

2003 MID-CON TOURNEY RETURNS TO OAKLAND

By virtue of winning the 2002 Mid-Con regular-season title, Oakland will again serve as the host for the 2003 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Tournament, which will be held on Nov. 14 and 16, at the OU Soccer Field in Rochester, Mich. The top four finishers in the Mid-Con regular-season standings will advance to the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Men's College Cup. Oakland became the first-ever tourney host to win the event last season. The Mid-Con has had four first-time champions in the last four years (Oral Roberts - 1999; IUPUI - 2000; UMKC - 2001; Oakland - 2002).
