Oral Roberts' Hector Zapata was solid between the pipes this past week, helping his team battle against tough opponents, allowing three goals and tallying 16 saves in 208 minutes of play at the SMU

Mi Cocina Classic in Dallas, Texas. The senior held No. 9 SMU scoreless until the second overtime period, recording ten saves, before allowing a penalty kick for the game-winner. He then allowed only two goals in Oral Roberts' second double-overtime loss of the weekend to No. 21 Tulsa. Zapata has allowed three goals in the Golden Eagles' last three matches, covering 318 minutes, while owning a 0.91 goals against average for the season.

OAKLAND EARNS NO. 27 IN LATEST COLLEGE SOCCER NEWS POLL: After spending two weeks at No. 30 on the College Soccer News Poll, Oakland has moved up three spots to No. 27. The Golden Grizzlies made their move following a 2-2 tie at home against regionally ranked (NSCAA) Detroit this past week. Oakland, which also received votes in the Soccer Times Coaches Poll, remains unbeaten with a 2-0-2 (.750) record and will take on undefeated Western Michigan (6-0-0) this week. Oakland was ranked No. 20 in the NSCAA poll last week.

IUPUI STEPS UP, ENDS SCORELESS DROUGHT: IUPUI ended its four-game losing skid, posting a double-overtime tie (0-0) against Loyola (III.) and earning a comeback win over Northern Illinois (4-3). The Jaguars' efforts earned them the NIU Fall Invitational Tournament crown. IUPUI, which also tallied its first scores of the season in the win over the Huskies, was led by Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Mike Madaj. Madaj, who entered the match with just two career goals in 37 matches played, turned in a hat trick in the second half the lead the Jaguar charge. Mike Sullivan also netted a goal in the win.

ORAL ROBERTS PROVES TOUGH AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS: Oral Roberts posted two tough losses last week, falling to No. 9/6 SMU (1-0) and No. 21/NR Tulsa (2-1) on back-toback days. The Golden Eagles put forth solid efforts, battling both squads to two doubleovertime periods. Against SMU, Oral Roberts was led by Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Hector Zapata's solid presence in net. The senior totaled ten saves in the loss and held SMU scoreless until the second overtime period. The Golden Eagles also played a tough match against Tulsa, with Alejandro Guardia tallying Oral Roberts' lone goal in the loss. The Golden Eagles will take on another strong competitor this week when they play Loyola Marymount, a team which received votes in the Soccer Times Top 25 poll this week.

THREE MID-CON TEAMS STILL IN SEARCH OF WIN: Three Mid-Con squads, Centenary (0-6), UMKC (0-3-1) and Valparaiso (0-4), will enter the fourth week of play still in search of a win. The Gents tallied their fifth consecutive one-goal decision against Stetson (3-2), before falling to Central Florida (4-1). UMKC was also beaten by Western Michigan (3-0) and Drake (4-1) both of which are regionally ranked by the NSCAA - and Valparaiso fell to Detroit (3-0).
