Justin Langan, Western Illinois Sr., M, Davenport, Iowa

Western Illinois' Justin Langan proved his worth against one of the nation's best teams, as he helped the Leathernecks to a 4-4 tie at No. 3 Saint Louis. Langan tallied a pair of goals against the previously unscathed Billikens - one on a penalty kick just before the half that tied the match, and another in the middle of the second half that gave Western Illinois a 3-2 lead. Langan, who leads the Mid-Con with 15 points (4g, 7a) despite missing two games because of his responsibilities for Western's football team, has moved into sixth place on the school's career scoring list. UMKC's Todd Dohlman withstood a great deal of pressure in the pipes for the Kangaroos, but hung tough in the Kangaroos' 2-1 upset win over No. 5 Santa Clara. Dohlman saw his team get outshot by a 14-3 margin, but he made five saves to give his team a chance to take away the late win. One of Dohlman's saves was a tip over the crossbar just before the end of the first half, and he also barely got a hand on another shot in the 64th minute that would have put the visiting Broncos ahead. AROUND THE MID-CON...

UMKC DOWNS NO. 5 SANTA CLARA, BENBEN REACHES MILESTONE: UMKC rebounded from a tough 3-2 loss to Denver last week in dramatic fashion, defeating No. 5 Santa Clara (2-1) two days later. The win snapped a five-game Kangaroo winless streak and marked the third season in the last four that the Kangaroos have defeated a top-25 team - they also beat No. 7 Marquette in 2000 and No. 19 UW-Milwaukee in 2001. The victory also marked UMKC head coach Rick Benbens 46th career win, making him the school's all-time leader in victories. In his sixth season, Benben has surpassed Mike Brown, who won 45 matches from 1993-97.

WESTERN ILLINOIS TURNS UP THE 'O' IN TIE AT NO. 3 SAINT LOUIS: Western Illinois walked away from its contest at No. 3/3 Saint Louis with a 4-4 tie, but the Leathernecks had put themselves in a position to post the big upset. Nowaf Jaman gave Western Illinois an early lead, but Saint Louis answered back with two scores. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Justin Langan converted on a crucial penalty kick just before the half; he and Jaman scored 1:21 apart in the middle of the second half to give the Leathernecks the lead, though the host Billikens rallied to force overtime.

MID-CON SEASON UNDERWAY: Centenary and IUPUI were the only squads in league action last week, as they battled to a 1-1 tie. The Gents outshot the Jags 22-11 in the draw. Alexander Smith netted Centenary's lone goal, while Mike Sullivan scored for the Jaguars. Currently, Western Illinois leads the Mid-Con standings after defeating Centenary, 5-0, in the first week of conference play. Next week conference play will find itself in full swing, as Valparaiso takes on UMKC and Centenary, Western Illinois travels to Oral Roberts, and Oakland hosts IUPUI.

MID-CON TEAMS CHALLENGE RANKED SQUADS: After posting a 1-1-1 record against ranked opponents this past week, Mid-Con teams proved they could battle with the best. Centenary took on No. 9/5 SMU, falling 5-1, but the two squads were knotted at 1-1 at the half. UMKC recorded the only league win against a ranked opponent, besting No. 5/8 Santa Clara (2-1), ending a five-game winless streak. Oakland, which was ranked 12th itself by the NSCAA last week, played Dayton (4th in the Great Lakes) to a 1-1 double overtime draw. Oral Roberts (1-0 to SW Missouri State), Valparaiso (3-0 to Michigan State; 1-0 to Drake) and Western Illinois (1-0 to Bradley) all lost games to regionally ranked opponents, though Western Illinois did manage a 4-4 tie at No. 3/3 Saint Louis.
