#### AROUND THE MID-CON...



ORAL ROBERTS DOWNS OAKLAND TO MOVE INTO FIRST PLACE: The Golden Eagles moved to the top of the Mid-Con standings with a 1-0 home victory over Oakland Saturday. Junior midfielder Dave Leung scored the game-winner in the 82nd minute to give ORU the win. The score was Leung's fifth of the season and his first game-deciding tally of 2004.

WESTERN EXTENDS HOME UNBEATEN STREAK TO 16 GAMES: Western Illinois kept pace with Oral Roberts and Oakland with a 2-0 victory over Valparaiso Saturday. The victory brought WIU's unbeaten string at MacKenzie Alumni Field to 16 games. Nowaf Jaman put the Leathernecks on the board first with a score in the 27th minute, while Elton Fernandes added an insurance tally in the 45th minute. Junior keeper David Hanlon earned his third shutout of the season with seven saves. Valpo's Jeff Oleck turned away 13 shots in the loss, the highest total in the Mid-Con this season.

**DENNIS IS A MENACE AGAINST IPFW:** Valparaiso's **Philip Dennis** had a solid performance in a 2-1 victory over IPFW Sunday. He found the back of the net off of a **DJ. Catrow** pass, just 1:43 into the match and later contributed an assist on **Jason Witte**'s game-winning goal.

WEATHER THE WINNER AT CENTENARY: Saturday's UMKC at Centenary game was postponed due to inclement weather in Louisiana. The contest will be made up at a later date.

NACOVSKI OUT-SHOOTS IPFW: IUPUI freshman Vangel Nacovski attempted more shots (8) than the entire IPFW team (7) in Friday's 3-0 loss at IPFW. On the evening, the Jaguars, who lost their third-straight match, outshot the 'Dons, 19-7.

WIU FALLS TO NORTHWESTERN: The Leathernecks played to a scoreless tie in the first half against Northwestern, which is ranked ninth in the NSCAA Great Lakes Regional Poll, Sunday. However, WIU's upset bid came up short after surrendering three second-half goals to the Wildcats.

CENTENARY SNAPS FOUR-GAME WINLESS SKID: The Gents halted a four-game winless skid with a 3-2 victory over Drury Thursday. Centenary had lady luck on its side as the Panthers scored an own goal to lift the Gents to the win. With the victory, Centenary evens the all-time series with Drury, 5-5-1.

DEFENSE IS THE NAME OF THE GAME: Defense is the name of the game in the Mid-Con with four teams owning a goals against average below 1.00 in conference play. The toughest teams to score on seem to be Oral Roberts and Oakland. The Golden Eagles are yet to allow a goal to a Mid-Con foe, while the Golden Grizzlies have only surrendered one goal in league play.

MID-CON SCORING RACE IS TIGHT: The Mid-Con scoring race with likely go down to the wire with IUPUI freshman Vangel Nacovski and Western Illinois sophomore Nowaf Jaman. Through 11 games, Nacovski has 23 points via 11 goals and an assist, while Jaman, in 13 games, has 21 points (10 g, 1 a). Nacovski slipped to sixth in the NCAA in goals through October 11. Jaman got his name in the NCAA ranking, placing 28th in goals per game.

WIESE IS ONE OF THE TOP NETMINDERS IN THE NCAA: Oakland junior Jeff Wiese has proven that he is not only one of the top goalkeepers in the Mid-Con, but one of the top netminders in the NCAA. The junior is sixth in the NCAA in goals against average (0.49) as of Oct. 4. As a team, the Golden Grizzlies are fifth in the country in goals against average (0.49) and tied for ninth in shutout percentage (0.60). OU is also tied for 15th in winning percentage (.750).
