Edwards is the Co-Offensive Player of the Week after scoring a pair of goals in a win over regionally-ranked Michigan State Wednesday. The junior forward gave the Golden Grizzlies a 2-0 lead in the 25th minute before adding his team-best seventh goal of the season in the 80th minute. In a 0-0 tie with IUPUI Sunday, Edwards led OU with four shots, including three on goal.

Jack Goodloe, Centenary Sr., M, Little Rock, Ark./Central

Goodloe takes home Co-Offensive Player of the Week accolades after scoring a pair of unassisted long-distance goals in a 3-0 win over Birmingham-Southern Wednesday. The senior midfielder notched the game-winner from about 40 yards out in the 48th minute and then added the Gents third goal of the game in the 81st minute. It was Centenary's first shutout of the season.

AROUND THE MID-CON...

ORAL ROBERTS CLINCHES PLAYOFF SPOT: The Golden Eagles are the first team to clinch a berth in the Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship after victories over Western Illinois (3-0) and UMKC (2-1) last weekend. The victories also clinched at least a share of the regular-season title for ORU. It is the Golden Eagles third regular-season crown and first since 2001. ORU has never won the regular-season title outright.

WESTERN'S HOME UNBEATEN STREAK SNAPPED: Western Illinois 16-game home unbeaten streak was snapped when Oral Roberts posted a 3-0 victory over the Leathernecks at MacKenzie Alumni Field Friday afternoon. ORU freshman defender **Jordan Tatum** netted a pass from **Adam Allee** to give the Golden Eagles the lead just eight minutes into the contest. **Stephen McCarthy** added an insurance tally in the 53rd minute and WIU surrendered an own goal in the 77th minute to give the final margin of victory.

QUARTUCCIO SOLID IN NET: Oral Roberts freshman keeper **Tony Quartuccio** continued his solid play in goal for the Golden Eagles. The rookie turned away 11 Leatherneck shots in a 3-0 win over Western Illinois Friday and made one stop in a 2-1 win over UMKC Sunday. In 13 career games, Quartuccio has eight shutouts.

UMKC ADDS TO THE WIN COLUMN: After going winless in their first seven contests, the Kangaroos collected back-to-back overtime victories with decisions over IUPUI (Oct. 1) and Illinois-Chicago (10/13). **Brian Garcia** tallied the game-winner against the Flames at 3:42 into the first extra period. The winning streak was stopped by Oral Roberts Sunday, although UMKC was the first team to score on the Golden Eagles in 338:07 when senior **Andrew Kewley** found the back of the net in the 57th minute.

FIRST START, FIRST GOAL, FIRST GAME-WINNER: In his first career start, IUPUI freshman **Troy Marchand** scored his first career goal to lift the Jaguars to a 4-3 overtime win against Wright State Tuesday. Classmate **Chris Wey** registered his first career assist on Marchand's goal, while fellow rookie **Vangel Nacovski** recorded a goal and an assist on the evening. Nacovski was the Mid-Con's Men's Student-Athlete of the Month in September after leading the NCAA in scoring that month.

GOOSE-EGGS ALL AROUND: The IUPUI-Oakland match on Sunday turned into a defensive battle with neither team finding their way onto the scoreboard en route to a 0-0 double-overtime tie. The squads combined for 66 fouls and six yellow cards in the game. The tie moves to the all-time series to 4-4-1 and was the Jaguars' first scoreless tie since Sept. 13, 2003.

EDWARDS THE GO-TO GUY FOR OU LAST WEEK: Junior forward **Chris Edwards** was the go-to guy for Oakland last week. He scored twice, including his team-best seventh goal of the season, in a 3-0 upset win over regionally-ranked Michigan State Wednesday. In a 0-0 double-overtime tie with IUPUI, Edwards tallied a team-best four shots, including three on goal.

WIESE POSTS TWO SHUTOUTS: Oakland junior keeper **Jeff Wiese** notched two shutouts last week, including an upset win over regionally-ranked Michigan State in which Wiese knocked away seven Spartan shots. In a 0-0 tie with IUPUI, Wiese had six saves to earn his sixth shutout of the season. As of Oct. 11, was ranked sixth in the NCAA with a 0.49 goals against average, but he now touts a league-best 0.39 GAA.

NACOVSKI AND JAMAN AMONG NCAA SCORING LEADERS: IUPUI's **Vangel Nacovski** and Western Illinois' **Nowaf Jaman** were ranked among the NCAA scoring leaders in the Oct. 11 report. Nacovski, the league leader in goals, was sixth in the country in goals per game (1.00) and 12th in points per game (2.09), while Jaman was 28th in the NCAA in goals per game (0.77). Other Mid-Con players among the NCAA leaders include Oakland's **Jeff Wiese** (goals against average) and Valparaiso's **Jeff Oleck** (saves per game). As a team, Oakland is fifth in goals against average, tied for ninth in shutout percentage and tied for 15th in winning percentage.
