THE CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD IS SET: Despite having two regular-season conference game remaining on the slate, the field has been set for the 2004 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship. Oral Roberts wrapped up the top seed in the Mid-Con Championship and earned its first outright regular-season title with a 4-0 victory over Centenary Friday evening. The Golden Eagles will face #4 seed and defending champion UMKC in the semifinals of the tourney, which is being held the MacKenzie Alumni Field on Western Illinois' campus (Nov. 12 & 14). The Kangaroos earned a berth with a pair of conference win over the weekend, including a 4-0 decision over Centenary Sunday to seal the postseason spot. In the other semifinal match-up, #2 Oakland will square off against the host and #3 seed Western Illinois.

UMKC POSTS TWO CONFERENCE WINS: UMKC entered last weekend in fifth-place in the conference standings and needed to win its final two Mid-Con matches in order to claim a spot in the Mid-Con Championship and the Kangaroos did just that, defeating Valparaiso, 3-1, and Centenary, 4-0, over the weekend. It will be UMKC's 11th-straight postseason appearance. In the win over the Crusaders. Brian Garcia netted two goals in a 25-second span to lift UMKC to a 2-0 lead, while Joe Chirco added an insurance tally in the second period. Four different players scored and the Kangaroos posted their first shutout of the season in the win over Centenary Sunday.

LEUNG'S FOOT REMAINS HOT FOR ORU: Junior Dave Leung registered his first career hat trick in a 4-0 win over Centenary Friday. Leung scored the Golden Eagles' first three goals on the evening to bring his season total to a team-best 11 goals. He also tops the team with 24 points. Kellon Sanders added a goal of his own in the win, while Tony Quartuccio made four saves for his 10th shutout of the season.

JAMAN NETS KEY GOALS FOR WESTERN ILLINOIS LAST WEEK: Sophomore forward Nowaf Jaman played a key role in Western Illinois' offensive success last week. The sophomore forward scored the game-tying goal in the 34th minute in a 2-1 overtime loss to IUPUI Friday night and came back Sunday afternoon to net the game-winner against IPFW. Jaman leads the team with 13 goal scored. WIU junior keeper Chris Frenz registered his first shutout of the season against IPFW after making five saves.

RZEPKA PLAYS UP AND IT PAYS OFF: Oakland senior defender Ryan Rzepka played up from his normal defensive position last week and it paid dividends for the Golden Grizzlies. Rzepka scored Oakland's first goal and assisted on two other tallies in OU's 4-1 victory over Wright State Tuesday. Rzepka kept his offensive groove Sunday, scoring OU's lone goal on a penalty kick in the 87th minute of a 4-1 loss to Detroit.

IUPUI ASSURED OF WINNING RECORD: IUPUI is assured of a winning season after a 2-1 overtime win over Western Illinois Friday night. The Jaguars are 9-6-1 on the season and will finish above .500 for the first time since 2000 when they were 11-9-2 and made an NCAA Tournament appearance.

DIPIRO AND NACOVSKI KEY IN IUPUI'S WIN OVER WESTERN ILLINOIS: Redshirt freshman Brian DiPiro and Vangel Nacovski were key personnel in IUPUI's 2-1 overtime win over Western Illinois Friday night. DiPiro picked up his first career win after making three saves, while Nacovski notched the first two-assist game of his career. Additionally, Michael Bowditch and Jared Byczko, who scored for the Jaguars Friday, tallied their first goals in an IUPUI uniform.

MEYER SCORES TWICE FOR CENTENARY: Junior J.J. Meyer scored twice, including the game-winner, in Centenary's 3-1 victory over Dallas Baptist Tuesday. It was his first multi-goal game of the season and brought his season goal total to four, which is tied for the team lead.
