AROUND THE MID-CON...

WESTERN WINS FIRST TITLE: The Western Illinois Leathernecks won their first-ever Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship with victories over second-seeded Oakland (1-0) and top-seeded Oral Roberts (4-0). The Leathernecks are just the second #3 seed to win the Mid-Con Tournament and just the second squad to celebrate a conference championship on their home field. The tourney crown also entitles Western Illinois to the league's automatic berth into the NCAA College Cup. WIU is making its first appearance in the national tourney and will face fellow first-timer Northwestern Friday at 1 p.m. in Evanston, Ill.

LEATHERNECKS-WILDCATS PART II: The NCAA College Cup first round match-up between Western Illinois and Northwestern will be the second meeting between the squads this season. The Wildcats posted 3-0 victory over WIU on Oct. 10 in Evanston, Ill. The Leathernecks were outshot in the contest, 13-7, but **Lorenzo Zignago** did manage to get off a team-best three shots in the contest. WIU is 0-3 against Big Ten foes this season with the October loss to NU and early season losses against Michigan and Michigan State.

JAMAN TABBED TOURNEY MVP: Western Illinois sophomore forward **Nowaf Jaman** was selected as the Mid-Con Tournament MVP after racking up two goals and two assists in a pair of contests over the weekend. Jaman ripped the net for the game-winner in the Championship match against Oral Roberts and tacked on an insurance goal later in the contest. Joining Jaman on the All-Tournament team were teammates **Elton Fernandes**, **Andy Swentik** and **Dave Hanlon**, from Oral Roberts **Adam Allee**, **Dave Leung** and **Jorge Flor**, from UMKC **Joe Chirco** and **Brian Garcia** and from Oakland **Bret McNabb** and **Jeff Wiese**.

LEUNG AND WIESE ARE THE PLAYERS OF THE YEAR: Oral Roberts junior forward **Dave Leung** and Oakland junior keeper **Jeff Wiese** were selected Offensive and Defensive Players of the Year, respectively, after outstanding seasons. Leung leads the league and is 19th nationally in points per game at a 1.67 clip. He is also 16th in the NCAA in goals per game (0.73). Wiese, a three-time all-star, leads the Mid-Con and ranks 12th in the country in goals against average with a 0.707 mark.

NACOVSKI CLAIMS NEWCOMER HONORS: IUPUI freshman forward **Vangel Nacovski** earned Newcomer of the Year honors after finishing his rookie campaign with 12 goals and four assists, which is tied for second in the conference. Nacovski also managed to score an NCAA-best four goal against Loyola (Ill.) in early September.

HAYES IS THE MID-CON'S TOP COACH: Oral Roberts mentor **Steve Hayes** was honored by his peers as the Mid-Con Coach of the Year after leading the Golden Eagles to their third regular-season title and first outright crown with a 5-0-1 record in Mid-Con play. The Golden Eagles are ninth on the NSCAA Midwest Region poll this week and are among the NCAA leaders in scoring offense (36th-1.94) and shutout percentage (5th-0.59).

HANLON HAS THE HOT HAND: Western Illinois keeper **Dave Hanlon** is riding a hot streak into the NCAA tourney. The junior has posted zeros on the scoreboard in his last three starts, including shutouts of the Mid-Con's top two scoring offenses (Oakland and Oral Roberts). As a team, WIU has blanked its opponents in its last four contests.

2004 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship Recap

Western Illinois blanks top seed Oral Roberts, wins 2004 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship 4-0

MACOMB, ILL. - If one has been the loneliest number over the course of the past decade in the Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Championship, then in 2004, three proved to be the magic number. With a 4-0 victory Sunday afternoon, #3 seed and tourney host Western Illinois denied top-seeded Oral Roberts' bid to become just the second #1 seed since 1995 to take home the tourney title. The title was the first in school history for the Leathernecks, who also became the second #3 seed to win the Championship, as well as the second team to celebrate a tourney Championship on its home turf.

Western Illinois' **Nowaf Jaman** wasted little time putting the Leathernecks on top in the Championship match, as Jaman kicked the game-winner by Oral Roberts' goalkeeper **Tony Quartuccio** 14:11 into the match. **Elton Fernandes** added an insurance tally for the Leathernecks less than 10 minutes later. Jaman and Fernandes would switch off scoring again, as Jaman added his second goal in the 45th minute and Fernandes in the 48th minute. **Matt Wieclaw** recorded the assist on Jaman's first goal, while Jaman and **Brett Thomas** each registered assists on Fernandes' second score. Oral Roberts outshot WIU, 11-10, in the first half, but were unable to beat **David Hanlon**, who finished with five saves, while notching his sixth shutout of the season. Oral Roberts also held a 6-0 advantage in corner kicks. Oral Roberts' leading scorer, **Dave Leung** managed five shots, although none came on goal.

Oral Roberts and Western Illinois to meet in the Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship match

MACOMB, ILL. — Top-seeded Oral Roberts (11-4-1, 5-0-1 Mid-Con) and third-seeded Western Illinois (10-9-0, 3-3-0) earned semifinal victories at the 2004 Mid-Continent Conference Men's Soccer Championship and will square-off for the Mid-Con title at 1 p.m. Sunday at WIU's MacKenzie Alumni Field. The Golden Eagles earned a berth in the final with a 4-3 decision over fourth-seeded UMKC (4-11-2, 3-3-0), while the Leathernecks clinched a spot in the Championship match with a 1-0 upset win over No. 2 seed Oakland (11-5-3, 4-1-1). The winner of the Championship match will earn a berth into the NCAA Men's College Cup.

Unexpectedly, the first semifinal was a high scoring affair with six first-half goals. The regular-season champion Golden Eagles jumped out to a 1-0 lead thanks to a tally by **Eric Mattison** just 40 seconds into the contest. The sophomore midfielder dribbled through a pair of defenders and got off a low shot from 15 yards out, which snuck past UMKC netminder **Todd Dohman**. However, ORU's lead was short-lived as sophomore midfielder **Brian Garcia** chipped a shot over ORU keeper **Tony Quartuccio** in the fifth minute.

The offenses continued to shine as Oral Roberts took a 2-1 lead after junior forward **Jorge Flor** netted a pass from senior forward **Steve McCarthy** in the 22nd minute, but the Kangaroos fought back just four minutes later when sophomore forward **Joe Chirco** knocked a loose ball in the box past Quartuccio. UMKC took its first lead of the contest in the 38th minute on a **Kyle Perkins** goal from 10 yards out, but Oral Roberts knotted to score at 3-3 after an own goal in the 45th minute.

The second frame proved to be the defensive battle that was expected at the outset. The lone goal of the period came in the 72nd minute when junior forward **Dave Leung**, who is the 2004 Offensive Player of the Year, served up a pass on the right side to freshman forward **Robert Davis**, who promptly booted the ball past UMKC's Dohman. The Golden Eagles hung tough on defense for the final 18 minutes, including a pair of key saves by Quartuccio.

In stark contrast, the second semifinal match featured a scoreless first half and only one goal in the entire contest. In the opening period there were more fouls (10) than shots (9). Both teams came out strong after the halftime break, but neither team could capitalize on their offensive chances until Western Illinois broke through with a tally in the 71st minute. Freshman **Preston Bernardi** found the perfect time to score his first career goal as he took a centering pass from sophomore **Nowaf Jaman** and knocked it past Oakland keeper **Jeff Wiese** from 10 yards out.

Western Illinois netminder **David Hanlon** made four saves en route to his fifth shutout of the season, while his counterpart Wiese, the 2004 Defensive Player of the Year, made seven stops in a losing effort. WIU's Jaman and Oakland's **Chris Edwards**, who were both named to the All Mid-Con first team, registered a match-high four shots apiece.
