Edwards wins his third Offensive Player of the Week award after scoring two goals in Oakland's 4-0 win over Valparaiso Sunday. It was the third multi-goal game of the season for Edwards, who

also blasted a game-high 10 shots against the Crusaders. The junior midfielder was Oakland's top offensive threat in a 0-0 tie with regionally-ranked Michigan Wednesday, getting off six shots. Edwards is tied for the Mid-Con lead in points (28) and goals (13).

### AROUND THE MID-CON...



THE CHAMPIONSHIP FIELD IS SET: The field has been set for the 2004 Mid-Con Men's Soccer Championship. Oral Roberts wrapped up the top seed in the Mid-Con Championship and earned its first outright regular-season title with a 4-0 victory over Centenary Oct. 30. The Golden Eagles will face #4 seed and defending champion UMKC in the semifinals of the tourney, which is being held the MacKenzie Alumni Field on Western Illinois' campus (Nov. 12 & 14). The Kangaroos earned a berth with a pair of conference wins the last weekend in October, including a 4-0 decision over Centenary Nov. 1 to seal the postseason spot. In the other semifinal match-up, #2 Oakland will square off against the host and #3 seed Western Illinois.

EDWARDS NOTCHES ANOTHER MULTI-GOAL GAME: Oakland's Chris Edwards continued his hot offensive streak with a two-goal game in a 4-0 win over Valparaiso in OU's Mid-Con regular-season finale. Edwards is tied for second in the league with three multi-goal games this season. He is also tied for the conference lead in points (28) and goals (13) and is third in shots (61) and game-winning goals (4). Marcus Halland scored his second goal of the season in the win, while Brian Graham came off of the bench to record his first tally of the year. Josh Slaughter was solid in the net for Oakland with four saves, while Jeff Oleck made seven stops for Valpo.

**IUPUI EDGES CENTENARY IN MID-CON FINALE: Matthew Smith** scored his second goal of the season to lead IUPUI to a victory over Centenary in the season finale for both teams Saturday. The junior midfielder took a pass from **Adrian Conrad** and zipped a shot past Centenary keeper **James Speed**, who made six saves on the day. **Peter Brasovan** led the defensive effort for the Jaguars with five saves.

UMKC POSTS BACK-T0-BACK TIES: It was a fruitless week for the Kangaroos in the win column as UMKC posted ties against Rockhurst (1-1) Thursday and Drury (1-1) Sunday. Kyle Perkins scored the lone UMKC goal and Todd Dohlman made five saves against Rockhurst. Robby Borchardt came up big on offense for the Kangaroos against Drury, while Dohlman had another solid performance in net with four stops. It was Borchardt's first goal of the season.

OAKLAND BLANKS MICHIGAN: The good news for Oakland Wednesday was that the Golden Grizzlies blanked regionally-ranked Michigan, but the bad news for OU was that they could not manage to find the back of the net as the team battled to a 0-0 tie. The Golden Grizzlies outshot the Wolverines, 22-15.

IUPUI ASSURED OF WINNING RECORD: IUPUI finished the season with a 10-7-1 record and finish above .500 for the first time since 2000 when they were 11-9-2 and made an NCAA Tournament appearance.

THREE DIFFERENT LEATHERNECKS SCORE VS. DRURY: Western Illinois closed out its regular-season slate with a 3-0 victory over Drury Sunday. Three different Leathernecks scored their first goal of the year in the win, led by **Brett Thomas** with the game-winning score at the 17-minute mark. **Andy Swentik** and **Jay Hawkins** added insurance tallies for WIU.

SCORING RACE HEATS UP: The Mid-Con scoring race is heating up heading into the conference tournament. IUPUI freshman Vangel Nacovski and Oakland junior Chris Edwards are tied for the Mid-Con points lead with 28 apiece. Nacovski's 28 markers come via 12 goals and four assists, while Edwards has 13 goals and two helpers on the season. In the goals department, Edwards is tied with Western Illinois' Nowaf Jaman with 13 tallies each. The duo is followed closely by Nacovski and Oral Roberts' Dave Leung (11 goals). Leung leads the conference and is ninth nationally in goals per game at a 0.85 clip.

TWO MID-CON TEAMS AMONG NCAA SHUTOUT LEADERS: Goose-eggs have been the name of the game for Oral Roberts and Oakland this season. The two squads are in the Top 10 in the NCAA in shutout percentage. The Golden Eagles are tied for second with a 0.67 shutout mark, while the Golden Grizzlies blank foes at a 0.56 clip.
