Valparaiso's Lori Moore sparked her team's win over three-time defending Mid-Con regular-season champion Oakland. Moore put the Crusaders on the board just 44 seconds into the match, then tallied the eventual game-winning goal in the 51st minute. The scores

increased her Mid-Con career-record total to 34 goals, and the game-winner was the tenth of her career. The win was the Crusaders' fourth in league play this season, which tied a school record set last season.

ORAL ROBERTS PUSHES WIN STREAK TO SEVEN: After starting slowly (it started 2-5), Oral Roberts has been spectacular over the last three weeks. The Golden Eagles, who have not lost since September 22, pushed their win streak to seven matches (and their unbeaten string to eight) with a pair of non-conference road wins last week. Three different players posted scores in a 3-0 win at Rice, including Heather Hall and Lindsay Ruisch, who did it off the bench. Jessica Kellogg netted two goals in a span of 1:01 in a 4-1 win at Centenary.

VALPO PULLS OFF FIRST, BEATS OAKLAND ON THE ROAD: Valparaiso knocked off three-time defending Mid-Con regular-season champion Oakland, 2-1, on the road last week, which was the Golden Grizzlies' first conference home loss since the Mid-Con started sponsoring women's soccer in 1999. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Lori Moore scored both Valpo goals, including one just 44 seconds into the match, and the eventual game-winner in the 51st minute. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Kristen Templin made eight saves in the win while facing 26 shots.

YAKAPOVICH A BUSY GIRL: Western Illinois goalie Sarah Yakapovich was a busy girl last week for the Westerwinds. She faced a total of 54 shots (28 at Saint Louis, 26 vs. Eastern Illinois) in a pair of losses, and made 13 saves in a 1-0 defeat at Saint Louis and 11 more in a 3-0 setback at the hands of Eastern Illinois. She is tied for first in the Mid-Con with 10-save matches this season with three.

CENTENARY COLLEGE TO JOIN MID-CON: For the first time in its brief history, the Mid-Con will have a seven-team women's soccer league in 2003. Centenary College of Louisiana, which has been playing as an independent for the last few years, will begin league play next season. The Ladies fell to 12-6 on the season after a 4-1 loss to Oral Roberts last weekend.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (3-12-2, 1-3 Mid-Con): IUPUI dropped a pair of lopsided non-conference matches, losing at Kent State (6-10) and at home to Tennessee Tech (5-0). Katie Giger made seven saves against Kent State, while Mari Jo Kohler's goal in the 88th minute averted the shutout. IUPUI took 18 shots against Tennessee Tech, including 10 that were on goal, but could not find the back of the net.

Oakland (6-10, 2-2 Mid-Con): Oakland topped crosstown rival Detroit (3-0), but dropped its first-ever Mid-Con home match to Valparaiso (2-1). Erica Demers recorded her first multi-goal match of the season against Detroit with a pair of scores, while Jenny Young added a goal as well. Oakland outshot Valpo by a 26-6 margin, but Kristi Swaving's goal in the 56th minute could not make up for a two-goal deficit.

Oral Roberts (9-5-1, 4-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts pushed its win streak to seven matches (and its unbeaten streak to eight) with road wins at Rice (3-0) and future Mid-Con foe Centenary (4-1). Heather Hall put the Golden Eagles ahead early at Rice, while Lindsay Ruisch and Tessa Long added insurance goals. Kellie Fenton made five saves for her fourth shutout of the season. Fenton allowed an early goal at Centenary, which snapped a scoreless streak of nearly 430 minutes, but shut down the host Ladies the rest of the way. Jessica Kellogg scored twice in a span of 1:01 in the middle of the first half, while Michelle Hoogveld and Nicole Bucceluni added insurance scores in the second frame. Oral Roberts is guaranteed at least a share of the Mid-Con regular-season crown for the second time in three years, and has also wrapped up the top seed in next month's Mid-Con Tournament.

Southern Utah (2-14, 1-3 Mid-Con): Southern Utah was idle last week.

Valparaiso (5-8-1, 4-1 Mid-Con): Valparaiso lost a 3-0 contest at Bowling Green, but rebounded to beat hand Oakland its first-ever home loss in Mid-Con play, 2-1. Danielle Guerra made six saves in goal for the Crusaders at Bowling Green. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Lori Moore put Valpo up just 44 seconds into the contest at Oakland, and scored the eventual game-winner in the 51st minute. Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Kristen Templin faced 26 shots, and allowed only one goal while making eight saves. The win at Oakland was Valparaiso's fourth league victory of the season, tying a school record that last season's squad set.

Western Illinois (1-12-1, 1-4 Mid-Con): Western Illinois lost at Saint Louis (1-0) and at home to Eastern Illinois (3-0) to extend its losing streak to six matches. Sarah Yakapovich made 13 saves in the loss at Saint Louis while facing 28 shots. Eastern Illinois did not score until the 73rd minute, and sealed up the contest with two goals in the final three minutes. Yakapovich made 11 more saves in the defeat.
