CARTMEL TRYING TO FOLLOW IN LONG LINE OF OAKLAND OFFENSIVE THREATS: Oakland's Debbie Cartmel has set her sights on the offensive numbers of former Oakland greats Kristen Luoma (76 career points), Ashley McGhee (92) and Anita Rapp (60), as she has taken on the role of the Golden Grizzlies' top scorer this season. Cartmel probably won't reach McGhee, the Mid-Con's all-time leading scorer, but Rapp and Luoma could be within her reach if she continues to score goals at the pace she did last week. Cartmel scored once against Illinois State and netted two scored and dished out an assist against Purdue, making her the choice for Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week. Cartmel now has 54 career points, including nine this season on four goals and an assist. Her 20 goals ties for sixth on the Mid-Con's career list, while her 54 points rank seventh.

AFTER A ONE-YEAR ABSENCE, HOCKING RACKING UP SAVES FOR IUPUI: IUPUI's Erica Hocking was named to the All Mid-Con first team as a freshman in 2000, but sat out last year. This season, Hocking is back in goal for the Jaguars, and is climbing up the Mid-Con's career saves list. Hocking made 21 saves last week, including a Mid-Con season-best 14 at Louisville, and now has 51 this season. Her 160 career saves ranks sixth on the Mid-Con's career list. Her effort at Louisville, coupled with a strong performance at Youngstown State in a 2-1 overtime win, helped win her Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week honors.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (2-5, 0-0 Mid-Con): IUPUI won once in tries last week. The Jaguars lost at Louisville (2-0), topped Youngstown State in overtime (2-1) on the road, and fell at Detroit (3-0). Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Erica Hocking made a Mid-Con season-best 14 saves in the loss at Louisville, as the Jaguars were outshot by a 30-2 margin. For the second straight week, Tara Latella scored both of her team's goals in a 2-1 win, this time against Youngstown State. She tied the match in the 68th minute, and won it in the eighth minute of overtime. Latella, who scored 14 goals as a rookie in 2000, found the back of the net just once last year, but already has five scores this season. IUPUI's 28 shots against Youngstown State is the second-highest match total in school history, trailing only the 32 attempts by the 2000 Jaguars, also against Youngstown State. Mari Jo Kohler didn't score against the Penguins, but did fire 13 shots, including 10 on goal. Hocking averaged 7.00 saves per game for the week.

Oakland (2-4, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland dropped its first two matches of the season, against Illinois State (3-2) and versus Purdue (4-3) in overtime. Down by three goals against Illinois State after a half, the Golden Grizzlies rallied in the second half behind scores by Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Debbie Cartmel and Kristi Swaving, but couldn't catch up. Cartmel scored the team's first two goals in the first half against Purdue and assisted on Natalie Simas' second-half score, but Purdue eventually won in overtime on a penalty kick. Cartmel leads Oakland with nine points on four goals and an assist.

Oral Roberts (1-3, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts was idle last week.

Southern Utah (0-7, 0-0 Mid-Con): A busy week for Southern Utah did not translate into the Thunderbirds first win of the season. Southern Utah dropped its home opener to Eastern Washington in double overtime (3-2), and then lost at Utah State (6-1) and against Portland State (7-0). Amber Tubbs scored her first career goal to put the Thunderbirds on the board against Eastern Washington, and Annie Payne's score gave the squad a 2-1 lead with five minutes left, but the visitors tied it up and won it in the second overtime period. Lindsey Mulliner scored the team's only goal over the weekend on a deflection off of a Utah State defender. The Thunderbirds surrendered a pair of hat tricks last week, and had four multi-goal matches against them in all. The match against Eastern Washington was the second-longest in the program's brief history.

Valparaiso (0-3-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso managed a tie in its only match last week, as it knotted with IPFW. Ashley Shaneyfelt scored in the first half to give the Crusaders a lead, and Lindsay Holley's score in the second half did the same, but IPFW battled back each time, scoring the game-tying goal in the waning moments of each half. Kristen Templin made ten saves for the Crusaders in the tie, which snapped a season-opening three-match losing streak.

Western Illinois (0-3-1, 0-0 Mid-Con): Western Illinois ran its losing streak to three matches with a 4-1 loss at UW-Green Bay in its only match last week. Katie Campion's score with a little more than a minute left in the first half kept the Westerwinds from the shutout loss. Carey Cowhey made nine saves in the defeat.
