LONG HEADS LIST OF MULTI-GOAL SCORERS: Mid-Con teams certainly didn't have a tough time finding the back of the net last week. Five different players posted multi-goal matches last week, and the number of players that have done the trick this season nearly doubled to ten. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Tessa Long scored three times in two matches while leading Oral Roberts to the Golden Hurricane Classic crown; both she and Erin Hartog scored twice in a 4-2 win over Drury. Oakland shut out former Mid-Con member Youngstown State by an 8-0 count, as Debbie Cartmel and Kristi Swaving each scored twice. Finally, Valparaiso's Lori Moore scored twice in a league win over IUPUI, which gave her 30 career goals, second on the Mid-Con's career list.

WESTERWINDS SNAP A PAIR OF SKIDS IN ONE WIN: After tying Northern Iowa to start the season, Western Illinois lost six consecutive matches. That streak stopped last weekend with the Westerwinds' 1-0 win at IUPUI, its first in three tries in Mid-Con play this season. Katie Campion's header in the 58th minute proved to be enough for the win, which was Western Illinois' first in its last eight Mid-Con matches, dating back to last season.

FLOWERS SEES SAVES RECORD BLOOM TWICE: Southern Utah's Megan Flowers was a busy girl last week in goal for the Thunderbirds. Flowers, who a week ago won Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week honors, set a school record with her 13 saves in a 1-0 loss at Northern Arizona. That record lasted less than 48 hours, as she went one better and stopped 14 shots in a 4-1 loss to Boise State.

OAKLAND ENDS FRUSTRATION WITH IMPRESSIVE PERFORMANCE: Heading into last week, Oakland had dropped six straight matches (its longest losing streak ever), including five contests by one goal. The Golden Grizzlies took out some frustration on former Mid-Con member Youngstown State, blanking the Penguins by an 8-0 count. Oakland outshot Youngstown State by a whopping 41-0 count, and 11 different Golden Grizzlies registered a point. Kristi Swaving scored twice, Debbie Cartmel posted two goals and two assists, and Katie Arnott had a Mid-Con season-best three assists.

MID-CON TEAM NOTES

IUPUI (2-8-1, 0-2 Mid-Con): IUPUI started the week by rallying for a 2-2 tie with visiting Indiana State, but then dropped Mid-Con contests at home to Western Illinois (1-0) and at Valparaiso (3-0). After Indiana State took a 2-0 lead, Tara Latella and Mari Jo Kohler netted second-half goals for the Jaquars, who battled the Sycamores to a draw the rest of the way. Connie Bigott made a career-best 12 saves in the match. Bigott made five stops against Western Illinois, but let a header slip past her in the 58th minute for the only score of the match; she then made seven saves at Valparaiso. IUPUI managed only seven shots against Valpo, including only one in the first half.

Oakland (3-7, 0-0 Mid-Con): Oakland snapped a six-match losing streak by soundly beating Youngstown State (8-0) at home, but then lost a home contest to regionally ranked Dayton (2-1). The Golden Grizzlies stiffed former Mid-Con member Youngstown State, outshooting the Penguins by a 41-0 count. Kristi Swaving had a pair of goals, including the game-winner, while Debbie Cartmel had two goals and two assists. Katie Arnott distributed a Mid-Con season-best three assists, while Erica Demers, Kim Moore, Leah Cherf and Lindsay Mathus all scored a goal each. Ingrid Mortensen put Oakland ahead late in the first half against Dayton, but the visiting Flyers knotted the match in the opening moments of the second half and took the lead in the 55th minute. Sarah Buckland made five saves in the loss.

Oral Roberts (3-5-1, 1-0 Mid-Con): Oral Roberts captured the 2002 Golden Hurricane Classic crown by tying SW Missouri State (1-1) and beating Drury (4-2). Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Tessa Long forced the tie with SW Missouri State by knotting the contest in the first minute of the second half with her first goal of the season. Kellie Fenton made five saves in goal to preserve the tie. Erin Hartog scored the first and last goals for the Golden Eagles in their win over Drury, but Long provided the middle two, including the eventual game-winner just 25 seconds into the second half. Martha Owens joined Long, Hartog and Jodi Kirkhuff on the all-tournament team. Kirkhuff had an assist in each match, while Jessica Kellog assisted on the final two goals of the Drury win.

Southern Utah (1-11, 1-0 Mid-Con): Southern Utah dropped three straight matches, including a home contest with Cal Baptist (1-0) and match-ups with Northern Arizona (1-0) and Boise State (4-1) at the Northern Arizona Mountain Tournament. Megan Flowers made six saves in the loss against Cal Baptist, but allowed the match's lone score in the 16th minute. Northern Arizona managed to sneak the quickest score in stadium history (at the 1:02 mark) by Flowers, but she posted a career-high 13 saves the rest of the way while facing 27 shots. Flowers then established a school record for the third time in five matches with 14 saves against Boise State. Michelle Davis tallied Southern Utah's only goal of the week to avoid a third straight shutout. Flowers and Sarah Sillitoe were named to the all-tournament team.

Valparaiso (2-5-1, 1-0 Mid-Con): Valparaiso started the weekend by dropping a 3-1 decision at Indiana State, but recovered to beat IUPUI by a 3-0 count in its league opener. Indiana State scored twice in the first 11 minutes of the match, which proved to be enough to top the Crusaders. Kristen Templin made 10 saves for the third time this season, and Lindsay 2002 Mid-Con Women's Soccer Tournament Holley scored the team's lone goal

. Templin posted her second career shutout by making four saves against IUPUI, but faced only seven shots in the match, thanks to a defense led by Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Courtney Budd. Emily King put Valpo on the board in the 37th minute with her first career tally, and Lori Moore tallied a pair of second-half goals to secure the win. Moore's scores moved her into second place on the Mid-Con's career goals scored list with 30.

Western Illinois (1-7-1, 1-2 Mid-Con): Western Illinois snapped a six-match losing streak by beating IUPUI (1-0) on the road in conference play, but then dropped a 3-1 decision at Indiana State. Katie Campion's header off of a Tricia Johnson cross in the 58th minute was all Sarah Yakapovich needed to post the shutout, which snapped a seven-match Mid-Con losing streak, dating back to last season. Campion's score at Indiana State closed the gap to 2-1 in the 80th minute, but the host Sycamores answered with a goal two minutes later to secure the victory.
