## Mid-Con Women's Soccer News and Notes

**MID-CON TEAMS GET OFF TO SLOW STARTS:** The six teams that comprise the Mid-Con have posted a combined 4-17-1 (.205) record to start the season, and only three teams have posted wins. Oakland is 2-2, while IUPUI and Oral Roberts are both 1-3. Southern Utah (0-4), Valparaiso (0-3) and Western Illinois (0-2-1) are all still searching for their first wins of 2002.

**LATELLA PROVIDES ALL OF IUPUI'S OFFENSE:** IUPUI's Tara Latella became the second Jaguar in as many weeks to earn Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week honors after scoring both of her team's goals in a 2-1 win over Louisiana-Monroe. Due to a scheduling mishap, Latella's goals helped IUPUI to its first win of the season, and in her team's first of two matches on the day. The Jaguars dropped the nightcap in the first women's soccer doubleheader in Mid-Con history, 3-0, to Akron.

**KIRKHUFF GETS DEFENSIVE AWARD WHILE BEING OFFENSIVE:** Yes, Oral Roberts' Jodi Kirkhuff helped her team to its first win of the season by contributing defensively in a 3-0 shutout of previously unbeaten Portland State. It was both her offensive and defensive efforts, however, that helped her win Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week honors. Kirkhuff had a goal and an assist in the win over Portland State, and also scored her team's only goal in a 2-1 loss to Louisiana-Lafayette. Kirkhuff was the Mid-Con Co-Player of the Year in 2001.

### MID-CON TEAM NOTES

**IUPUI (1-3, 0-0 Mid-Con):** Due to a scheduling mishap, IUPUI played the first doubleheader in Mid-Con women's soccer history in Ogden, Utah. The Jaguars slipped by Louisiana-Monroe by a 2-1 score in the first game, but lost to Akron in the nightcap, 3-0. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Tara Latella provided all of IUPUI's offense in its win, scoring twice in the second half. Erica Hocking narrowly missed the shutout, allowing a goal with just seven seconds left in the match. Latella now has 18 goals and 46 points in her career, both of which second on the school's all-time lists.

**Oakland (2-2, 0-0 Mid-Con):** After opening the season with a pair of wins, Oakland lost back-to-back contests last week. The Golden Grizzlies fell at Central Michigan by a 3-2 count, and also dropped a match at Michigan State, 2-0. All five goals in the Central Michigan match were scored in the first 37 minutes of the contest. Oakland's Ingrid Mortensen scored her first career goal in the second minute, and Erica Demers tied the match on a penalty kick on the 18th minute after two Chippewa goals. Sarah Buckland made four saves in the loss. The Golden Grizzlies were held to just eight shots in the loss at Michigan State; Buckland made five stops in defeat.

**Oral Roberts (1-3, 0-0 Mid-Con):** Oral Roberts picked up its first win of the season over previously unbeaten Portland State, 3-0, but then dropped a 2-1 decision to Louisiana-Lafayette. Rookie Jessica Kellogg scored twice in the second half against Portland State, while Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Jodi Kirkhuff added an insurance score. Kellie Fenton posted her first career shutout by making six saves. Kirkhuff tied the match with Louisiana-Lafayette with a score in the 61st minute, but the Ragin' Cajuns answered a few minutes later to secure the win. Christy Chapman returned from injury, and made one save in the loss.

**Southern Utah (0-4, 0-0 Mid-Con):** Southern Utah is still looking for its first win after suffering two shutout losses in a tournament hosted by UNLV - 4-0 to Fresno State and 2-0 to Nevada. Megan Flowers made seven saves in the loss to Fresno State, in which the Thunderbirds managed only two shots. Nevada narrowly outshot Southern Utah in the next contest (9-7), but Kaula Rowe's two scores in a span of 1:05 late in the match secured the win. Lyndsey Sobrero played solidly in goal for much of the contest, making three saves and not allowing a score for nearly 83 minutes. The Thunderbirds took their first corner kick of the season in the first half against Nevada, snapping a streak of more than 300 minutes without one in 2002.

**Valparaiso (0-3, 0-0 Mid-Con):** Valparaiso suffered a pair of defeats at a tournament hosted by Cal Poly. The Crusaders fell to the hosts by a 4-0 score, and were defeated by Pacific, 5-0, in the second match. Valparaiso was outshot by a 28-4 margin by Cal Poly, and by a 20-11 margin against Pacific. Kristen Templin made 10 saves in the latter defeat. The Crusaders allowed two scores in the first three minutes of the second half in each match. Valparaiso has been outscored by a 14-1 margin to start the season.

**Western Illinois (0-2-1, 0-0 Mid-Con):** Western Illinois played only once last week, losing at Murray State by a 5-0 count. The Westerwinds were outshot by a 23-9 margin and put only two shots on goal. Murray State scored three times in a span of 2:08 early in the second half. Carey Cowhey made seven saves in defeat for Western Illinois. The Westerwinds sported four freshmen in their starting line-up.
