AROUND THE MID-CON...

CENTENARY POSTS FIRST EVER MID-CON VICTORY: Newcomer Centenary posted its first-ever Mid-Con win in any sport last week, blanking visiting Western Illinois 4-0. Rebecca Swilley collected the game-winner, while Kylie Garrett, Courtney McCotter and Angela Tryba also scored. Centenary, which is currently riding a five-game win streak, will look to post its fifth shutout in six wins next week as it takes on non-conference foe Alcorn State.

OAKLAND RIDING SEVEN-GAME STREAK: Oakland collected two wins last week, defeating Valparaiso (3-0) and UW-Milwaukee (2-1), to extend its current winning streak to seven matches, the longest for the Golden Grizzlies since winning eight in a row in the 2001 season. Oakland has outscored its opponents 25-4 in the last seven matches and currently leads the league in points (83), goals (29) and assists (25). Oakland, the Mid-Con preseason favorite, is a perfect 4-0 in conference play, and is 6-0-1 in its last seven matches against league foes dating back to last season. The Golden Grizzlies will look to extend their streak as they take on conference rival Oral Roberts, which is also undefeated in league play at 2-0, this week.

ORAL ROBERTS STAYS PERFECT IN LEAGUE PLAY : Oral Roberts posted its second Mid-Con win of the season last week as it defeated visiting Western Illinois, 4-1. The Golden Eagles dominated the field, outshooting the Westerwinds 22-4, including 11-4 on goal. Nicole Buccelluni netted her second game-winning goal in the win, while teammates Jessica Kellogg, Kim Pangburn and Heather Hall also scored. Oral Roberts will try to maintain its five-match unbeaten streak and perfect league record at Oakland this week.

SOUTHERN UTAH POSTS FIRST WIN OF THE SEASON: Southern Utah recorded its first win of the season last week, defeating conference foe IUPUI, 3-1. The victory snapped an 18-match Thunderbird losing streak dating back to last season, with the last victory being nearly a year ago against Houston. Michelle Davis and Chaysie Call led the Southern Utah charge, as each tallied a goal and an assist in the win. Goalkeeper Megan Flowers tallied her first win of the season allowing just one goal, while stopping four shots in just under 81 minutes of play. The Thunderbirds' three goals, 16 shots and 10 shots on goal were all season highs. Southern Utah will look to improve its Mid-Con Tourney chances at Western Illinois this weekend. The Thunderbirds play four of their final five regular-season matches on the road.
