AROUND THE MID-CON...

OAKLAND CLINCHES MID-CON TITLE, STAYS UNDEFEATED: Oakland (5-0 Mid-Con) clinched at least a share of the Mid-Continent Conference regular-season title last week, defeating visiting Oral Roberts by a 3-1 count. Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Lisa-Marie Woods was the Golden Grizzlies' offensive force in the match, recording one goal and two assists in the win. Shelly Piccirillo and Krsiti Swaving also scored. Oakland went on to set a school record for consecutive wins when it beat Detroit by a 1-0 over the weekend; the Golden Grizzlies have now won nine straight matches, and have assured themselves of at least a share of their fourth regular-season title in five years.

OAKLAND MOVES TO NO. 5 IN REGION RANKINGS: Oakland has moved up to the No. 5 spot in the NSCAA Great Lakes Regional Rankings after its performance last week, which included wins over Oral Roberts (3-1) and Detroit (1-0) and extended its winning streak to nine matches. Oakland (11-3-1) trails only No. 25 Purdue, No. 16 Ohio State, No. 19 Illinois and No. 2 Notre Dame in its region.

IUPUI, VALPO BATTLE TO TIE AND SET SCHOOL RECORDS: IUPUI's scoreless tie against Valparaiso was only the fifth tie in the program's history and the first scoreless tie in school history. Valparaiso then went on to post a 1-1 tie against Western Illinois later in the week to record the first back-to-back ties in school history. The Crusaders had never posted two ties in the same season.

TINY TIDBITS: Centenary picked up a 14-0 win last week over Alcorn State, the largest margin of victory for the Ladies since they defeated the same squad 19-0 last year... the Centenary defense did not allow Alcorn to attempt a single shot in the match as the Ladies outshot their opponent 51-0...Western Illinois snapped its six-match losing streak, posting a 2-0 win over Southern Utah last week. The Westerwinds went on to record a 1-1 tie against Valparaiso... IUPUI's Lauren Hallahan became the sixth Jaguar to score her first career goal this season in a 6-1 loss to IPFW.
