Oakland's Erica Demers led the Golden Grizzlies as they clinched the Mid-Continent Conference regular-season title outright last week with a 5-0 win over visiting IUPUI. The senior scored a goal, while assisting on both the game-winning and fourth goal of the match, for four points overall. Because of her efforts, the Golden Grizzlies remained the only undefeated Mid-Con team (6-0) in league play, and set school records for the most consecutive games without a loss (10) and the most consecutive wins in a single season (10). Demers is tied for the team lead in assists (6) and ranks fifth on her team in scoring (10). # Team-by-Team Schedule and Results

## AROUND THE MID-CON...

**OAKLAND WINS MID-CON TITLE:** Oakland clinched the Mid-Con regular season title last week as it defeated visiting IUPUI by a 5-0 count. The Golden Grizzlies went undefeated in conference play this season and with the win, set school records for most consecutive games without a loss (10), as well as the most consecutive wins in a season (10). Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Erica Demers led the Golden Grizzly charge, collecting a goal and two assists in the win. She was also a main factor on the defensive end of the field where she helped allow just two shots in the first half and eight overall. Oakland, the Mid-Con preseason favorite, currently leads the conference only stats in every category and is ranked fifth in the Great Lakes Region (NSCAA). The Golden Grizzlies will conclude the regular season next week as they take on non-conference foes Western Michigan and Indiana.

**MID-CON TOURNAMENT RIGHT AROUND THE CORNER:** The Mid-Continent Conference Tournament is set for November 7-9, and two teams have already secured their spots. Oakland (6-0), the Mid-Con regular-season champion, will make the trip to Tulsa, while host Oral Roberts (4-1) will also compete. The fates of Western Illinois (2-3-1), Valparaiso (1-2-1) and Centenary (2-2) will all be decided this weekend. Centenary battles Valparaiso and IUPUI, while Western Illinois, which has already concluded its conference slate, will have to sit back and wait to learn their potential postseason fate.

**SOUTHERN UTAH SNAPS 17-MATCH STREAK:** Southern Utah's 17-match road losing skid was snapped last week as it picked up its first road victory at Texas Woman's (3-1). The Thunderbirds ended a three-game slide with the win, a stretch that saw Southern Utah give up just four goals in the three setbacks. Southern Utah's only other win this season came on October 11th against IUPUI by the same 3-1 count. Dani Lavigne led the Thunderbirds netting two goals in the win, including the game-winning goal. Eliminated from postseason tourney contention, Southern Utah will conclude its season this week as it hosts Oral Roberts.

**CENTENARY STREAK SNAPPED BY ORAL ROBERTS:** Centenary's six-match winning streak was ended last week as it was beaten by conference foe Oral Roberts (2-1). The Ladies are currently in fourth place in the conference standings and will battle for their first trip to the Mid-Con Tournament this weekend as they hit the road to take on IUPUI and Valparaiso.
