AROUND THE MID-CON...

MID-CON RACE RESUMES: Entering the third week of Mid-Continent Conference action, defending Mid-Con Tourney champion Oakland holds a comfortable lead in the conference standings with its 3-0 record. The Golden Grizzlies, who have posted five straight wins, collected their third conference victory last week as they defeated Western Illinois, 7-2. Oral Roberts, Valparaiso and Western Illinois trail Oakland, as each squad has tallied one conference win. Oral Roberts defeated IUPUI (2-0) and Valparaiso beat Southern Utah (2-1) last week.

MID-CON POSTS WINNING RECORD OVER NON-LEAGUE OPPONENTS: For the first time this season, the seven teams that comprise the Mid-Con posted a winning record against non-league foes, recording a 5-3 record on the week, defeating opponents from Conference USA, and the Mid-American, Southwestern Athletic and Western Athletic Conferences. Oral Roberts started the week, beating Hawaii (1-0), which was picked as the runner-up in the WAC preseason poll. Centenary collected a pair of wins as it defeated SWAC foes Grambling State (4-0) and Alabama A&M (2-0), IUPUI tallied a win against Eastern Michigan (1-0) in overtime, and Oakland defeated Cincinnati by a 5-1 count. The Mid-Con holds a winning record against the Big Ten (2-1), SWAC (3-0), and WAC (2-0) in 2003, and is even against the MAC (2-2).

SAMDAL, FENTON TAB MID-CON HONORS: Oakland's Marianne Samdal more than doubled her point total for the season in just two games last week, while Oral Roberts' Kellie Fenton posted a pair of shutouts to help her squad.
