AROUND THE MID-CON...

TOURNAMENT FIELD SET: The field and seedings for the 2003 Mid-Continent Conference Women's Soccer Tournaments are both set after the conclusion of the league's conference slate last week. Oakland will serve as the top seed in the single-elimination event, held at the ORU Soccer Complex on the campus of Oral Roberts University in Tulsa, Okla. The Golden Grizzlies will be joined by the host Golden Eagles (No. 2 seed), Centenary (No. 3 seed) and Western Illinois (No. 4 seed). The champion will receive the league's automatic qualification to the NCAA Women's College Cup.

OAKLAND LOOKS FOR FOUR: Oakland, which finished undefeated in league play for the third time in five seasons, will serve as the top seed in the tournament. The Golden Grizzlies (13-4-1, 6-0 Mid-Con) won their fourth Mid-Con regular-season title in five seasons last week and their third outright crown. Oakland, which is the only squad to represent the Mid-Con in NCAA postseason play, has also been the winner of the last three Mid-Con Tournaments. The Golden Grizzles are led by Shelly Piccirillo, who leads the Mid-Con with 11 goals. Sarah Buckland has also posted a great season, posting a league-best 0.86 goals against average.

HOST ORAL ROBERTS WILL SERVE AS NO. 2 SEED: Oral Roberts, which was picked second in the Mid-Con preseason poll, will serve as the No. 2 seed in the tournament. The Golden Eagles ended their regular-season play winning 9 of 11 matches, while allowing only 17 goals in 18 matches. Oral Roberts is led by Jessica Kellogg, who has a team-best eight goals and 19 points, while teammates Christy Chapman and Kellie Fenton have combined to post eight shutouts.

CENTENARY SENDS FIRST TEAM TO TOURNAMENT: The Ladies became the first Centenary team to qualify for a Mid-Continent Conference Tournament last week as they defeated IUPUI (3-1) and tied Valparaiso (1-1). They are the first Centenary team since 1999 to qualify for a conference tournament, and will serve as the No. 3 seed. Centenary (10-7-1, 3-2-1 Mid-Con) has won eight of its last ten games and has outscored its opponents by a 35-5 margin in that span while posting six shutouts. Offensive Player of the Week Mindi Levinski recorded an outstanding week, as she collected three goals and one assist in conference play. The senior finished the regular season as the conference leader in assists (10) and total points (26).

WESTERN MAKES FIRST APPEARANCE SINCE 2000: Western Illinois, which was picked seventh in the Mid-Con preseason poll, will make just its second-ever appearance in the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament this weekend. The Westerwinds, who have not been to a conference tournament in three years, will enter the tournament as the fourth seed and will play Mid-Con regular-season champion Oakland. Western is led by rookie Sarah Gathje, who led the team with six goals and 12 points. Gathje is ranked sixth on the Westerwinds' all-time scoring list and fifth on the career list for goals scored.

- The Jaguars' Sarah Leonard netted IUPUI's only goal last week, finishing the season ranked third on the team with seven points, while tying for the second-highest season assist total in school history with five.
