OFFENSIVE Jessica Kellogg, Oral Roberts So., F., Tulsa, Okla.

Oral Roberts' Jessica Kellogg picked up where she left off last season, when she led the Mid-Con with 12 goals as a rookie. Kellogg played an integral part in the Golden Eagles' two wins to start the

season, which pushed the team's unbeaten streak to 16 matches, dating back to last season. In a 5-0, rain-shortened win over Stephen F. Austin, she tallied a pair of scores for her fourth career multi-goal game. A day later, she broke a scoreless tie against Texas Tech in the 70th minute with her third goal of the weekend, which proved to be the gamewinner. She is now tied for seventh on the school's career goals list (15); the game-winner was the seventh of her career.

DEFENSIVE Sarah Buckland, Oakland Sr., GK., Burlington, Ontario

Oakland's Sarah Buckland was rock solid in net for the Golden Grizzlies in the season's first weekend, as they took away a co-championship (along with SE Missouri State) from Illinois' Illini Cup.

Buckland made four saves to preserve a 1-0 win against host Illinois in the season-opener, and stopped seven shots in a 0-0, double-overtime tie against SE Missouri State in what turned out to be the title match (she made two stops in the second extra session). Buckland, who allowed no goals in 200 minutes of work, extended her school and Mid-Con career shutouts record to 20.

AROUND THE MID-CON...

MID-CON TEAMS OFF TO TOUGH START: The six teams that comprise the Mid-Con have posted a combined 4-8-1 (.346) record to start the season, with only three teams recording wins. Oral Roberts is 2-0, while Oakland is 1-0-1 and Centenary is 1-1. IUPUI (0-1), Southern Utah (0-2), Valparaiso (0-2) and Western Illinois (0-2) are still in search of a win.

ORAL ROBERTS STARTS PERFECT, EXTENDS STREAK: Oral Roberts has started the season nearly perfect, winning both matches this past week, while extending its unbeaten streak to 16. The Golden Eagles, who were picked to finish second in the Mid-Con preseason poll, blanked both Stephen F. Austin (5-0) and Texas Tech (3-0). Jessica Kellogg, the Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week, led the charge, scoring three goals in the two games, including the gamewinner against Texas Tech. The sophomore is now tied for seventh in career goals (15) and is ranked third in career game winning goals (7).

OAKLAND WINS ILLINI CUP CO-CHAMPIONSHIP: Oakland, picked first in the Mid-Con preseason poll, will be in search of its fourth consecutive Mid-Con Tournament crown this season, as well as another trip to the NCAA College Cup. The Golden Grizzlies started the season off on the right foot, defeating Big Ten foe Illinois (1-0) and battling to a 0-0 tie with SE Missouri State at the Illinii Cup this past week. Oakland was led by last year's Mid-Con Newcomer of the year, Kristi Swaving. The sophomore scored the game-winning goal against Illinois, while leading the team in shots. Defensively, Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Sarah Buckland was strong for the Golden Grizzlies in goal, playing all 200 minutes and posting two shutouts and 11 saves. She is now the keeper with the most career saves (248) and the most career shutouts in Oakland history (20). She also holds the Mid-Con career record for shutouts.

OAKLAND EARNS REGION RANKINGS FROM NSCAA, SOCCER BUZZ: Oakland's performance ini the first week of the regular season was enough to earn them Great Lakes Region rankings from both the NSCAA and Soccer Buzz. The Golden Grizzlies are fifth in this week's NSCAA Great Lkaes Region poll, and tenth in the Soccer Buzz region rankings.
