AROUND THE MID-CON ...

MID-CON SEASON UNDERWAY: The start of the 2003 Mid-Con conference season was marked last week with a match between defending Mid-Con champ Oakland and newcomer Centenary. The Golden Grizzlies prevailed (1-0), posting their second straight win of the week, while extending the host Ladies' winless streak to four games. Centenary, which hosted its first-ever Mid-Con contest in any sport, will take a break from conference play until October 15th. Oakland will return home for one match this week, taking on Southern Utah in its second league game of the season.

OAKLAND SNAPS LOSING STREAK, EARNS REGION RANKINGS: Oakland snapped a threegame losing streak, defeating Centenary (1-0) and Eastern Michigan (3-0) last week, earning the Golden Grizzlies a No. 10 Great Lakes Region ranking from the NSCAA. Four different Oakland players netted goals in the wins - Katie Arnott, Lisa-Marie Woods and Marianne Samdal all scored their first goals of the year against Eastern Michigan, while Shelly Piccirillo scored against the Ladies. The Golden Grizzlies outshot their opponents 23-13 in the two victories, while holding Mid-Con foe Centenary to just three shots the entire match.

WESTERN ILLINOIS SCORELESS STRING SNAPPED: Western Illinois snapped its scoreless streak this past week, tallying two goals in a 6-2 loss to Evansville. The Westerwinds equaled the longest scoreless streak to start a season in school history, as the 1997 and 1999 teams were held without a goal until the seventh game of the season as well. Sarah Gathje netted both goals for the Westerwinds, who were held scoreless for 581 minutes this season, and 675 minutes overall dating back to last season.

REUTER LEADS IUPUI TO FIRST WIN: Kathryn Reuter led IUPUI to its first victory of the season last week, a 3-2 win over the University of Indianapolis. The freshman netted two goals (the first two of her career) in the win, marking the first time an IUPUI player had multiple goals in a match since Tara Latella turned in two vs. Louisiana-Monroe on Sept. 7, 2002. The Jaguars rallied from 1-0 and 2-1 deficits en route to the win thanks to Reuter, who took over the team lead in points (6) with her efforts. The victory had another signifigance to head coach Chris Johson, as he picked up his first win at IUPUI against his former school.

2003 MID-CON TOURNEY RETURNS TO ORAL ROBERTS

By virtue of winning the 2002 Mid-Con regular-season title, Oral Roberts will again serve as the host for the 2003 Mid-Con Women's Soccer Tournament, which will be held on Nov. 7 and 9, at the ORU Soccer Complex in Tulsa, Okla. The top four finishers in the Mid-Con regular-season standings will advance to the event, with the winner receiving the league's automatic berth to the NCAA Women's College Cup. Oral Roberts will host the event for the fourth straight year in 2003. Oakland has won each of the last three Mid-Con Women's Soccer Tournays, while Oral Roberts won the initial event in 1999.
