MID-CON RACE RESUMES: In the second week of Mid-Con play, two squads have posted wins to take an initial lead in the conference standings. Oakland, the defending Mid-Con Tourney champ, registered a 4-0 win over visiting Southern Utah, moving the Golden Grizzlies to the top of the standings with a 2-0 record. Western Illinois is not far behind, after picking up its first win of the season by defeating visiting IUPUI, 3-2. Oakland and Western Illinois will battle next week in Macomb, while Valparaiso will play Southern Utah and IUPUI will host Oral Roberts.

MID-CON STREAKS SNAPPED: Four Mid-Con teams picked up wins last week to end their respective winless or losing streaks. Centenary stopped its five-match winless streak, defeating Arkansas State (3-0), marking the first shutout of the year for the Ladies. Oral Roberts snapped a brief three-match losing streak, its longest in two years, defeating Drury (2-1). Valparaiso posted its first win of the season in a 3-2 overtime defeat of Eastern Illinois, marking the first time the Crusaders have bested the Panthers in eight outings dating back to 1995. Finally, Western Illinois posted its first victory in nearly a year with a 3-2 win over IUPUI. The Westerwinds, who had a 15-match losing streak dating back to last season, including a 10-match home losing streak, defeated the Jaguars nearly one year ago to the day.

MID-CON STREAKS STARTED: While four Mid-Con squads (Centenary, Oral Roberts, Valparaiso and Western Illinois) snapped winless streaks, IUPUI, Oakland and Southern Utah have all started streaks of their own. The Jaguars picked up two losses last week in a 3-2 loss to Western Illinois and a 4-0 loss to Indiana State, extending their losing streak to three matches, while Oakland tallied a win over Southern Utah (4-0) to extend its winning streak to three matches. Southern Utah, which lost to Weber State (1-0), Oakland (4-0) and IPFW (3-0) extended its season-opening losing streak to 11 matches. The Thunderbirds are the only Mid-Con squad still in search of a win.

VALPO, WESTERN PICK UP FIRST WINS: Both Valparaiso and Western Illinois picked up their first wins of the season last week as the Crusaders defeated Eastern Illinois (3-2) and the Westerwinds beat IUPUI (3-2). Mid-Con Offensive Player of the Week Jannifer Bartels led Valparaiso, tallying two goals in the win, while teammate Amanda Meyer netted the gamewinning goal. The Westerwinds were led by Mid-Con Defensive Player of the Week Sarah Yakapovich's play between the pipes, as she tallied seven saves against the Jaguars. Sarah Gathje, Andrea Fernandez and Nicole Trendler each netted a goal for Western in the win.
